FBB1-5-01: The Deity and Divine Nature of God – Introduction

The Deity and Divine Nature of God:

The Godhead

This course will cover the Deity and Divine Nature of God Chronologically and cover Christ by the Ages. To comprehend the mystery of Godliness, one must first understand that God existed before His Creation. God created all things in heaven and in earth; this includes time, matter, spiritual and natural realms (and all that exist within them). God spoke things into existence, therefore God's Word existed before His words caused creation to fulfill His will.

From the Ages of creation, come definable eras that establish various time segments that God had ordained from the foundation of creation. There are several ages that are clearly defined throughout the scriptures, but we will focus on the ages that define the Godhead towards His creation. The ages that define the creation itself (the seven days of creation) do not define the Godhead itself and will not be studied in this work.

One should try to avoid assuming pre-determined doctrines (Trinity or Monotheisms) and let the understanding evolve from the chronological revelations that are evident in the scriptures from Creation to modern-day. This way every student of the scripture will understand what the people understood during the time of their lives as the scripture gives account of their testimony based on the understanding of that day.

Godhead: (Greek 2305 - as used in *Romans 1:20*) theiotes thi-ot'-ace from 2304; divinity (abstractly):--godhead.

Romans 1:20 For the invisible things of him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, *even* his eternal power and Godhead; so that they are without excuse:

Acts 17:29-30 Forasmuch then as we are the offspring of God, we ought not to think that the Godhead is like unto gold, or silver, or stone, graven by art and man's device. 30 And the times of this ignorance God winked at; but now commandeth all men every where to repent:

Colossians 2:8-9 Beware lest any man spoil you through philosophy and vain deceit, after the tradition of men, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Christ. 9 For in him dwelleth all the fulness of the Godhead bodily.
