MIDDLE SCHOOL— Small Group Ephesians Lesson #2 “One Family-One Faith”

Summary (KEY TEXT Ephesians 2:13-14 & 3:6)

- This small group lesson taught that through the blood of Christ, those who were once far away have been brought near, and Jesus Himself is our peace. He has broken down every dividing wall and made former outsiders and insiders into one united people. In Christ, Jews and Gentiles now share equally in the promise of the gospel—members of the same body, heirs together, and part of one family through one faith in Him.

HIGH SCHOOL— Large Group Lesson “Are You In Christ?”

Summary (KEY TEXT Ephesians 2:1-10)

- Tonight, Pastor Cam taught that our most important identity is whether we are “in Christ,” because apart from Jesus we are spiritually dead, slaves to sin, and guilty before God. He explained that sin isn’t just mistakes but is also intentional rebellion that leaves us disconnected from God, and unable to fix ourselves. But because of His great love and mercy, God makes us alive, raises us up with Christ, and saves us entirely by grace through faith—not by anything we do.
