A message from Ben Cole, Senior Minister

This past Sunday, as I was saying my goodbyes at the front door, a gentleman from out of town, who was visiting his aunt, pulled me aside. He said, "I've been in churches all across America, and what you have is special." Naturally, I thanked him and humbly reminded him, "All I do is preach the Scripture." But then he said, "No, not your sermon, YOUR PEOPLE! Look around."

The hallway was packed as we transitioned between services, with so many conversations happening, people greeting and hugging one another, smiles on every face, and just a church full of people truly happy to be there. He continued, "This is what you don't often see—people genuinely loving one another. You are a blessed minister, to have this as your congregation." I replied, "I certainly am!"

So, let me say thank you. God continues to pour out His blessings upon our church, and it seems like He is adding to our number daily, just as He did with the first church we've been studying in the book of Acts. It is right for me to feel this way about all of you, since I have you in my heart." (Phil 1:3-7)

Old and New Diabetes by Dr. Nerissa Licup-Taylor, MD, FACP

March 13, 2025 at 12:00 PM in room 106. Lunch will be provided.

What's going on with Diabetes? Dr. Licup-Taylor will be presenting the Old and New Diabetes. The talk starts with the basics of diagnosing diabetes and the lifestyle changes that are the cornerstone of treatment. This has remained unchanged for years. Then we explore the updates of managing diabetes from new technology like continuous glucose monitoring to the latest medications available.

Dr. Nerissa Licup-Taylor, MD, was born in the Philippines and moved to the Appalachian Highlands to complete her medical residency at East Tennessee State University. Following her residency, she practiced as an internal medicine physician with Ballad Health Medical Associates for over a decade. Interested in geriatric care, she pursued a Geriatric fellowship to enhance her clinical expertise in this field. Her passion for focused geriatric care led her back to Ballad Health Medical Associates' Center for Healthy Aging, where she now provides specialized attention to the aging population. Dr. Licup-Taylor says, "The most important part of caring for her patients is listening to them."
