FCS1-1-13: Testimony of Good Works

It is through the good works of faith that unbelieving people can see God in this world. The God they see in the lives of faithful Christians is part of a godly Christian testimony. Therefore, all should take heed of their actions and reactions in this life: lost souls may be judging the God we serve by how we serve Him.

1 Peter 2:12 Having your conversation honest among the Gentiles: that, whereas they speak against you as evildoers, they may by *your* good works, which they shall behold, glorify God in the day of visitation.

Titus 2:6-8 Young men likewise exhort to be sober minded. 7 In all things shewing thyself a pattern of good works: in doctrine *shewing* uncorruptness, gravity, sincerity, 8 Sound speech, that cannot be condemned; that he that is of the contrary part may be ashamed, having no evil thing to say of you.

John 10:37-38 If I do not the works of my Father, believe me not. 38 But if I do, though ye believe not me, believe the works: that ye may know, and believe, that the Father is in me, and I in him.
