

Pastor Roy's Study Questions on Matthew 24:1-28 (February 11, 2026)

— *Below are questions to help further our understanding of Wednesday's Sermon.* —

1. How can we develop stronger discernment to recognize false teachers in our modern church culture, especially when they may be entertaining or have large followings?
2. Jesus warns that many will fall away during tribulation and persecution. What practical steps can believers take today to strengthen their faith so they can endure until the end?
3. The disciples asked about signs of the end times, yet Jesus emphasized that even wars, famines, and earthquakes are just the beginning of birth pains. How should this perspective shape our response to current world events?
4. What does it mean that the love of many will grow cold because of increased lawlessness, and how do you see this manifesting in society today?
5. The sermon challenges the once saved always saved doctrine by pointing to Matthew 24:10 where many will fall away. How does this tension between eternal security and perseverance affect your understanding of salvation?
6. Jesus said the gospel must be proclaimed throughout the whole world before the end comes. What role do modern technology and global missions play in fulfilling this prophecy?
7. Why do you think people continue to fall for false prophets and false christs despite Jesus warning us about them nearly two thousand years ago?
8. The passage describes the abomination of desolation as a future event requiring immediate flight without looking back. What does this urgency teach us about the seriousness of end times judgment?
9. How can believers maintain hope and faithfulness knowing that the tribulation period will be the worst suffering the world has ever experienced?
10. When Christ returns, it will be unmistakable like lightning flashing across the sky. How should the certainty and visibility of His return impact the way we live today?
