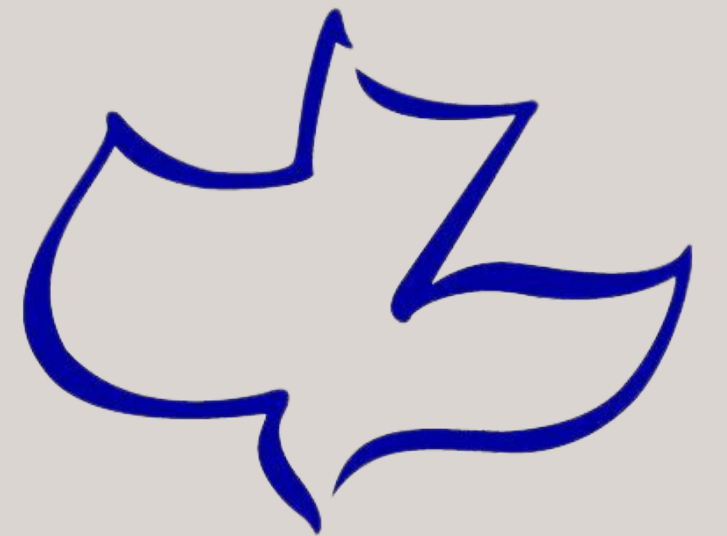


The Name of God & it's Meaning

Name of God: YHWH

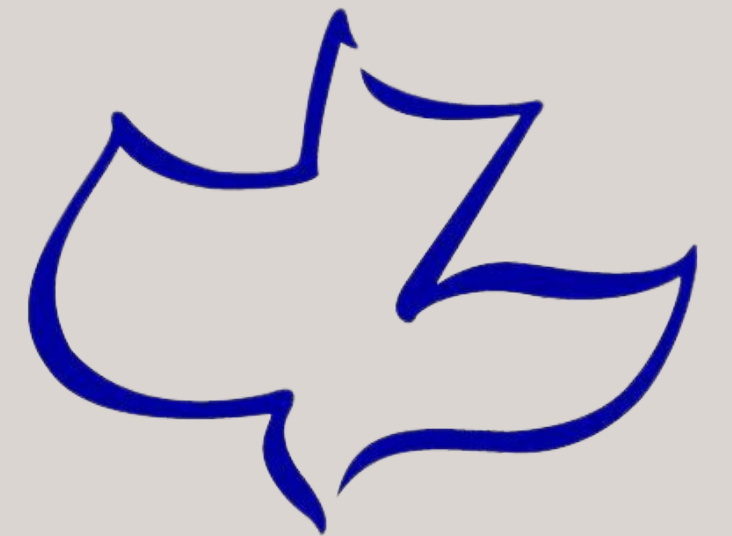
Pronunciation: yeh-ho-vaw'

Part of Speech: proper noun with reference to deity



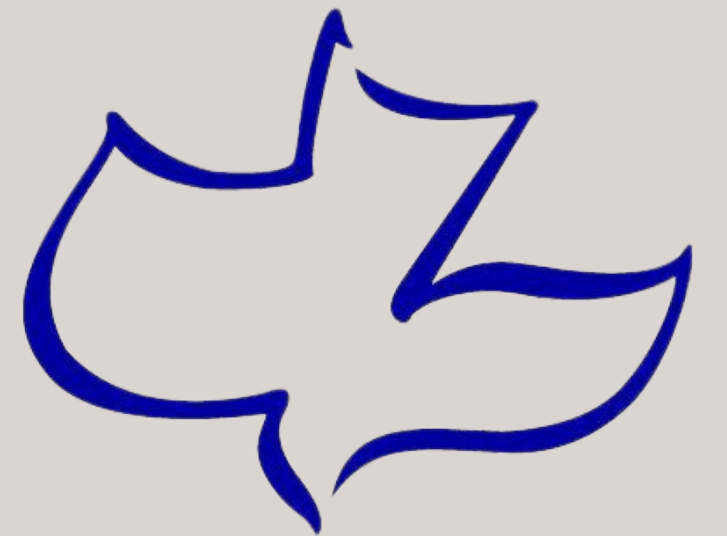

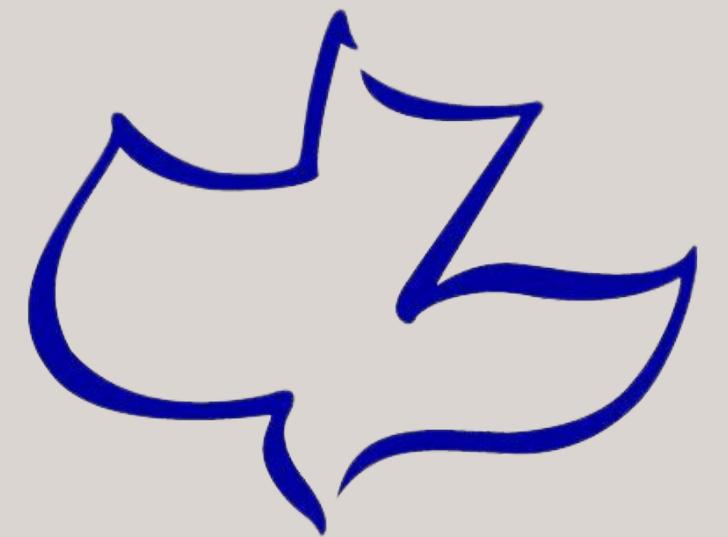

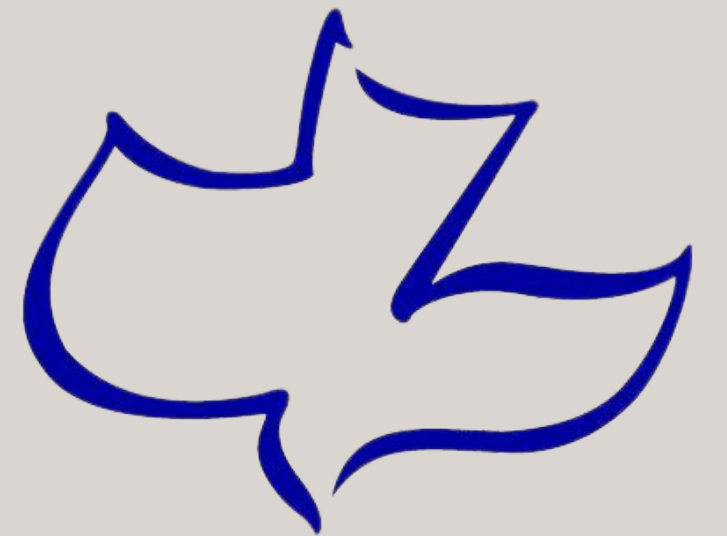


In His Name

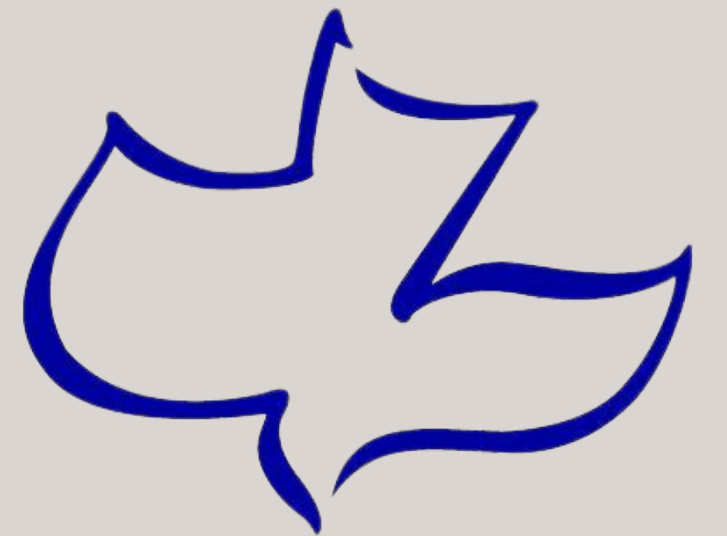

Ask Anything

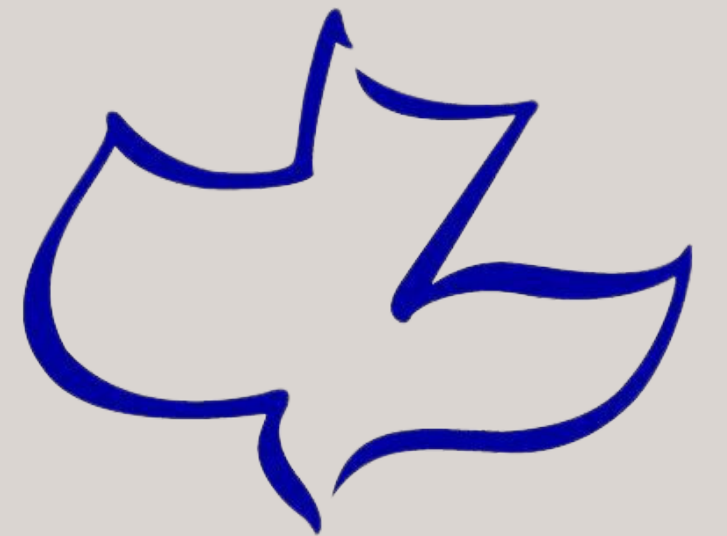
12 “Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me,

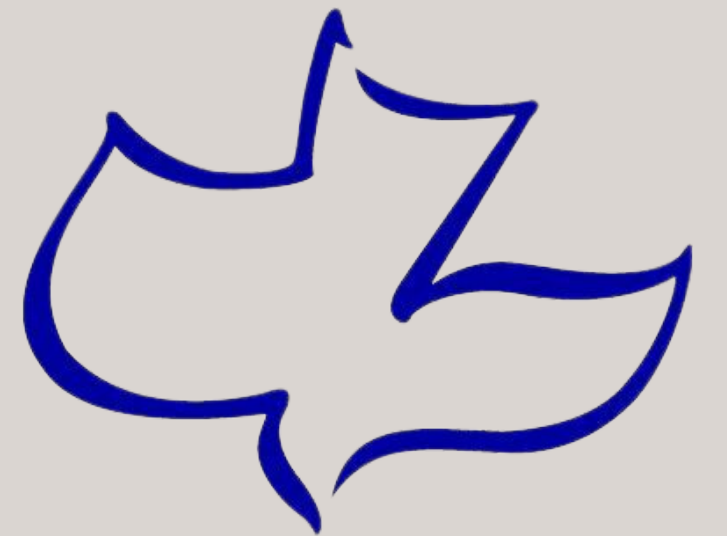

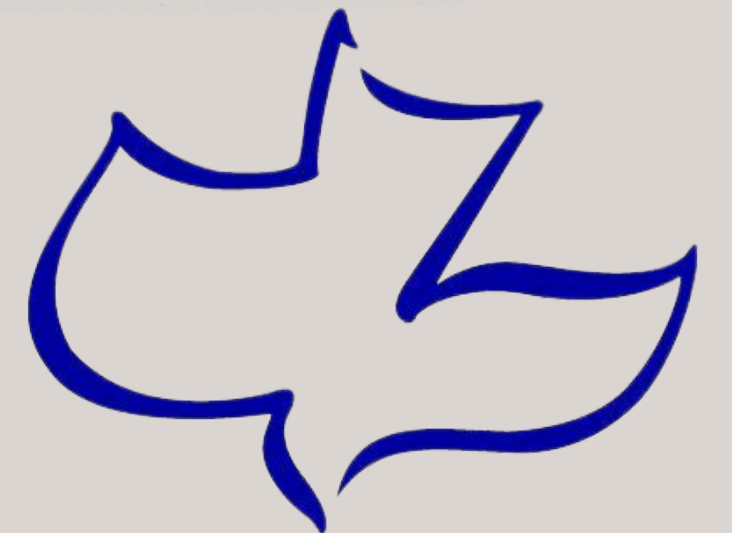

Paul's Day

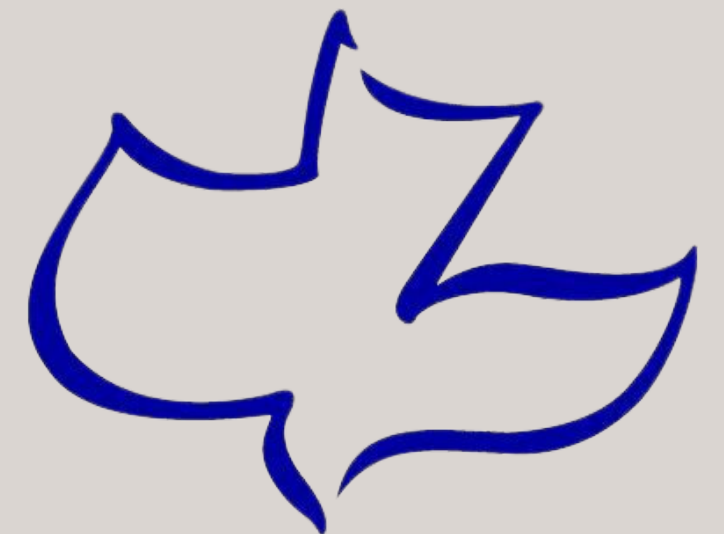


Modern Day



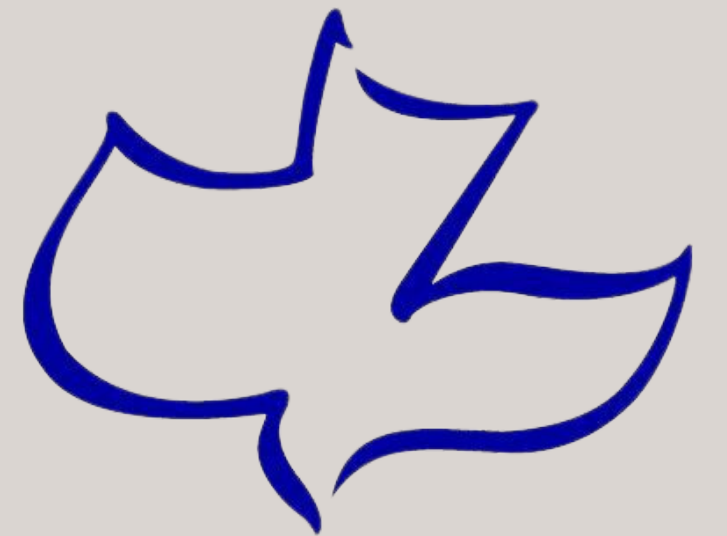

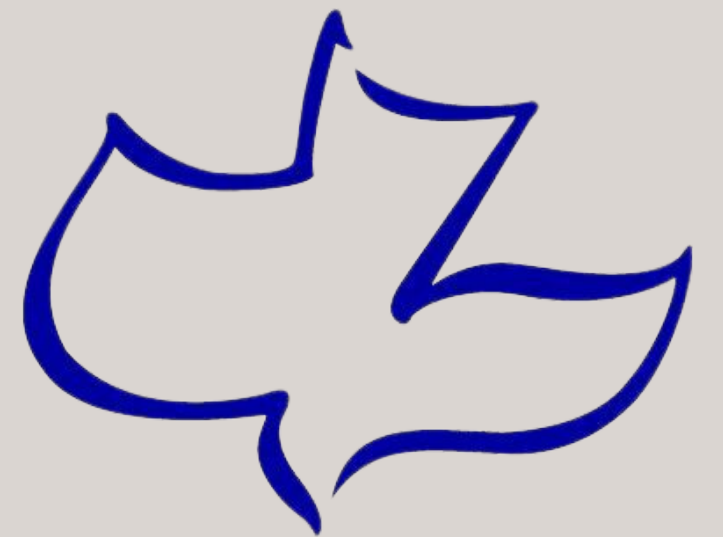
