### FCS1-4-14: Feet Shod in God's Armor

**Feet:** "... And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace; ..." (*shoes of a warrior that give a sturdy stance and protection from uneven ground.*)

**Shod:** (Greek 5265 – as used in *Ephesians 6:15*) *hypodeo* hoop-od-eh'-o from 5259 and 1210; to bind under one's feet, i.e. put on shoes or sandals:--bind on, (be) shod.

**Preparation:** (Greek 2090 - as used in *Ephesians 6:15*) *hetoimazo* het-oy-mad'-zo from 2092; to prepare:--prepare, provide, make ready.

**Peace:** (Greek 1515 - as used in *Ephesians 6:15*) *eirene* i-ray'-nay probably from a primary verb *eiro* (to join); peace (literally or figuratively); by implication, prosperity:--one, peace, quietness, rest, + set at one again.

*It is the shoes of a warrior that give him the sturdy stance and protection in uneven ground. This is what helps the warrior stand fast while fighting the oncoming enemy.*

**Romans 10:15** And how shall they preach, except they be sent? as it is written, How beautiful are the feet of them that preach the gospel of peace, and bring glad tidings of good things!

*Peace in God means that a person no longer is fighting with the Spirit of God in their conscience. That person accepts God's will without resistance or bargaining. Walking in the Spirit of God with their flesh in total submission is the preparation of the Gospel of Peace. Therefore, when a person is standing against the wiles of the Devil with their stance firmly resolved in Christ, there is nothing from hell that will be able to move them from their steadfastness in Christ.*

**1 Corinthians 16:13** Watch ye, stand fast in the faith, quit you like men, be strong.

**Galatians 5:1** Stand fast therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free, and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage.

**Colossians 1:23** If ye continue in the faith grounded and settled, and be not moved away from the hope of the gospel, which ye have heard, and which was preached to every creature which is under heaven; whereof I Paul am made a minister;

*When a person is standing firm in their spiritual resolve and not moved from the hope of their life in the Gospel, that person has their feet shod with the preparation of the Gospel of peace.*
