FCS1-4-15: The Shield in God's Armor



Shield of Faith: "... Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked." (a flat or convex piece of armor carried on the arm and used as a protection against weapon blows, arrows, bullets, or projectiles)

Shield: (Greek 2375 - as used in *Ephesians 6:16*) thureos thoo-reh-os' from 2374; a large shield (as door-shaped):--shield.

Shield: (Merriam-Webster.com) a broad piece of defensive armor carried on the arm.

Faith: (Greek 4102 - as used in *Galatians 3:22*) pistis pis'-tis from 3982; persuasion, i.e. credence; moral conviction (of religious truth, or the truth-fulness of God or a religious teacher), especially reliance upon Christ for salvation; by extension, the system of religious (Gospel) truth itself :--assurance, belief, believe, faith, fidelity.

Quench: (Greek 4570 – as used in *Ephesians 6:16*) sbennumi sben'-noo-mee a prolonged form of an apparently primary verb; to extinguish (literally or figuratively):--go out, quench.

2 Thessalonians 3:3 But the Lord is faithful, who shall stablish you, and keep *you* from evil.

Hebrews 10:23 Let us hold fast the profession of *our* faith without wavering; (for he *is* faithful that promised;)

2 Timothy 4:7 I have fought a good fight, I have finished *my* course, I have kept the faith:

The faith and evidence within of a person's life is not based on personal feelings. Sometimes, a person's does not even feel saved. The good news is that it is a person's soul that will go to heaven; the flesh will never feel saved because it is not going to heaven. If a person starts to doubt the ability of God to save their souls, or they start to listen to their flesh regarding salvation, they will have the power to their shield diminished. That is why the Devil is tireless in telling people that they are not saved; He is trying to weaken their shield of faith that He may break through to the heart. He cannot reach the heart of a person if their shield of faith is strong.
