FCS1-4-12: The Loins in God's Armor

Loins: “...*having your loins girt about with truth ...*” (area below the waist - the hips and the front of the body below the waist, considered as the part of the body that should be covered as the site of the gender)

Loins: (Greek 3751 – *Ephesians 6:14*) *osphus* os-foos' of uncertain affinity; the loin (externally), i.e. **the hip; internally** (by extension) procreative power:--**loin**.

Loins: (Merriam-Webster.com) a: the upper and lower abdominal regions and the region about the hips b: (1): the pubic region. (2): the reproductive organs.

Truth: (Greek 0225 – *Ephesians 6:14*) *aletheia* al-ay'-thi-a from 227; **truth**:--true, X truly, truth, verity.

2 Timothy 2:22 Flee also youthful lusts: but **follow righteousness**, faith, charity, peace, with them that call on the Lord out of a **pure heart**.

1 Thessalonians 4:3-5 For this is the will of God, *even your sanctification*, that ye should abstain from fornication: 4 That every one of you should know how to possess his vessel in sanctification and **honour**; 5 Not in the lust of concupiscence, even as the Gentiles which know not God:

Luke 12:35 Let your loins be girded about, and your lights burning;

The loins are a major area of concern, especially for the youth that are going through changes in their lives. Always have your loins girt about with truth.
