A message from Ben Cole, Senior Minister

“Let everything that has breath praise the Lord...” (Psalm 150:6). I believe you know what the periods mean—this is not the end of the verse. I like to call it a cliffhanger. You will need to read this whole article to find out how the verse ends.

As we close out 2024, let us all praise the Lord for His faithfulness this past year. When I reflect on what God did throughout the year, I am in awe. The year started with a sermon series entitled *Just Jesus* (Matthew 3–7). As you know, we camped out in Matthew 5–7, the Sermon on the Mount, for nearly 6 months. I do not have enough words or space on this page to describe how God worked through these teachings.

A brand-new discipleship curriculum called *Living in the Kingdom* was launched, based on this series (be on the lookout for a breakout class coming in February). Oh, that's right—breakout classes... (this is me switching to bullet points so I can cover a lot that took place in 2024):

- Breakout classes: Parenting, Marriage, Finance
- Every "ONE" Matters sermon series,
- We all have a “one” that we are Investing and Inviting into the Kingdom
- Go Sunday
- 3 new 11 AM Sunday School classes
- Over 350 people attended summer small groups
- Continued growth at our Union Campus, including the launch of a youth program
- 195 kids at Start the Party Vacation Bible School
- Over 250 attended ladies' Bible study
- 134 people went through our Starting Point class
- 169 new members thus far
- 56 baptisms (writing this in December—praying for more!)
- 11% increase in worship attendance
- 654,117 meals packed for Kids Against Hunger, 1,929 volunteers
- 1,444 shoeboxes collected for Operation Christmas Child
- A huge turnout for Trunk or Treat
- Four packed-out Christmas plays (1 children's, 3 adults)
- 30% growth in students who attended the CIY summer conference

Agape Women's Services

Agape Women's Services is located at 515 West Walnut Street, Johnson City, TN. Agape means unconditional love. Agape is devoted to loving and serving all clients before, during, and after an unplanned pregnancy. Agape's mission since 1983 has not only been to advocate for life in the womb, but to offer the hope of the gospel to the women and families they walk alongside. Agape offers medical services, educational classes, and Abortion Recovery Care ministry. In 2024, they have had 388 pregnancy tests and 318 ultrasounds, and 1349 client visits. They have had the privilege of walking into conversations surrounding abortion with over 120 women. BCCC has supported Agape through missions and the Baby Bottle fundraiser. The Baby Bottle fundraiser is a way you can support Agape and in turn help those that have an unplanned pregnancy. Baby bottles will be available at the kiosk at the Connection Corner, Entry B, D and K starting January 12th. Pick up a bottle and fill it with your change or check. Return your bottle by February 9th to the Connection Corner. Agape offers tours on the last Wednesday of each month January - October from 3:30 - 4:30 PM. 



As you approach the New Year, write down your goal(s). If you do, you have a 42.1 percent chance of being successful.
