### FCS1-3-18: God's Answer to our Prayers

*Prayer is a two-way conversation, and not just a one-sided one. Prayer is not just a person telling God what they want. If a person asks God for an answer to a question, they need to be listening for His answer. When a person is focusing on receiving direction from God, their prayer will be answered.*

**Matthew 21:22** And all things, whatsoever ye shall ask in prayer, believing, ye shall receive.

*There should always be time reserved to listen for God's answer and direction. Whether it is time in the morning or in the evening, every moment we spend with Him is time well spent in prayer. This means that a person may need to adjust the way they spend their time.*

*The answer from God may come in a variety of ways. He may speak to us directly through our thoughts or in a dream. We may read it from scripture or hear His answer through the preaching of His Word within a sermon. Sometimes the answer may even come through a conversation with a friend or family member. Whichever way God chooses to answer, a person will know when He has answered their prayers. There is never a doubt in God's answers.*

**1 Kings 19:11-13** And he said, Go forth, and stand upon the mount before the LORD. And, behold, the LORD passed by, and a great and strong wind rent the mountains, and brake in pieces the rocks before the LORD; *but the LORD was not in the wind: and after the wind an earthquake; but the LORD was not in the earthquake:* 12 And after the earthquake a fire; *but the LORD was not in the fire: and after the fire a still small voice.* 13 And it was so, when Elijah heard it, that he wrapped his face in his mantle, and went out, and stood in the entering in of the cave. And, behold, *there came a voice unto him, and said, What doest thou here, Elijah?*

**James 3:17** But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, *and* easy to be intreated, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality, and without hypocrisy.

*God may not answer the way we think He should or as fast. An open heart will hear His answer and be blessed accordingly by it.*
