FCS1-4-02: Where Did the Bible Come From?

The accounts in the Bible usually were not written down as they occurred. Some accounts became teachings that were passed down from generation to generation. Others were written down when it happened by the Scribes that wrote as the Prophets spoke. These ancient accounts or writings (regardless of when they were written down), came from a variety of sources consisting of historical documents and letters which were written from leaders and church elders. As God's Spirit moved on these authors of the Bible, they recorded these messages with whatever resources were available to them at that time.

2 Peter 1:21 For the prophecy came not in old time by the will of man: but holy men of God spake as they were moved by the Holy Ghost.

For a long period in history common men and women were forbidden access to the Bible and its life-transforming truths. Today, the Bible is the bestselling book of all time, with billions of copies distributed throughout the world in more than 2,000 languages.
