

Pastor Roy's Study Questions on Luke 11:24-54 (February 1, 2026)

— *Below are questions to help further our understanding of today's sermon.* —

1. How can we discern whether we are truly hearing and applying God's Word in our lives, rather than just listening to it and walking away unchanged?
2. What does it mean to keep our spiritual house protected after deliverance, and how can we actively fill our lives with God's presence rather than leaving room for darkness to return?
3. In what ways might we be seeking signs from God while simultaneously ignoring the clear evidence of His work that is already present in our lives?
4. How does the comparison between the Queen of Sheba seeking Solomon's wisdom and people rejecting Jesus challenge us to recognize and respond to divine wisdom when it is offered to us?
5. What does it mean to be a light in the world, and how can we ensure that we are not covering up or dimming the light of Christ within us through our choices and behaviors?
6. How do we guard our eyes and minds from the darkness of the world while living in a culture that constantly bombards us with images and messages contrary to God's truth?
7. In what ways might we be like the Pharisees, focusing on outward appearances and religious rituals while neglecting the condition of our hearts and genuine love for God?
8. How can we avoid placing heavy burdens on others in the name of religion while refusing to help carry those burdens ourselves, and what does true spiritual leadership look like?
9. What is the difference between being a hearer of the Word and a doer of the Word, and how can we practically move from passive listening to active obedience in our daily lives?
10. How does understanding that Jesus died for our sins and rose again to give us eternal life transform the way we approach communion and our ongoing relationship with Him?
