Psalms 98:1-3 O sing unto the LORD a new song; for he hath done marvelous things: **his right hand, and his holy arm**, hath gotten him **the victory**. 2 The LORD hath made known his salvation: his righteousness hath he openly shewed in the sight of the heathen. 3 He hath remembered his mercy and his truth toward the house of Israel: all the ends of the earth have seen the salvation of our God.

Psalms 110:1 The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit thou at **my right hand**, until I make thine enemies thy footstool.

2 Corinthians 5:18-19 And all things *are* of God, who hath **reconciled us to himself** by Jesus Christ, and hath given to us the ministry of reconciliation; 19 To wit, that **God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto himself**, not imputing their trespasses unto them; and hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation.

Ephesians 1:20-21 Which **he wrought in Christ**, when he raised him from the dead, and **set him at his own right hand** in the heavenly *places*, 21 Far above all principality, and power, and might, and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this world, but also in that which is to come:

Titus 2:11-14 For the grace of God that bringeth salvation hath appeared to all men, 12 Teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly, in this present world; 13 Looking for that blessed hope, and the glorious appearing of the **great God** and our **Saviour Jesus Christ**; 14 **Who gave himself for us**, that **he** might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify **unto himself** a peculiar people, zealous of good works.

Deuteronomy 14:1-2 Ye *are* the children of the LORD your God: ye shall not cut yourselves, nor make any baldness between your eyes for the dead. 2 For thou *art* an holy people unto the LORD thy God, and **the LORD hath chosen thee to be a peculiar people unto himself**, above all the nations that *are* upon the earth.

2 Samuel 7:22-24 Wherefore thou art great, O LORD God: for *there is* none like thee, neither *is there any* God beside thee, according to all that we have heard with our ears. 23 And what one nation in the earth *is* like thy people, *even* like Israel, whom **God went to redeem for a people to himself**, and to make him a name, and to do for you great things and terrible, for thy land, before thy people, which thou redeemedst to thee from Egypt, *from* the nations and their gods? 24 For thou hast confirmed to thyself thy
