The “One Thing”

From Today’s Passage: What is the One-Thing you would teach on?
(have each in the group share their one-thing)

Ice Breaker: What movie would you suggest has the best ending?

What elements need to be presented to make it a great ending?

The Bible contains powerful pictures of how this all ends.

Share as a group elements of God’s Promises that make it a great ending.

The study touched on “end-times” as having started with the Ascension of Jesus. Lookup and read the following verses. Discuss their place in our lives now.

Philippians 2:9 - the authority of His Name (in these end-times)

John 14:2 - His love in preparing a place for us (in these end-times)

Colossians 1:18 - As Head of His church (in these end-times)

For any in the group who aren’t “really into all that end-time stuff” how did these verses provide a different / fresh perspective of our living in these ‘end-times’?

The final point of the study focused on Peter’s quotation of Isaiah 40.

Isaiah prophecies to the remnants of Israel in Captivity of their assured return.

Babylon, Assyria and Persia are in defeat or have relinquished Israel to return.

Israel has a lack of assurance in a renewed ‘authorship’ by God of their lives.
