### FBB1-5-06: The Deity and Divine Nature of God – God of the Prophets

#### God of the Prophets

*The Prophets foretold of how God would raise up His Christ. The last of these prophets was John the Baptist. When Christ came, a new age was birthed: the age of the Kingdom of God.*

**Numbers 12:6** And he said, Hear now my words: If there be a prophet among you, **/the LORD will make myself known unto him** in a vision, *and* will speak unto him in a dream.

**Deuteronomy 18:15** The LORD thy **God will raise up** unto thee a Prophet from the midst of thee, of thy brethren, like unto me; unto him ye shall hearken;

**1 Samuel 9:8-9** And the servant answered Saul again, and said, Behold, I have here at hand the fourth part of a shekel of silver: *that* will I give to the man of God, to tell us our way. 9 (Beforetime in Israel, when a man went **to enquire of God**, thus he spake, Come, and let us go to the seer: for *he that is now called* a Prophet was beforetime called a Seer.)

**Luke 7:28** For I say unto you, Among those that are born of women there is not a greater **prophet** than John the Baptist: but he that is least in the kingdom of God is greater than he.

**Luke 16:16** The law and the **prophets were until John**: since that time the kingdom of God is preached, and every man presseth into it.
