God is the First and the Last

Isaiah 41:4 Who hath wrought and done it, calling the generations from the beginning? **I the LORD, the first, and with the last; I am he.**

Isaiah 44:6-8 Thus saith the LORD the King of Israel, and his redeemer the LORD of hosts; **I am the first, and I am the last; and beside me there is no God.** 7 And who, as I, shall call, and shall declare it, and set it in order for me, since I appointed the ancient people? and the things that are coming, and shall come, let them shew unto them. 8 Fear ye not, neither be afraid: have not I told thee from that time, and have declared *it*? ye *are* even my witnesses. Is there a God beside me? yea, *there is* no God; I know not *any*.

Isaiah 48:12-13 Hearken unto me, O Jacob and Israel, my called; **I am he; I am the first, I also am the last.** 13 Mine hand also hath laid the foundation of the earth, and **my right hand** hath spanned the heavens: *when* I call unto them, they stand up together.

God is redeeming His people through His right arm Christ Jesus. None other than God manifested in (through) the flesh. God is fulfilling His covenant made in the Old Testament, though Christ.

Revelation 1:9-11 I John, who also am your brother, and companion in tribulation, and in the kingdom and patience of Jesus Christ, was in the isle that is called Patmos, for the word of God, and for the testimony of Jesus Christ. 10 I was in the Spirit on the Lord's day, and heard behind me a great voice, as of a trumpet, 11 Saying, **I am Alpha and Omega, the first and the last:** and, What thou seest, write in a book, and send *it* unto the seven churches which are in Asia; unto Ephesus, and unto Smyrna, and unto Pergamos, and unto Thyatira, and unto Sardis, and unto Philadelphia, and unto Laodicea.

Revelation 1:17-18 And when I saw him, I fell at his feet as dead. And he laid his right hand upon me, saying unto me, Fear not; **I am the first and the last:** 18 *I am* he that liveth, and **was dead;** and, behold, **I am alive for evermore,** Amen; and have the keys of hell and of death.

Jesus Christ will be the final judge and the last word. The Realm of Christ had a beginning and has an upcoming ending. His beginning was prophesied before He was born of a woman. The start of Christ came in the flesh as the holy thing born of Mary. The end of the Reign of Christ will come when He shall have put down all rule and
