FCS1-2-02: The Father is Author and Creator of All

Manifest: (Greek 5319 – 1 Timothy 3:16) **to render apparent** (literally or figuratively):--**appear**, manifestly declare, (make) manifest (forth), shew (self).

Evident: (Greek 2612 – Hebrews 7:15) **manifest:**--far more evident.

Evidence: (Greek 1650 – Hebrews 11:1) **proof**, conviction:--evidence, reproof.

Attribute: (Merriam-webster) 1. an inherent characteristic; 2. an object closely associated with or belonging to a specific person, thing, or office; 3. A word ascribing a quality;

The Author and Creator of all: (*The Father – Our heavenly Father cares for His children*)

Manifestations may be seen, heard, and felt with carnal senses such as sight, sound and touch. God used these types of manifestations to relate to mankind in these ways so that they may better understand Him. This study will only reference a few of the many manifestations and attributes of God.

Genesis 1:1 In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.

John 1:1-3 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. 2 The same was in the beginning with God. 3 All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made.

God personally interacts with His people as a father would interact with his son or daughter.

Hebrews 12:6-10 For whom the Lord loveth he chasteneth, and scourgeth every son whom he receiveth. 7 If ye endure chastening, God dealeth with you as with sons; for what son is he whom the father chasteneth not? 8 But if ye be without chastisement, whereof all are partakers, then are ye bastards, and not sons. 9 Furthermore we have had fathers of our flesh which corrected *us*, and we gave *them* reverence: shall we not much rather be in subjection unto the Father of spirits, and live? 10 For they verily for a few days chastened *us* after their own pleasure; but he for *our* profit, that *we* might be partakers of his holiness.
