## FBB1-5-04: The Deity and Divine Nature of God – The God of the Forefathers

### The God of the Forefathers

#### God of Adam

**Genesis 1:26-27** And **God said**, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth. 27 So **God created man** in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them.

**Genesis 2:5-7** And every plant of the field before it was in the earth, and every herb of the field before it grew: for the **LORD God** had not caused it to rain upon the earth, and *there was not a man to till the ground*. 6 But there went up a mist from the earth, and watered the whole face of the ground. 7 And the **LORD God formed man** of the dust of the ground, and **breathed into his nostrils the breath of life**; and man became a **living soul**.

**Genesis 5:1-3** This is the book of the generations of **Adam**. In the day that **God created man**, in the likeness of God made he him; 2 **Male and female created he them**; and blessed them, and called **their name Adam**, in the day when they were created. 3 And Adam lived an hundred and thirty years, and begat a **son in his own likeness**, after **his image**; and called his name **Seth**:

*God of Noah:*

**Genesis 6:5-9** And **GOD** saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and *that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually*. 6 And it repented **the LORD that he had made man on the earth**, and it grieved him at his heart. 7 And the **LORD** said, I will destroy **man whom I have created** from the face of the earth; both man, and beast, and the creeping thing, and the fowls of the air; for it repenteth me that I have made them. 8 But Noah found grace in the eyes of the **LORD**. 9 These are the generations of Noah: Noah was a just man *and perfect in his generations, and Noah walked with God*.

**Genesis 9:12-17** And **God said**, This is the token of the covenant which I make between me and you and every living creature that is with you, for perpetual generations: 13 **I do set my bow in the cloud, and it shall be for a token of a covenant between me and the earth**. 14 And it shall come to pass, when I bring a cloud over the earth, that the bow shall be seen in the cloud: 15 And **I will remember my covenant**, which is between me and you and every living creature of all flesh; and the waters shall no more become a flood to destroy all flesh. 16 And the bow shall be in the cloud; and I will look upon it, that I may remember the everlasting covenant **between God and every living creature** of all flesh that is upon the earth. 17 And **God** said unto Noah, This is the token of the covenant, which I have established between me and all flesh that is upon the earth.

**Hebrews 11:7** By faith Noah, **being warned of God** of things not seen as yet, moved with fear, prepared an ark to the saving of his house; **by the which** he condemned the world, and became **heir of the righteousness which is by faith**.

*God of Abraham:*

**Genesis 17:1-8** And when Abram was ninety years old and nine, the **LORD** appeared to Abram, and said unto him, **I am the Almighty God**; walk before me, and be thou perfect. 2 And **I will make my covenant between me and thee**, and will multiply thee exceedingly. 3 And Abram fell on his face: **and God talked with him**, saying, 4 As for me, behold, my covenant is with thee, and thou shalt be a father of many nations. 5 Neither



shall thy name any more be called Abram, but thy name shall be Abraham; for a father of many nations have I made thee. 6 And I will make thee exceeding fruitful, and I will make nations of thee, and kings shall come out of thee. 7 And I will establish my covenant between me and thee and thy seed after thee in their generations for an everlasting covenant, **to be a God unto thee**, and to thy seed after thee. 8 And I will give unto thee, and to thy seed after thee, the land wherein thou art a stranger, all the land of Canaan, for an everlasting possession; **and I will be their God**.

**James 2:23** And the scripture was fulfilled which saith, **Abraham believed God**, and it was imputed unto him for righteousness: and he was called **the Friend of God**.

#### *God of Isaac*

**Genesis 17:19-21** And God said, Sarah thy wife shall bear thee a son indeed; and thou shalt call his name **Isaac: and I will establish my covenant with him** for an everlasting covenant, *and* with his seed after him. 20 And as for Ishmael, I have heard thee: Behold, I have blessed him, and will make him fruitful, and will multiply him exceedingly; twelve princes shall he beget, and I will make him a great nation. 21 But **my covenant will I establish with Isaac**, which Sarah shall bear unto thee at this set time in the next year.

#### *God of Jacob (Israel)*

**Genesis 28:10-15** And Jacob went out from Beerâ€“sheba, and went toward Haran. 11 And he lighted upon a certain place, and tarried there all night, because the sun was set; and he took of the stones of that place, and put *them* for his pillows, and lay down in that place to sleep. 12 And he dreamed, and behold a ladder set up on the earth, and the top of it reached to heaven: and behold **the angels of God ascending and descending on it**. 13 And, behold, **the LORD stood above it**, and said, **I am the LORD God of Abraham thy father, and the God of Isaac**: the land whereon thou liest, to thee will I give it, and to thy seed; 14 And thy seed shall be as the dust of the earth, and thou shalt spread abroad to the west, and to the east, and to the north, and to the south: and in thee and in thy seed shall all the families of the earth be blessed. 15 And, behold, **I am with thee**, and will keep thee in all *places* whither thou goest, and will bring thee again into this land; for I will not leave thee, until I have done *that* which I have spoken to thee of.

#### *The God of Moses*

**Exodus 3:6** Moreover he said, **I am the God of thy father, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob**. And Moses hid his face; for he was afraid to **look upon God**.

**Exodus 3:13-15** And Moses said unto God, Behold, *when* I come unto the children of Israel, and shall say unto them, **The God of your fathers** hath sent me unto you; and they shall say to me, *What is his name?* what shall I say unto them? 14 And **God said unto Moses, I AM THAT I AM**: and he said, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, **I AM** hath sent me unto you. 15 And God said moreover unto Moses, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, **The LORD God of your fathers, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob**, hath sent me unto you: this *is* my name for ever, and **this is my memorial unto all generations**.
