### A message from Ben Cole, Senior Minister

What a powerful sermon! I hope you've enjoyed the past eight months as much as I have, after we've carefully explored the greatest sermon ever preached—the Sermon on the Mount. Even though our time studying the sermon is complete, our journey of living it out is just beginning.

I truly believe that God has been preparing us for this moment. After spending the last 35 weeks listening to Jesus teach about the Kingdom of God, I have decided to live in that Kingdom. Will you join me? Let's be the light of the world and the salt of the earth right here in the community where God has placed us!

Starting September 15th, we will begin a new sermon series titled, "Every ONE Matters." The 12-week series will explore 12 different accounts of Jesus taking the time to slow down for the ONE—where ONE person's life was radically changed by an interaction with Christ.

My prayer is that as you read the last paragraph, your ONE came to mind. If not, you might have missed my messages over the past few months, where I've encouraged you to pray for your ONE: ONE person in your life who does not know Christ as their Savior; ONE person in your life who needs to hear the Good News of the Gospel; ONE person in your life who needs an interaction with Christ. As we will see from the Scripture, all it takes is ONE encounter with Jesus to change everything.

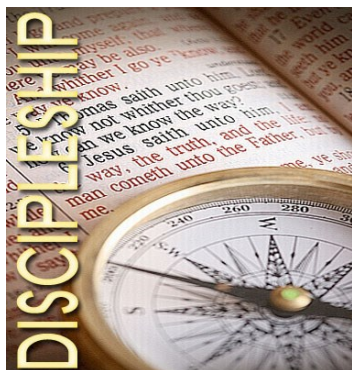
