God Commits All Judgment unto the Son

Only God Can Forgive Sins

Exodus 34:8-9 And Moses made haste, and bowed his head toward the earth, and worshipped. 9 And he said, If now I have found grace in thy sight, **O Lord**, let my Lord, I pray thee, go among us; for it *is* a stiffnecked people; and **pardon our iniquity and our sin**, and take us for **thine inheritance**.

2 Chronicles 7:12-14 And the LORD appeared to Solomon by night, and said unto him, I have heard thy prayer, and have chosen this place to myself for an house of sacrifice. 13 If I shut up heaven that there be no rain, or if I command the locusts to devour the land, or if I send pestilence among my people; 14 If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will **forgive their sin**, and will heal their land.

Psalms 25:18-22 Look upon mine affliction and my pain; and **forgive all my sins**.
19 Consider mine enemies; for they are many; and they hate me with cruel hatred.
20 **O keep my soul, and deliver me**: let me not be ashamed; for I put my trust in thee.
21 Let integrity and uprightness preserve me; for I wait on thee. 22 **Redeem Israel, O God**, out of all his troubles.

Psalms 130:3-7 If thou, LORD, shouldest mark iniquities, O Lord, who shall stand?
4 But **there is forgiveness with thee**, that thou mayest be feared. 5 I wait for the LORD, my soul doth wait, and in his word do I hope. 6 My soul *waiteth* for the Lord more than they that watch for the morning: *I say, more than* they that watch for the morning. 7 Let Israel hope in the LORD: for with the LORD *there is* mercy, and with him *is* plenteous **redemption**.
