

## 5 Day Reading Plan - Curiosity Over Judgment

### **Day 1: Luke 24:13-24**

Meditate on the story of Jesus' followers on the road to Emmaus and how they missed recognizing Jesus. Consider the need for curiosity in our interactions with others.

### **Day 2: Proverbs 25:2**

Reflect on the idea that it is the glory of God to conceal things, but the glory of kings is to search things out. Consider how embracing curiosity can lead to a deeper understanding of God, His kingdom, our inner life, and the reasons we react in certain ways.

### **Day 3: Read Proverbs 12:15 and Proverbs 18:2**

Reflect on the dangers of being judgmental and the importance of listening to others instead of just airing our own opinions. Consider practical ways to prioritize curiosity and understanding over passing judgment on others.

### **Day 4: Read Proverbs 29:9**

Reflect on the futility of arguments with those who are not open to discussion or are unwilling to consider different perspectives. Consider how to discern whether a conversation is worth engaging in or if it would be more productive to disengage.

### **Day 5: Read Romans 12:16**

Reflect on the qualities described in this passage. Consider the importance of prioritizing relationship over winning arguments.
