### A message from Ben Cole, Senior Minister

#### Advent: The Arrival of Grace, Truth, and Jesus

Advent is a time of waiting and preparation, a season that marks the coming of something—or someone—that will change everything. Webster's dictionary defines Advent as "the arrival of a notable person, thing, or event." But the arrival we celebrate at Christmas is far more than the coming of a remarkable figure. It is the arrival of our Savior, the Messiah, the Lord. As the Scriptures tell us: "Today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you; he is the Messiah, the Lord." (Luke 2:11)

Jesus is not just another notable person in history. He is the eternal Son of God—He who was, who is, and who is to come. His birth does not mark the beginning of His existence but instead the moment when God became one of us. It is the arrival of grace. The arrival of truth. The arrival of Jesus.

This sets the stage for our three-week Christmas sermon series: *The Arrival of Grace* (Dec. 8th), *The Arrival of Truth* (Dec. 15th), and *The Arrival of Jesus* (Dec. 22nd). But here's the question: did the birth of Christ bring the arrival of grace and truth? I would argue not in the way we might initially think. Grace has been present since the fall of humanity—Noah found grace in the eyes of the Lord (Genesis 6:8), and God's truth has been revealed through His Word, His law, and His actions throughout history. However, as John 1:17 tells us, "The law was given through Moses; grace and truth came through Jesus Christ." (John 1:17)

In Jesus, grace and truth are revealed in their fullness. While grace and truth were present before His birth, it is through His coming—God putting on flesh and dwelling among us—that we encounter them in their complete, personal, and transformative form.

My prayer this Christmas season is that we would each come to know Jesus more deeply and we have the opportunities available to do so. Whether through our sermon series, the children's Christmas play, the adult Christmas play, our candlelight services, etc. You'll find all the details inside this newsletter.

It is an incredible honor to serve as your Senior Minister, and I'm grateful for the opportunity to walk alongside each of you in faith. From my family to yours, Merry Christmas!

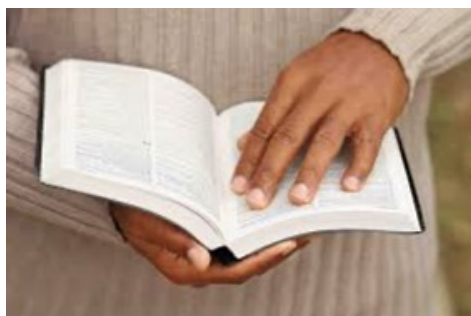
## Starting Point

## Gifts at the End of the Year

Just a quick note to try to clarify the IRS rules regarding end of the year gifts and determining the year to which they belong. The general rule is the gift belongs to the year in which the giver fully surrenders control of the gift.

If you desire to make a gift that belongs to 2024:

**Online:** the date and time you make the gift is recorded and the gift will belong to 2024 as long as it is completed before midnight on December 31, 2024.

**In Person, Check or Cash:** the date and time the gift is surrendered to the church will determine the year. This year, if you give on Sunday, December 29th, at a service, or put a gift in the drop box at the office before midnight on Tuesday, December 31st (yes, we will check), that gift will belong to 2024. (The date on the check is not a factor.)

If you desire to make a gift that belongs to 2025:

**Online:** the date and time you make the gift is recorded and the gift will belong to 2025 as long as it is completed after midnight on January 1, 2025.

**In Person, Check or Cash:** the date and time the gift is surrendered to the church will determine the year. If you give on or after January 1st, at a service, or put a gift in the drop box at the office, that gift will belong to 2025. (The date on the check is not a factor.)
