GOD'S DESIGN

"Before I formed you in the womb, I knew you." — **Jeremiah 1:5**

Before politics, before policy, before public debate, there was God's design. Life began with His breath and still bears His image. God designed the womb to be safe. Humankind has made the womb one of the most dangerous places on earth for a baby to be in.

In America abortions numbers are up, abortion is being sold online, women are the victims of evil people forcing or fooling them into taking abortion drugs, pregnant women have become their own abortionist, men and women unknowingly serve as coroner of their own babies. While all this is happening, the church is becoming more silent on the issue than ever. Christians have a false sense that the battle for life in the womb has ended. They don't know the truth, no one is telling them. In our post-Roe v Wade slumber, we assume all is well. No news is good news, right? Wrong. Now is not the time to go silent. While we sleep our enemy is gaining ground. If not now, when? If not you, then who?

What can you do?

Plan now to share a pro-life message on Sanctity of Human Life Sunday.

In America, an estimated 1-2 abortions occur every minute. On average, a church may have 20-30 minutes of worship music. In that amount of time, possibly 60 babies' lives would have been ended.

Consider dedicated 2-3 minutes of that time to silence in remembrance of those babies.

Plan a night of prayer.

Reach out to the pregnancy center and see what their needs are.

Do a church wide baby bottle campaign.

Remember those that have been hurt by abortion decisions.

He heals the brokenhearted and binds up their wounds. **Psalms 137:3 (NKJV)**

The sanctity of human life isn't only about protecting life in the womb...it's about healing life outside it.

Every statistic has a story. Every wound has a name. We must be a Church that not only speaks against death but also walks with the wounded toward restoration.
