### FCS1-4-20: Security of God's Grace - God is Well Able



*The promise of God, that all nations would be blessed, is fulfilled in Christ Jesus. This promise from God is salvation from His wrath unto eternal life. All nations are now able to come unto eternal life through Jesus Christ.*

**Matthew 28:18** And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth.

**Romans 6:9-10** Knowing that Christ being raised from the dead dieth no more; death hath no more dominion over him. 10 For in that he died, he died unto sin once: but in that he liveth, he liveth unto God.

**Hebrews 7:24-25** But this *man*, because he continueth ever, hath an unchangeable priesthood. 25 Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by him, seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them.

*God is well able to redeem mankind unto Himself by the sacrifice of His Son Jesus Christ. God's love for mankind is clearly seen in the sacrifice of Christ. All those that come and abide in Jesus, shall have eternal life.*

**Hebrews 6:16-19** For men verily swear by the greater: and an oath for confirmation *is* to them an end of all strife. 17 Wherein God, willing more abundantly to shew unto the heirs of promise the immutability of his counsel, confirmed *it* by an oath: 18 That by two immutable things, in which *it was* impossible for God to lie, we might have a strong consolation, who have fled for refuge to lay hold upon the hope set before us: 19 Which *hope* we have as an anchor of the soul, both sure and stedfast, and which entereth into that within the veil;

Immutability: ametathetos am-et-ath'-et-os from 1 (as a negative particle) and a derivative of 3346; unchangeable, or (neuter as abstract) unchangeability:--immutable(-ility).

Immutability: (Merriam-Webster.com) not capable of or susceptible to change.

**John 17:2, 11-12** As thou hast given him power over all flesh, that he should give eternal life to as many as thou hast given him.

11 And now I am no more in the world, but these are in the world, and I come to thee. Holy Father, keep through thine own name those whom thou hast given me, that they may be one, as we *are*. 12 While I was with them in the world, I kept them in thy name: those that thou gavest me I have kept, and none of them is lost, but the son of perdition; that the scripture might be fulfilled.

**Ephesians 2:4-10** But God, who is rich in mercy, for his great love wherewith he loved us, 5 Even when we were dead in sins, hath quickened us together with Christ, (by grace ye are saved;) 6 And hath raised *us* up together, and made *us* sit together in heavenly *places* in Christ Jesus: 7 That in the ages to come he might shew the exceeding riches of his grace in *his* kindness toward us through Christ Jesus. 8 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: *it is* the gift of God: 9 Not of works, lest any man should boast. 10 For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them.

**Romans 8:35-39** Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? *shall* tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? 36 As it is written, For thy sake we are killed all the day long; we are accounted as sheep for the slaughter. 37 Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us. 38 For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, 39 Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

**John 10:27-30** My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me: 28 And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any *man* pluck them out of my hand. 29 My Father, which gave *them* me, is greater than all; and no *man* is able to pluck *them* out of my Father's hand. 30 I and *my* Father are one.

*There is nothing that can separate those that abide in Christ from the promise of salvation unto eternal life; not even the Devil or any of His devices. God's promise is steadfast and eternal.*
