FBB1-5-2-04 The Landmark Covenants – Covenant with David

Covenant with David

The Davidic Covenant provides hope in the promises of God to God's chosen people. In this hope, the chosen - called the children of David - seek a light, a kingdom, a throne and a Messiah (of the seed of David) that will bring this covenant to pass.

2 Samuel 7:12-16 And when the days be fulfilled, and thou shalt sleep with thy fathers, I will set up the seed after thee, which shall proceed out of the bowels, and I will establish his kingdom. 13 He shall build an house for my name, and I will **establish the throne of his kingdom for ever**. 14 I will be his father, and he shall be my son. If he commit iniquity, I will chasten him with the rod of men, and with the stripes of the children of men: 15 But **my mercy shall not depart away from him**, as I took it from Saul, whom I put away before thee. 16 And **thine house and the kingdom shall be established for ever** before thee: **the throne shall be established for ever**.

Psalm 89:3-4, 28-37 I have a covenant with my chosen. **I have sworn unto David my servant.** 4 The seed will I **establish for ever, and build up the throne to all generations.** Selah. 28 My mercy will I keep for him for evermore, and **my covenant shall stand fast with him.** 29 **His seed** also will I make to **endure for ever**, and his throne as the days of heaven. 30 If his children forsake my law, and walk not in my judgements; 31 If they break my statutes, and keep not my commandments; 32 Then will I visit their transgression with the rod, and their iniquity with stripes. 33 Nevertheless **my loving kindness will I not utterly take from him**, nor **suffer my faithfulness to fail.** 34 My covenant will I **not break**, nor alter the thing that is gone out of my lips. 35 Once have I sworn by my holiness that **I will not lie unto David.** 36 **His seed shall endure for ever, and his throne as the sun before me.** 37 It shall be **established for ever as the moon, and as a faithful witness in heaven.** Selah.

Provisions of the Davidic Covenant:

- A. *David's seed (lineage or house) will succeed him and establish his kingdom.*
- B. *David's son Solomon will build the temple instead of David himself.*
- C. *The Kingdom will be forever established.*
- D. *The Throne will not be removed because of the iniquity of men but established through God's loving kindness.*
- E. *David's house, throne and kingdom shall all be established forever.*

There is much to be said regarding the throne in these provisions: the throne and the kingdom described are not made with the hands of men, but by the hands of God. They are spiritual and eternal. Those that look for these provisions to be fulfilled in this worldly and temporary existence will be perpetually frustrated in their understanding.



A. God's promises to David and Israel contained in the Davidic Covenant are eternal and unconditional. God's faithfulness and loving kindness will endure forever. David's seed (house) will establish an eternal kingdom.

David's house will be everlasting and blessed forever. The House may be thought of as his lineage or habitation.

2 Samuel 7:18-29 Then went king David in, and sat before the Lord, and he said, Who am I, O Lord God? and what is my house, that thou hast brought me hitherto? 19 And this was yet a small thing in thy sight, O Lord God; but thou hast spoken also of thy servant's house for a great while to come. And is this the manner of man, O Lord God? 20 And what can David say more unto thee? for thou, Lord God, knowest thy servant. 21 For thy word's sake, and according to thine own heart, hast thou done all these great things, to make thy servant know them. 22 Wherefore thou art great, O Lord God: for there is none like thee, neither is there any God beside thee, according to all that we have heard with our ears. 23 **And what one nation in the Earth is like thy people, even like Israel, whom God went to redeem for a people to himself**, and to make him a name, and to do for you great things and terrible, for the land, before the people, which thou redeemed to thee from Egypt, from the nation's and their God's? 24 For thou hast confirmed to thyself thy people Israel to be a people unto thee for ever: and thou, Lord, art become their God. 25 And now, O Lord God, the word that thou hast spoken concerning thy servant, and concerning his house, establish it for ever, and do as thou hast said. 26 And let thy name be magnified for ever, saying, The Lord of hosts is the God over Israel: and let the house of thy servant David be established before thee. 27 For thou, O Lord of hosts, God of Israel, hast revealed to thy servant, saying, I will build thee an house: there fore hath the servant found in his heart to pray this prayer unto thee. 28 And now, O Lord God, thou art that God, and thy words be true, and thou hast promised this goodness unto thy servant: 29 Therefore now let it please thee to bless the house of thy servant, that it may continue for ever before thee: for thou, O Lord God, hast spoken it: and with thy blessing let the house of thy servant be blessed for ever.

2 Chronicles 6:14-16 And said, O Lord God of Israel, there is no God like thee in the heaven, nor in the earth; **which keepeth covenant**, and shewest mercy unto thy servants, that walk before thee with all their hearts: 15 Thou which hast kept with thy servant David my father that **which thou hast promised him**; and spakest with thy mouth, and hast fullfilled it with thine hand, as it is this day. 16 Now therefore, O Lord God of Israel, keep with thy servant David my father that which thou hast promised him, saying, **there shall not fail thee a man in my sight to sit upon the throne** of Israel; yet so that thy children take heed to their way to walk in my law, as thou hast walked before me.

The birth of the coming Messiah, Jesus Christ, the Son of the Highest, whom God will give his throne to, is foretold. The angel of God announced to Mary that the eternal throne of David would be given to her child - forever.



Luke 1:31-33 And behold, thou shalt conceive in the womb, and bring forth a son, and shalt call his name JESUS. 32 He shall be great, and shall be called the Son of the Highest: and the **Lord God shall give unto him the throne of his father David:** 33 And he shall reign over the house of Jacob for ever: and of his kingdom there shall be no end.

Matthew 1:1 The book of the generation of **Jesus Christ, the son of David**, the Son of Abraham.

Psalms 110:1 The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit thou at my right hand, until I make thine enemies thy footstool.

Matthew 22:41-46 While the Pharisees were gathered together, Jesus asked them, 42 Saying, **What think ye of Christ?** whose son is he? They say unto him, **The Son of David.** 43 He saith unto them, How then doth David in spirit call him Lord, saying, 44 The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit thou on my right hand, till I make thine enemies thy footstool? 45 If David then call him Lord, how is he his son? 46 And no man was able to answer him a word, neither durst any *man* from that day forth ask him any more *questions*.

B. David speaks to Solomon about building the temple of God.

1 Chronicles 22:6-11 Then he called for Solomon his son, and charged him to build an house for the Lord God of Israel. 7 And David said to Solomon, My son, as for me, it was in my mind to build an house unto the name of the Lord my God. 8 But the word of the Lord came to me, saying, Thou hast shed blood abundantly, and hast made great wars: thou shalt not build an house unto my name, because thou hast shed much blood upon the earth in my sight. 9 Behold, a son shall be born to thee, who shall be a man of rest; and I will give him rest from all his enemies round about: for his name shall be Solomon, and I will give peace and quietness unto Israel in his days. 10 He shall build an house for my name; and he shall be my son, and I will be his father; and **I will establish the throne of his kingdom over Israel for ever.** 11 Now, my son, the Lord be with thee; and prosper thou, and build the house of the Lord thy God, as he hath said of thee.

1 Chronicles 28:5-8 And of my sons, (for the Lord hath given me many sons,) he hath chosen Solomon my son **to sit upon the throne of the kingdom of the Lord** over Israel. 6 And he said unto me, Solomon thy son, he shall build my house and my courts; for I have chosen him to be my son, and I will be his father. 7 Moreover I will establish his kingdom for ever, if he be constant to do my commandments and my judgements, as at this day. 8 Now therefore in the sight of all Israel the congregation of the Lord, and in the audience of our God, keep and seek for all the commandments of the Lord your God: that ye may possess this good land, and leave it for an inheritance for your children after you for ever.



Prophecy concerning the Christ (son & seed of David), would establish the rest and peace of the Lord.

1 Chronicles 22:9-10 Behold, **a son shall be born to thee**, who shall be a **man of rest**; and I will give him **rest from all his enemies** round about: for his name shall be Solomon, and **I will give peace and quietness** unto Israel in his days. 10 He shall build an house for my name; and he shall be my son, and I will be his father; and I will establish the throne of his kingdom over Israel for ever.

Isaiah 9:7 Of the increase of **his government** and **peace** *there shall be* no end, upon the throne of David, and upon his kingdom, to order it, and to establish it with judgment and with justice from henceforth even for ever. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will perform this.

Matthew 11:27-30 All things are delivered unto me of my Father: and no man knoweth the Son, but the Father; neither knoweth any man the Father, save the Son, and *he* to whomsoever the Son will reveal *him*. 28 Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and **I will give you rest**. 29 Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find **rest unto your souls**. 30 For **my yoke is easy**, and my burden is light.

The work on the house of God is completed, and the ark of the Covenant is brought into the house of God.

2 Chronicles 8:7-18 As for all the people that were left of the Hittites, and the Amorites, and the Perizzites, and the Hivites, and the Jebusites, which were not of Israel. 8 But of their children, who were left after them in the land, whom the children of Israel consumed not, them did Solomon make to pay tribute until this day. 9 But of the children of Israel did Solomon make no servants for his work; but they were men of war, and chief of his captains, and captains of his chariots and horsemen. 10 And these were the chief of king Solomon's officers, even two hundred and fifty, that bare rule over the people. 11 And Solomon brought up the daughter of Pharaoh out of the city of David unto the house that he had built for her: for he said, My wife shall not dwell **in the house of David king of Israel, because the places are holy, whereunto the ark of the Lord hath come**. 12 Then Solomon offered burnt offerings unto the Lord on the alter of the Lord, which he had built before the porch. 13 Even after certain rate every day, offering according to the commandment of Moses, on the Sabbath's, and on the new moons, and on the solemn feasts, three times in the year, even in the feast of unleavened bread, and in the feast of weeks, and in the feast of tabernacles. 14 And he appointed, according to the order of David his father, the courses of the priests to their service, and the Levites to their charges, to praise and minister before the priests, as the duty of every day required: the Porter's also by their courses at every gate: for so had David the man of God commanded. 15 And they departed not from the commandment of the king unto the priests and Levites concerning any matter, or concerning the treasures. 16 Now all the work of Solomon was prepared unto the day of the foundation of the house of the Lord, and until it was finished. So the house of the



Lord was perfected. 17 Then went Solomon to Eziongeber, and to Eloth, at the sea side in the land of Edom. 18 And Huram sent him by the hands of his servants ships, and servants that had knowledge of the sea; and they went with the servants of Solomon to Ophir, and took thence four hundred and fifty talents of gold, and brought them to king Solomon.

C. The Kingdom that the Messiah will bring will be eternal and not be of this world.

John 18:34-37 Jesus answered him, Sayest thou this thing of thyself, or did others tell it thee of me? 35 Pilate answered, Am I a Jew? Thine own nation and the chief priests have delivered thee unto me: what hast thou done? 36 Jesus answered, **My kingdom is not of this world: if my kingdom were of this world, then would my servants fight**, that I should not be delivered to the Jews: **but now is my kingdom not from hence.** 37 Pilate therefore said unto him, Art thou a king then? Jesus answered, Thou sayest that I am a king. To this end was I born, and for this cause came I into the world, that I should bear witness unto the truth. Every one that is of the truth heareth my voice.

John 18:10-11 Then Simon Peter having a sword drew it, and smote the high priest's servant, and cut off his right ear. The servant's name was Malchus. 11 Then said Jesus unto Peter, Put up thy sword into the sheath: the cup which my Father hath given me, **shall I not drink it?**

Acts 1:3-8 To whom also he shewed himself alive after his passion by many infallible proofs, being seen of them forty days, and speaking of the things pertaining to the kingdom of God: 4 And, being assembled together with *them*, commanded them that they should not depart from Jerusalem, but wait for the promise of the Father, which, *saith he*, ye have heard of me. 5 For John truly baptized with water; but ye shall be baptized with the Holy Ghost not many days hence. 6 When they therefore were come together, they asked of him, saying, Lord, **wilt thou at this time restore again the kingdom to Israel?** 7 And he said unto them, It is not for you to know the times or the seasons, which the Father hath put in his own power. 8 But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Juda, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.

Luke 24:15-27 And it came to pass, that, while they communed *together* and reasoned, Jesus himself drew near, and went with them. 16 But their eyes were holden that they should not know him. 17 And he said unto them, What manner of communications are these that ye have one to another, as ye walk, and are sad? 18 And the one of them, whose name was Cleopas, answering said unto him, Art thou only a stranger in Jerusalem, and hast not known the things which are come to pass there in these days? 19 And he said unto them, What things? And they said unto him, Concerning Jesus of Nazareth, which was a prophet mighty in deed and word before God and all the people: 20 And how the chief priests and our rulers delivered him to be condemned to death, and have crucified him. 21 **But we trusted that it had been he which should have redeemed Israel:** and beside all this, to day is the third day since



these things were done. 22 Yea, and certain women also of our company made us astonished, which were early at the sepulchre; 23 And when they found not his body, they came, saying, that they had also seen a vision of angels, which said that he was alive. 24 And certain of them which were with us went to the sepulchre, and found *it* even so as the women had said: but him they saw not. 25 Then he said unto them, O fools, and slow of heart to believe all that the prophets have spoken: 26 Ought not Christ to have suffered these things, and **to enter into his glory?**

D. The Throne will not be removed because of the iniquity of men but be established through God's loving kindness.

God preserved His covenant with David, not because the righteousness of men, but for His own. This covenant was promised to David and kept by God's loving kindness.

2 Chronicles 21:7 Howbeit the Lord would not destroy the house of David, **because of the covenant that he had made with David**, and he promised to give a light to him and to his sons for ever.

2 Kings 8:19 Yet the Lord would not destroy Judah **for David his servant's sake**, as he **promised** him to give him alway light, and to his children.

Every person will give account of themselves to God. Their eternal fate and relationship with God are based on their own works, yet this covenant with David is kept by God for His kindness' sake, and not under any condition to the ways (or sins) of any man.

Ezekiel 33:10-20 Therefore, O thou son of man, speak unto the house of Israel; Thus ye speak, saying, If our transgressions and our sins *be* upon us, and we pine away in them, how should we then live? 11 Say unto them, As I live, saith the Lord GOD, I have no pleasure in the death of the wicked; but that the wicked turn from his way and live: turn ye, turn ye from your evil ways; for why will ye die, O house of Israel? 12 Therefore, thou son of man, say unto the children of thy people, The righteousness of the righteous shall not deliver him in the day of his transgression: as for the wickedness of the wicked, he shall not fall thereby in the day that he turneth from his wickedness; neither shall the righteous be able to live for his *righteousness* in the day that he sinneth. 13 When I shall say to the righteous, *that* he shall surely live; if he trust to his own righteousness, and commit iniquity, all his righteousnesses shall not be remembered; but for his iniquity that he hath committed, he shall die for it. 14 Again, when I say unto the wicked, Thou shalt surely die; if he turn from his sin, and do that which is lawful and right; 15 *If* the wicked restore the pledge, give again that he had robbed, walk in the statutes of life, without committing iniquity; he shall surely live, he shall not die. 16 None of his sins that he hath committed shall be mentioned unto him: he hath done that which is lawful and right; he shall surely live. 17 Yet the children of thy people say, The way of the Lord is not equal: but as for them, their way is not equal. 18 When the righteous turneth from his righteousness, and committeth iniquity, he shall even die thereby. 19 But if the wicked turn from his wickedness, and do that which is



lawful and right, he shall live thereby. 20 **Yet ye say, The way of the Lord is not equal. O ye house of Israel, I will judge you every one after his ways.**

1 Chronicles 28:9 And thou, Solomon my son, know thou the God of thy father, and serve him with a perfect heart and with a willing mind: for the Lord searchest all hearts, and understandeth all the imaginations of the thoughts: if thou seek him, he will be found of thee: but if thou forsake him, he will cast the off for ever.

E. David's house, throne and kingdom shall all be established forever.

Now through the Messiah Jesus the Christ we had the Davidic Covenant fulfilled into an everlasting kingdom.

Jesus was pronounced as the Son of God and given the throne of his father David.

Isaiah 7:14 Therefore the Lord himself shall give you a sign; Behold, a virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel.

Matthew 1:18-23 Now the birth of Jesus Christ was on this wise: When as his mother Mary was espoused to Joseph, before they came together, she was found with child of the Holy Ghost. 19 Then Joseph her husband, being a just man, and not willing to make her a publick example, was minded to put her away privily. 20 But while he thought on these things, behold, the angel of the Lord appeared unto him in a dream, saying, **Joseph, thou son of David**, fear not to take unto thee Mary thy wife: for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Ghost. 21 And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name JESUS: for he shall save his people from their sins. 22 Now all this was done, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken of the Lord by the prophet, saying, 23 Behold, a virgin shall be with child, and shall bring forth a son, and they shall call his name Emmanuel, which being interpreted is, God with us.

Isaiah 9:6-7 For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace. 7 Of the increase of his government and peace *there shall be no end, upon the throne of David, and upon his kingdom, to order it, and to establish it* with judgment and with justice from henceforth even for ever. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will perform this.

Luke 1:26-35 And in the sixth month the angel Gabriel was sent from God unto a city of Galilee, named Nazareth, 27 To a virgin espoused to a man whose name was Joseph, **of the house of David**; and the virgin's name was Mary. 28 And the angel came in unto her, and said, Hail, *thou that art* highly favoured, the Lord *is* with thee: blessed *art* thou among women. 29 And when she saw *him*, she was troubled at his saying, and cast in her mind what manner of salutation this should be. 30 And the angel said unto her, Fear not, Mary: for thou hast found favour with God. 31 And, behold, thou shalt conceive in thy womb, and bring forth a son, and shalt call his name JESUS. 32 He shall be great, and shall be called the Son of the Highest: and the Lord



God shall give unto him the throne of his father David: 33 And he shall reign over the house of Jacob for ever; and of his **kingdom there shall be no end.** 34 Then said Mary unto the angel, How shall this be, seeing I know not a man? 35 And the angel answered and said unto her, The Holy Ghost shall come upon thee, and the power of the Highest shall overshadow thee: therefore also that holy thing which shall be born of thee shall be called the Son of God.

1 Timothy 3:16 And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: God was manifest in the flesh, justified in the Spirit, seen of angels, preached unto the Gentiles, believed on in the world, received up into glory.

The temple of God in Jerusalem:

Daniel 9:24-25 Seventy weeks are determined upon thy people and upon thy holy city, to finish the transgression, and to make an end of sins, and to make reconciliation for iniquity, and to bring in everlasting righteousness, and to seal up the vision and prophecy, and to anoint the most Holy. 25 Know therefore and understand, *that* from the going forth of the commandment **to restore and to build Jerusalem unto the Messiah** the Prince *shall be* seven weeks, and threescore and two weeks: the street shall be built again, and the wall, even in troublous times.

Acts 15:14-17 Simeon hath declared how God at the first did visit the Gentiles, to take out of them a people for his name. 15 And to this agree the words of the prophets; as it is written, 16 After this I will return, and will build again the tabernacle of David, which is fallen down; and I will build again the ruins thereof, and I will set it up: 17 That the residue of men might seek after the Lord, and all the Gentiles, upon whom my name is called, saith the Lord, who doeth all these things.

John 2:18-22 Then answered the Jews and said unto him, What sign shewest thou unto us, seeing that thou doest these things? 19 Jesus answered and said unto them, Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up. 20 Then said the Jews, Forty and six years was this temple in building, and wilt thou rear it up in three days? 21 But he spake of the temple of his body. 22 When therefore he was risen from the dead, his disciples remembered that he had said this unto them; and they believed the scripture, and the word which Jesus had said.

Jesus did claim to be the Messiah.

John 4:20-26 Our fathers worshipped in this mountain; and ye say, that in Jerusalem is the place where men ought to worship. 21 Jesus saith unto her, Woman, believe me, the hour cometh, when ye shall neither in this mountain, nor yet at Jerusalem, worship the Father. 22 Ye worship ye know not what: we know what we worship: for salvation is of the Jews. 23 But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship him. 24 God *is* a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship *him* in spirit and in truth. 25 The woman saith unto him, **I know that Messias cometh**, which is called Christ:



when he is come, he will tell us all things. 26 Jesus saith unto her, **I that speak unto thee am he.**

The everlasting kingdom is of the Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

2 Peter 1:10-11 Wherefore the rather, brethren, give diligence to make your calling and election sure: for if ye do these things, ye shall never fall: 11 For so an entrance shall be ministered unto you abundantly into the **everlasting kingdom of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.**

Jesus is the light of the World

1 Kings 11:36 And unto his son will I give one tribe, that **David my servant may have a light always before me in Jerusalem**, the city which I have chosen me to put my name there.

Psalms 89:36-37 My covenant will I not break, nor alter the thing that is gone out of my lips. 35 Once have I sworn by my holiness that I will not lie unto David. 36 His seed shall endure for ever, **and his throne as the sun** before me. 37 It shall be established for ever as the moon, and as a faithful witness in heaven. Selah.

John 8:12 Then spake Jesus again unto them, saying, I am the light of the world: he that followeth me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the **light of life.**

Revelations 21:9-16 And there came unto me one of the seven angels which had the seven vials full of the seven last plagues, and talked with me, saying, Come hither, I will shew thee the bride, the Lamb's wife. 10 And he carried me away in the spirit to a great and high mountain, and shewed me that great city, **the holy Jerusalem, descending out of heaven from God**, 11 Having the glory of God: and her light was like unto a stone most precious, even like a jasper stone, clear as crystal; 12 And had a wall great and high, *and* had twelve gates, and at the gates twelve angels, and names written thereon, which are *the names* of the twelve tribes of the children of Israel: 13 On the east three gates; on the north three gates; on the south three gates; and on the west three gates. 14 And the wall of the city had twelve foundations, and in them the names of the twelve apostles of the Lamb. 15 And he that talked with me had a golden reed to measure the city, and the gates thereof, and the wall thereof. 16 And the city lieth foursquare, and the length is as large as the breadth: and he measured the city with the reed, twelve thousand furlongs. The length and the breadth and the height of it are equal.

Revelations 21:22-25 And I saw no temple therein: for the Lord God Almighty and the **Lamb are the temple** of it. 23 And the city had no need of the sun, neither of the moon, to shine in it: **for the glory of God did lighten it, and the Lamb is the light thereof.** 24 And the nations of them which are saved shall walk in the light of it: and the kings of the earth do bring their glory and honour into it. 25 And the gates of it shall not be shut at all by day: for there shall be no night there.
