Introduction Prophecies

The New Covenant is of great significance regarding the Gospel salvation that Christ brought to all mankind. In this covenant, God promised to put the law in the hearts of mankind as a whole. He also gave the purpose of the promise: His desire to be their God and that they would be God's people. In the implementation of this promise every person would be able to know God (the Lord), from the least to the greatest. There would no longer be required a teacher for people to know and understand the laws of God, all would be taught by God directly.

Jeremiah 31:31-34 Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that **I will make a new covenant** with the house of Israel, and with the house of Judah: 32 Not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day *that I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt; which my covenant they brake, although I was an husband unto them*, saith the LORD: 33 **But this shall be the covenant** that I will make with the house of Israel; After those days, saith the LORD, **I will put my law in their inward parts, and write it in their hearts; and will be their God, and they shall be my people.** 34 And they shall teach no more every man his neighbour, and every man his brother, saying, Know the LORD: for **they shall all know me**, from the **least of them unto the greatest** of them, saith the LORD: for I will forgive their iniquity, and I will remember their sin no more.

Hebrews 8:6-13 But now hath he obtained a more excellent ministry, by how much also he is **the mediator of a better covenant**, which was established upon **better promises**. 7 For if that first covenant had been faultless, then should no place have been sought for the second. 8 For finding fault **with them**, he saith, Behold, the days come, saith the Lord, when **I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah**: 9 Not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day when I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt; because **they continued not in my covenant**, and I regarded them not, saith the Lord. 10 For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, saith the Lord; **I will put my laws into their mind, and write them in their hearts: and I will be to them a God, and they shall be to me a people:** 11 And they shall not teach every man his neighbour, and every man his brother, saying, Know the Lord: **for all shall know me, from the least to the greatest.** 12 For I will be merciful to their unrighteousness, and their sins and their iniquities will I remember no more. 13 In that he saith, **A new covenant**, he hath made the first old. Now that which decayeth and waxeth old **is ready to vanish away.**

Before this new covenant could come to pass, the older covenant of the Law of Moses had to be fulfilled in its entirety, until Shiloh (Messiah) come. When this New Covenant



came, it took away the First Covenant of Commandment and established the Covenant of Promise. The Covenant of Faith given to Abraham was fulfilled and accomplished through Christ. Now all that are in Christ are heirs of this promise through faith and in Christ.

Genesis 49:10 The sceptre shall not depart from Judah, nor a lawgiver from between his feet, **until Shiloh come**; and unto **him shall the gathering of the people be**.

Deuteronomy 18:15-19 The LORD thy **God will raise up** unto thee a Prophet from the midst of thee, of thy brethren, like unto me; **unto him ye shall hearken**; 16 According to all that thou desiredst of the LORD thy God in Horeb in the day of the assembly, saying, Let me not hear again the voice of the LORD my God, neither let me see this great fire any more, that I die not. 17 And the LORD said unto me, They have well *spoken that* which they have spoken. 18 I will raise them up a Prophet from among their brethren, like unto thee, and **will put my words in his mouth**; and he shall speak unto them **all that I shall command him**. 19 And it shall come to pass, *that* whosoever will not hearken unto my words which he shall speak in my name, **I will require it of him**.

Luke 24:44-45 And he said unto them, These are the words which I spake unto you, while I was yet with you, that **all things must be fulfilled**, which were written in the law of Moses, and *in* the prophets, and *in* the psalms, **concerning me**. 45 Then opened he their understanding, that they might understand the scriptures,

Luke 16:16-17 The law and the prophets were until John: **since that time** the kingdom of God is preached, and **every man** preseth into it. 17 And it is easier for heaven and earth to pass, than one tittle of the law to fail.

Luke 3:15-17 And as the people were in expectation, and all men mused in their hearts of John, whether he were the Christ, or not; 16 John answered, saying unto *them* all, I indeed baptize you with water; but one mightier than I cometh, the latchet of whose shoes I am not worthy to unloose: he shall baptize you with **the Holy Ghost** and with **fire**: 17 Whose fan *is* in his hand, and he will **throughly purge** his floor, and will gather the wheat into his garner; but the chaff **he will burn** with fire unquenchable.

When the Messiah came, He brought in the Kingdom of God through the Holy spirit of God himself. God made complete provision for His covenant to be fulfilled by giving the way that all men would be able to the know the Lord in their inward parts - the Holy Ghost.

Joel 2:28-29 And it shall come to pass afterward, *that I will pour out my spirit upon all flesh*; and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, your young men shall see visions: 29 And also upon the servants and upon the handmaids in those days **will I pour out my spirit**.

Jeremiah 24:6-7 For I will set mine eyes upon them for good, and I will bring them again to this land: and I will build them, and not pull *them* down; and I will plant them,



and not pluck *them* up. 7 And I will give them an heart to know me, that I am the LORD: and they shall be my people, and I will be their God: for they shall return unto me with their whole heart.

Ezekiel 36:25-28 Then will I sprinkle clean water upon you, and ye shall be clean: from all your filthiness, and from all your idols, will I cleanse you. 26 A new heart also will I give you, and a new spirit will I put within you: and I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh, and I will give you an heart of flesh. 27 And I will put my spirit within you, and cause you to walk in my statutes, and ye shall keep my judgments, and do *them*. 28 And ye shall dwell in the land that I gave to your fathers; and ye shall be my people, and I will be your God.

Isaiah 44:3-8 For I will pour water upon him that is thirsty, and floods upon the dry ground: I will pour my spirit upon thy seed, and my blessing upon thine offspring: 4 And they shall spring up as among the grass, as willows by the water courses. 5 One shall say, I am the LORD'S; and another shall call *himself* by the name of Jacob; and another shall subscribe with his hand unto the LORD, and surname *himself* by the name of Israel. 6 Thus saith the LORD the King of Israel, and his redeemer the LORD of hosts; I am the first, and I am the last; and beside me there is no God. 7 And who, as I, shall call, and shall declare it, and set it in order for me, since I appointed the ancient people? and the things that are coming, and shall come, let them shew unto them. 8 Fear ye not, neither be afraid: have not I told thee from that time, and have declared *it*? ye are even my witnesses. Is there a God beside me? yea, *there is* no God; I know not any.

Isaiah 9:6-7 For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace. 7 Of the increase of his government and peace *there shall be* no end, upon the throne of David, and upon his kingdom, to order it, and to establish it with judgment and with justice from henceforth even for ever. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will perform this.
