FCS1-1-09: Remission of Sin



Remission: (Greek 3929 – *Romans 3:25*) **praetermission** [*omission: something that has not been included or done: something that has been omitted*], i.e. toleration:--**remission**.

When a person has the blood of Christ applied to their life, they receive remission of all their sins. The blood that was shed at the sacrifice of Christ atones for and erases every prior sin within their life. They are saved from the wrath of God that was held against them because of sin and granted eternal life.

Romans 3:24-25 Being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus: 25 Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation through faith in his blood, to declare his righteousness for the **remission of sins that are past**, through the forbearance of God;

Colossians 2:10-14 And ye are complete in him, which is the head of all principality and power: 11 In whom also ye are circumcised with the circumcision made without hands, in putting off the body of the sins of the flesh by the circumcision of Christ: 12 Buried with him in baptism, wherein also ye are risen with *him* through the faith of the operation of God, who hath raised him from the dead. 13 And you, being dead in your sins and the uncircumcision of your flesh, hath he quickened together with him, having forgiven you all trespasses; 14 Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross;
