**Luke 1:26-38** And in the sixth month the **angel Gabriel was sent from God** unto a city of Galilee, named Nazareth, 27 To a virgin espoused to a man whose name was Joseph, of the house of David; and the virgin's name was Mary. 28 And the angel came in unto her, and said, Hail, *thou that art* highly favoured, **the Lord is** with thee: blessed *art thou* among women. 29 And when she saw *him*, she was troubled at his saying, and cast in her mind what manner of salutation this should be. 30 And the angel said unto her, Fear not, Mary: for thou hast found **favour with God**. 31 And, behold, thou shalt conceive in thy womb, and bring forth a son, and shalt call his name JESUS. 32 He shall be great, and shall be called **the Son of the Highest**: and the **Lord God shall give unto him** the throne of his father David: 33 And **he shall reign** over the house of Jacob for **ever**; and of **his kingdom there shall be no end**.

34 Then said Mary unto the angel, How shall this be, seeing I know not a man?

35 And the angel answered and said unto her, **The Holy Ghost shall come upon thee**, and the **power** of the Highest shall **overshadow thee**: therefore also **that holy thing** which shall be **born of thee** shall be called **the Son of God**. 36 And, behold, thy cousin Elisabeth, she hath also conceived a son in her old age: and this is the sixth month with her, who was called barren. 37 For with God nothing shall be impossible.

38 And Mary said, Behold the handmaid of the Lord; be it unto me according to thy word. And the angel departed from her.

**Hebrews 2:8-11** Thou hast put all things in subjection under his feet. For in that he put all in subjection under him, he left nothing *that is* not put under him. But now we see not yet all things put under him. 9 But **we see Jesus**, who **was made** a little lower than the angels **for the suffering of death**, crowned with glory and honour; that **he** by the grace of God should taste death for every man. 10 For **it became him**, for whom **are all** things, and by whom **are all** things, in bringing many sons unto glory, to make the captain of their salvation perfect through sufferings. 11 For both **he that sanctifieth** and **they who are sanctified** **are all of one**: for which cause he is not ashamed to call them brethren,

**John 1:14** And the **Word** was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of **the only begotten of the Father**,) full of grace and truth.

**Ephesians 3:9-11** And to make all *men* see what *is* the fellowship of the mystery, which **from the beginning of the world** hath been hid in God, who created all things **by Jesus Christ**: 10 To the intent that **now** unto the **principalities and powers**
