

Frisco Bible Summer Mission Internship Position



PURPOSE

An opportunity to gain practical ministry experience, work within an environment of personal and professional guidance and support, test gifts and calling for vocational ministry, and grow spiritually and theologically. For the church, the intern offers practical help and energy to mission efforts, provides additional relational ministry to our congregation, and serves as a role model for our church.

ACCOUNTABLE TO

The mission intern will be accountable to the Missions Director.

INTERNSHIP DESCRIPTION

The overall goal is to present and demonstrate the gospel of Jesus Christ within the scope of missions; to encourage growth through studying scripture, prayer, service, and fellowship.

Specific activities include:

- Plan and execute activities for the Summer Lunch Program (SLP) & serve as the Bright Academy coordinator for the week Frisco Bible Church serves in SLP. Serve with the monthly local mission teams (CHF food packs, Laundry Love, Beehive Nursing Home, & Showers of Blessings).
- Meet regularly with the Director to pray, plan, communicate, and evaluate.
- Assist the Director in planning and executing mission ministry programs. These include special events, retreats, urban projects, and travel ministries.
- Lead social media & any talents that the intern can bring into the internship.
- Maintain personal, spiritual, and professional growth alongside assigned mentor.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Growing commitment to the Christian faith, the body of Christ, and God's work in the world.
- Ability to work effectively with others, exhibiting creativity, understanding, flexibility, and patience.
- Ability to verbally articulate personal faith and a Christian worldview.
- Potential applicants will need to complete an. Applicants will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis. 

TIME and TRAVEL COMMITMENT

The internship will begin at the end of May and run through June and July, with completion by mid-August. The director will consider vacations, summer school, etc.

The internship will require approximately ten hours per week, including Monday mornings and Wednesday or Friday afternoons, some Saturdays and other single days or evenings.

HOUSING AND COMPENSATION

Arrangements can be made for on-site housing at the intern's expense. Currently, this internship is non-paid. However, interns can participate in our summer mission trip at half the cost. Additionally, interns will have the opportunity to meet with our elder board, connect with a spiritual mentor, and join all Frisco Bible staff events during the internship.
