

## Foundation Building Blocks

### FBB1-5-4-04 Christian Communion – The Death of His Flesh on the Cross

*Jesus taught that He was the living bread that came down from heaven. Those that would eat (partake) of His flesh (bread of heaven) would live forever. In order to live forever, one must partake of the body and blood of Christ through obedience to water baptism in Jesus' name. Communion is partaken of as a remembrance of the body that was broken and blood that was shed (Luke 22:7-20).*

**John 6:47-58** Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me hath everlasting life. 48 **I am that bread of life.** 49 Your fathers did eat manna in the wilderness, and are dead. 50 This is the bread which **cometh down from heaven**, that a man may eat thereof, and not die. 51 I am the **living bread** which came down from heaven: if any man eat of this bread, **he shall live for ever**: and the bread that I will give **is my flesh**, which I **will give** for the life of the world. 52 The Jews therefore strove among themselves, saying, How can this man give us *his* flesh to eat? 53 Then Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except ye eat the flesh of the Son of man, and drink his blood, ye have no life in you. 54 Whoso eateth my flesh, and drinketh my blood, hath eternal life; and I will raise him up at the last day. 55 For my flesh is meat indeed, and my blood is drink indeed. 56 He that eateth my flesh, and drinketh my blood, **dwelleth in me, and I in him.** 57 As the living Father hath sent me, and I live by the Father: **so he that eateth me, even he shall live by me.** 58 This is that bread which came down from heaven: not as your fathers did eat manna, and are dead: he that eateth of this bread shall live for ever. 59 These things said he in the synagogue, as he taught in Capernaum. 60 Many therefore of his disciples, when they had heard *this*, said, This is an hard saying; who can hear it? 61 When Jesus knew in himself that his disciples murmured at it, he said unto them, Doth this offend you? 62 *What* and if ye shall see the **Son of man ascend up** where he was before? 63 It is the spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing: **the words that I speak unto you, they are spirit, and they are life.**

*Jesus was teaching of a spiritual application of eating His flesh and drinking His blood by saying, "the words that I speak unto you, they are spirit, and they are life". If He was teaching of natural blood and flesh, He would be teaching sacrilege for anyone to partake of the blood (Genesis 9:4).*
