FCS1-2-01: God is a Spirit

God: (Greek 2316 – *John 4:24*) a deity, especially (with 3588) **the supreme Divinity**; figuratively, a magistrate; by Hebraism, very;--X exceeding, God, god(-ly, -ward).

Lord: (Hebrew 3068 – *Isaiah 45:6*) (the) **self-Existent or Eternal**; Jehovah, Jewish national name of God;--**Jehovah, the Lord.**

God (the Lord) is the supreme divinity that always was and will always be.

Exodus 3:14 And God said unto Moses, I AM THAT I AM: and he said, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, I AM hath sent me unto you.

Isaiah 45:6 That they may know from the rising of the sun, and from the west, that *there is* none beside me. *I am* the LORD, and *there is* none else.

John 4:24 God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship *him* in spirit and in truth.

Ephesians 4:4-6 *There is* one body, and one Spirit, even as ye are called in one hope of your calling; 5 One Lord, one faith, one baptism, 6 One God and Father of all, who *is* above all, and through all, and in you all.
