The Father to Son Relationship

Isaiah 63:16 Doubtless thou *art* our father, though Abraham be ignorant of us, and Israel acknowledge us not: thou, **O LORD, art our father**, our redeemer; thy name *is* from everlasting.

2 Samuel 7:14 **I will be his father, and he shall be my son.** If he commit iniquity, I will chasten him with the rod of men, and with the stripes of the children of men:

Jeremiah 3:19 But I said, How shall I put thee among the children, and give thee a pleasant land, a goodly heritage of the hosts of nations? and I said, **Thou shalt call me, My father;** and shalt not turn away from me.

Malachi 2:10 Have we not all **one father? hath not one God created us?** why do we deal treacherously every man against his brother, by profaning the covenant of our fathers?

Psalms 89:26-29 He shall cry unto me, **Thou art my father, my God,** and the rock of my salvation. 27 **Also I will make him my firstborn,** higher than the kings of the earth. 28 My mercy will I keep for him for evermore, and my covenant shall stand fast with him. 29 His seed also will I make *to endure* for ever, and his throne as the days of heaven.

Psalms 2:7 I will declare the decree: the LORD hath said unto me, **Thou art my Son;** this day have I begotten thee.
