God Gives Power to Forgive Sins unto the Son

Mark 2:7-11 Why doth this *man* thus speak blasphemies? **who can forgive sins but God only?** 8 And immediately when Jesus perceived in his spirit that they so reasoned within themselves, he said unto them, Why reason ye these things in your hearts? 9 Whether is it easier to say to the sick of the palsy, *Thy sins be forgiven thee*; or to say, Arise, and take up thy bed, and walk? 10 But that ye may know that **the Son of man hath power on earth to forgive sins**, (he saith to the sick of the palsy,) 11 I say unto thee, Arise, and take up thy bed, and go thy way into thine house.

Isaiah 16:4-5 Let mine outcasts dwell with thee, Moab; be thou a covert to them from the face of the spoiler: for **the extortioner is at an end**, the spoiler ceaseth, the oppressors are consumed out of the land. 5 **And in mercy shall the throne be established**: and **he shall sit upon it** in truth in the tabernacle of David, judging, and seeking judgment, and hasting righteousness.

John 3:34-36 For he whom God hath sent speaketh the words of God: for God giveth not the Spirit by measure *unto him*. 35 **The Father loveth the Son, and hath given all things into his hand**. 36 He that believeth on the Son hath everlasting life: and he that believeth not the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of God abideth on him.

John 5:21-30 For as the Father raiseth up the dead, and quickeneth *them*; even so the Son quickeneth **whom he will**. 22 For the Father judgeth no man, but **hath committed all judgment unto the Son**: 23 **That all men** should honour the Son, **even as** they honour the Father. He that honoureth not the Son honoureth not the Father which hath sent him. 24 Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that heareth my word, and believeth on him that sent me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life. 25 Verily, verily, I say unto you, The hour is coming, and now is, when **the dead shall hear the voice of the Son of God**: and they that hear shall live. 26 For as the Father hath life in himself; so hath he given to the Son to have life in himself; 27 And **hath given him** authority to **execute judgment** also, **because** he is **the Son of man**. 28 Marvel not at this: for the hour is coming, in the which all that are in the graves shall hear his voice, 29 And shall come forth; they that have done good, unto the resurrection of life; and they that have done evil, unto the resurrection of damnation. 30 I can of mine own self do nothing: **as I hear, I judge**: and my judgment is **just**; **because** I seek not mine own will, but the will of the Father which hath sent me.

John 13:3 Jesus knowing that **the Father had given all things into his hands**, and that he was come from God, and went to God;



John 17:5-7 And now, **O Father**, glorify thou me with thine own self with the glory which I had with thee before the world was. 6 I have manifested thy name unto the men which thou gavest me out of the world: thine they were, and thou gavest them me; and they have kept thy word. 7 Now they have known **that all things whatsoever thou hast given me are of thee.**

2 Corinthians 5:18-20 And **all things are of God**, who hath reconciled us to himself by Jesus Christ, and hath given to us the ministry of reconciliation; 19 To wit, that **God was in Christ, reconciling** the world unto himself, **not imputing their trespasses unto them**; and hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation. 20 Now then we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God did beseech *you* by us: we pray *you* in Christ's stead, be ye reconciled to God.

2 Peter 1:1-4 Simon Peter, a servant and an apostle of Jesus Christ, to them that have obtained like precious faith with us through **the righteousness of God** and **our Saviour Jesus Christ**: 2 Grace and peace be multiplied unto you through the knowledge of God, and of Jesus our Lord, 3 According as **his divine power** hath given unto us all things that *pertain* unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue: 4 Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye **might be partakers of the divine nature**, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.
