



# LARGE GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS



## 2.19.25 & 2.26.25 *Psalm 23*

### Lesson Summary:

Everyone chooses a guide for their life, whether it's friends, social media, or celebrities, and this choice can determine the outcome of our lives. Psalm 23 instructs us to let God guide us, as God offers true satisfaction, protection, and direction.

God, like a shepherd, meets our needs. He provides satisfaction by fulfilling our deepest needs, protection by guiding us through life's dangers, and direction by leading us on the right path. This Psalm urges us to turn to God as our guide, rather than relying on worldly influences, and to trust in His guidance for both life on earth and eternity.

### Key Points:

#### The Point:

Who or what you allow to GUIDE your life can determine the OUTCOME of your life

#### 3 reasons why you should let God guide you...

1. He meets your need for SATISFACTION
2. He meets your need for PROTECTION
3. He meets your need for DIRECTION

What DIRECTION are you headed?

## Discussion Questions:

4. Have you ever experienced a situation where the guidance you received led to a good or bad outcome? What did you learn from that experience?
5. When it comes to facing difficult or dangerous situations, how does knowing that God provides protection (like the shepherd's rod and staff) change your perspective?
6. What are some things or people that you typically rely on to guide your decisions or actions? How can you make sure that you're choosing the right guide?
7. What are some ways God provides satisfaction and comfort in your life? Have you ever found yourself seeking satisfaction in other places, and what was the result?
