


Program Information

- Children must be the age of their class on or before Sept 1st in the fall of the school year.

One Year Olds

Two Year Olds


*Monday, Wednesday and Friday - 8:30 am - 12:00 noon

This program helps your child gain self-confidence through fun, delightful play. Toddlers begin language skills through Bible stories, nursery rhymes, and games. They will be introduced to colors, shapes, letters, numbers, and nature activities.

Three Year Olds

*Monday, Wednesday and Friday - 8:30 am - 12:00 noon
or
Monday thru Friday - 8:30 am - 12:00 noon*

We utilize the Abeka curriculum for letters and numbers, music, puzzles and other manipulatives; encourage creativity while helping your child understand concepts and recognize numbers, colors, letters, and shapes. Lessons prepare your child for a rewarding school experience. Bible concepts are taught through hands-on activities.



Four Year Olds

Kindergarten

Phonics and Saxon Math are part of our curriculum as well as handwriting, art, and physical education. Children leaving our kindergarten program enter the public school system seamlessly and many are identified and placed in the GATE program (gifted).
