HEBREWS 12:26-29

Hebrews 12:26-29

- **26 His voice shook the earth [at Mount Sinai] then, but now He has given a promise, saying, “Yet once more I will shake not only the earth, but also the [starry] heaven.” 27 Now this [expression], “Yet once more,” indicates the removal *and* final transformation of all those things which can be shaken—that is, of that which has been created—so that those things which cannot be shaken may remain.**

Hebrews 12:26-29

- **28** Therefore, since we receive a kingdom which cannot be shaken, let us show gratitude, and offer to God pleasing service *and* acceptable worship with reverence and awe; **29** for our God is [indeed] a consuming fire. (AMP)

- **What is the point of God allowing things to be shaken? So, what is eternal will remain but what is not eternal, although we may esteem it, is removed.**

John 15:1-8

- “I am the true vine, and My Father is the vinedresser. ² Every branch in Me that does not bear fruit He takes away; and every *branch* that bears fruit He prunes, that it may bear more fruit. ³ You are already clean because of the word which I have spoken to you. ⁴ Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in Me.

John 15:1-8

- 5 “I am the vine; you *are* the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing. 6 If anyone does not abide in Me, he is cast out as a branch and is withered; and they gather them and throw *them* into the fire, and they are burned. 7 If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you. 8 By this My Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit; so, you will be My disciples.

- **“God wants the whole person, and He will not rest till He gets us in entirety. No part of the man will do” – A. W. Tozer**
- **The closer we get to our calling, the more we need to be shaken so all our dependance is on Jesus. All self must be eradicated.**

We Must Be Totally Kingdom-Minded

Matthew 6:19-21

- 19 “Do not lay up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy and where thieves break in and steal; 20 but lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust destroys and where thieves do not break in and steal. 21 For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.

Hebrews 11:25-27

- 25 He chose to share the oppression of God's people instead of enjoying the fleeting pleasures of sin. 26 He thought it was better to suffer for the sake of Christ than to own the treasures of Egypt, for he was looking ahead to his great reward. 27 It was by faith that Moses left the land of Egypt, not fearing the king's anger. He kept right on going because he kept his eyes on the one who is invisible. (NLT)

We Must Be Totally Kingdom-Minded

- **God wants our eyes on Him, our faith in Him and our hearts on what is eternal - people are eternal.**

1 Timothy 6:17-19

- ¹⁷ Command those who are rich in this present age not to be haughty, nor to trust in uncertain riches but in the living God, who gives us richly all things to enjoy. ¹⁸ *Let them* do good, that they be rich in good works, ready to give, willing to share, ¹⁹ storing up for themselves a good foundation for the time to come, that they may lay hold on eternal life.

We Must Be Totally Holy Spirit Reliant

- **2 Corinthians 12:9 - 9 And He said to me, “My grace is sufficient for you, for My strength is made perfect in weakness.” Therefore, most gladly I will rather boast in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.**

We Must Be Totally Holy Spirit Reliant

- **The Holy Spirit is always at the door but many times, He is never truly invited. The Holy Spirit knows true desperation when He sees and hears it.**

We Must Be Totally Holy Spirit Reliant

2 Corinthians 4:7 - 7 But we have this treasure in earthen vessels, that the excellence of the power may be of God and not of us.

• **1 Corinthians 2:3-4 - 3 I was with you in weakness, in fear, and in much trembling. 4 And my speech and my preaching were not with persuasive words of human wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power**

We Must Have Great Hunger for God and His Presence

- **Deuteronomy 4:23-24** - ²³Take heed to yourselves, lest you forget the covenant of the Lord your God which He made with you, and make for yourselves a carved image in the form of anything which the Lord your God has forbidden you. ²⁴For the Lord your God is a consuming fire, a jealous God.

We Must Have Great Hunger for God and His Presence

1 Timothy 6:11-14

- **11** But you, O man of God, flee these things and pursue righteousness, godliness, faith, love, patience, gentleness. **12** Fight the good fight of faith, lay hold on eternal life, to which you were also called and have confessed the good confession in the presence of many witnesses. **13** I urge you in the sight of God who gives life to all things, and *before* Christ Jesus who witnessed the good confession before Pontius Pilate, **14** that you keep *this* commandment without spot, blameless until our Lord Jesus Christ's appearing...

Deuteronomy 9:1-3

- “Hear, O Israel: You *are* to cross over the Jordan today, and go in to dispossess nations greater and mightier than yourself, cities great and fortified up to heaven,² a people great and tall, the descendants of the Anakim, whom you know, and *of whom* you heard *it said*, ‘Who can stand before the descendants of Anak?’³ Therefore understand today that the Lord your God is He who goes over before you *as* a consuming fire. He will destroy them and bring them down before you; so, you shall drive them out and destroy them quickly, as the Lord has said to you.
