FCS1-3-10: Christians in Fellowship

In the Church (the Body of Christ), every person has a responsibility to and for one another. Collectively, each Christian is stronger and more fruitful when they work together in Christ. This working together uses each other's strengths that overcome any weakness an individual may have. The result is a strong and healthy Christian fellowship.

Galatians 6:2 Bear ye one another's burdens, and so fulfil the law of Christ.

Romans 14:17-19 For the kingdom of God is not meat and drink; but righteousness, and peace, and joy in the Holy Ghost. 18 For he that in these things serveth Christ is acceptable to God, and approved of men. 19 Let us therefore follow after the things which make for peace, and things wherewith one may edify another.

Ephesians 4:15-16 But speaking the truth in love, may grow up into him in all things, which is the head, *even* Christ: 16 From whom the whole body fitly joined together and compacted by that which every joint supplieth, according to the effectual working in the measure of every part, maketh increase of the body unto the edifying of itself in love.

Within the fellowship, God supplies spiritual abilities to meet its administrative and spiritual needs. Every part of this ministry has a purpose that is used for edifying of each person within it.

Ephesians 4:11-13 And he gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers; 12 For the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ: 13 Till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ:

Ephesians 4:3-6 Endeavouring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. 4 *There is* one body, and one Spirit, even as ye are called in one hope of your calling; 5 One Lord, one faith, one baptism, 6 One God and Father of all, who *is* above all, and through all, and in you all.

Personally, each person's ministry is more fruitful in Christ than they would have been on their own without fellowship. Collectively, the church is stronger and better off for their fellowship in ministry.
