## Acts 4:29-31

► ***29 Now, Lord, look on their threats, and grant to Your servants that with all boldness they may speak Your word, 30 by stretching out Your hand to heal, and that signs and wonders may be done through the name of Your holy Servant Jesus.” 31 And when they had prayed, the place where they were assembled together was shaken; and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit, and they spoke the word of God with boldness.***



► ***About three in the morning as we were continuing instant in prayer, the power of God came mightily upon us, insomuch that many cried out for exceeding joy, and many fell to the ground. As soon as we recovered a little from the awe and amazement at the presence of His Majesty, we broke out with one voice, 'We praise Thee, O God, we acknowledge Thee to be the Lord.' – John Wesley***

■ ***1 Corinthians 2:4-5 - <sup>4</sup> And my message and my preaching were very plain. Rather than using clever and persuasive speeches, I relied only on the power of the Holy Spirit. <sup>5</sup> I did this so you would trust not in human wisdom but in the power of God.***

- ***We have outsourced the work of the church to a few in leadership.***





► **Romans 15:18-19 - <sup>18</sup> Yet I dare not boast about anything except what Christ has done through me, bringing the Gentiles to God by my message and by the way I worked among them. <sup>19</sup> They were convinced by the power of miraculous signs and wonders and by the power of God's Spirit. In this way, I have fully presented the Good News of Christ from Jerusalem all the way to Illyricum.**



➡ **1 Corinthians 14:26 - <sup>26</sup> Well, my brothers and sisters, let's summarize. When you meet together, one will sing, another will teach, another will tell some special revelation God has given, one will speak in tongues, and another will interpret what is said. But everything that is done must strengthen all of you. (NLT)**

- ***1 Corinthians 12:31 - <sup>31</sup> But earnestly desire and strive for the greater gifts [if acquiring them is going to be your goal] ... (AMP)***
  - ***1 Corinthians 14:1 - Let love be your highest goal! But you should also desire the special abilities the Spirit gives—especially the ability to prophesy. (NLT)***

- ***Gideon – Where are all the miracles we heard about?***
  - ***There were no miracles because no one in Israel was seeking the God of miracles.***
