Two Kinds of Trust (Part 2)

T- TAKE IT TO GOD

Why do you think prayer so often becomes a last resort instead of a first response?

R - REMEMBER WHO HE IS

How does fear tend to distort our view of God when pressure is high?

What helps you remember who God is when fear is loud?

U - UNLOAD YOUR HEART

Why is it sometimes easier to hide pain than to bring it honestly to God?

S - SEEK HIS HELP

What's the difference between asking God for help and trying to control the outcome ourselves?

T - TRUST GOD'S GLORY WITH THE OUTCOME

Why is it difficult to release outcomes to God instead of protecting our reputation or expectations?

Over the course of the Hezekiah series, where have you noticed God inviting you to trust Him more deeply?

What would it look like to take one small step of trust this week - even if the wall doesn't move?
