MIRACLES IN LITHUANIA

»»» HEALING AND HOPE

Our Regional Director for Belarus, Andrei, recently shared an uplifting story from a church in Klaipeda, Lithuania, that speaks volumes about faith, perseverance, and the power of divine encounters. Every Saturday, this church family takes to the streets, visiting different areas of the city to speak with residents and distribute Bibles, sharing the message of hope.

Last winter, one of the church's leaders faced a life-threatening health crisis, so severe that he was admitted to intensive care. He had little chance of survival. But in a miraculous turn of events, he made a full recovery, crediting his healing to divine intervention. A kind nurse in full protective gear cared for him daily. The mask and suit obscured her face, leaving him unable to recognize her later. After his recovery, he returned to his church's mission, continuing the Saturday outreach.

Months later, while out distributing Bibles, he had a profound encounter: he met the very nurse who had cared for him. She revealed that she had been searching for him, eager to hear about his recovery. In that moment, the church leader shared his miraculous testimony of healing and introduced her to Christ. He offered her a Bible, and she was deeply moved. Since then, she has begun studying the Scriptures with the church community, embarking on her own spiritual journey.

This story is a powerful reminder of how God weaves unexpected connections and uses every moment, even the most challenging, to bring people closer to Him. What started as a life-or-death struggle in a hospital bed transformed into a life-changing testimony and a new beginning for someone seeking truth. LIVES TRANSFORMED IN GREECE

»»» UPDATE FROM EEM PARTNER HELLENIC MINISTRIES (HM)

The rich aroma of freshly brewed coffee fills the air, marking the start of another day to welcome Athens' most honored guests. Refugees from Iran, Afghanistan, Syria, Ukraine, and Greece gather in this warm haven, where they receive not just a meal but the embrace of love and community hosted by Hellenic Ministries (HM).

As the doors swing open, people stream into the bustling dining hall. Familiar faces glow with heartfelt hugs and shared smiles, while newcomers quietly settle in, eager for the uplifting songs and inspiring message to come. In the background, others sift through clothing, savor a hot shower, or start a load of laundry.

Every day, HM coordinates the distribution of food, Bibles, hygiene products, and clothing. Simultaneously, they provide activities for children. They also offer Greek and English classes and essential psychological support seminars to help heal deep wounds of trauma. HM leader Leonid Ivanov shared, **"Most important of all is witnessing people come to know the Lord and watching their lives transform. Each year, we celebrate dozens of baptisms at our summer camps, where people fully dedicate their lives to Him."**

Olya, a Ukrainian refugee, shared her heart:

"I had lost hope due to a serious health issue until I truly found God here. Soon, I'll undergo surgery, but I'm no longer afraid. My heart is full of peace because I know He will sustain me."

In August, HM hosted a family camp for nearly 100 Ukrainian refugees in the stunning Porto Astro facility. By the camp's end, five people had been baptized. We praise God for the ways he is at work in Greece, meeting and serving the populations seeking community through our amazing ministry partners like HM.

A SOVEREIGN HOPE AMID UNCEASING CHAOS

War has become a cruel companion in the daily lives of Ukrainians. What once might have been unthinkable—the repeated sound of air raid sirens, the devastation of homes, the daily death toll of innocent civilians—has now become part of a harrowing routine.

Even in towns once deemed safe, the war finds its way, shattering the fragile illusion of normalcy. Daily life in Ukraine is marked by destruction: crumbling infrastructure, residential areas reduced to rubble, and frequent blackouts that plunge communities into darkness. Few are untouched by fear, loss, or exhaustion. As the war rages on, military recruiters hunt for new conscripts, adding another layer of anxiety as families fear losing their loved ones to the front lines.

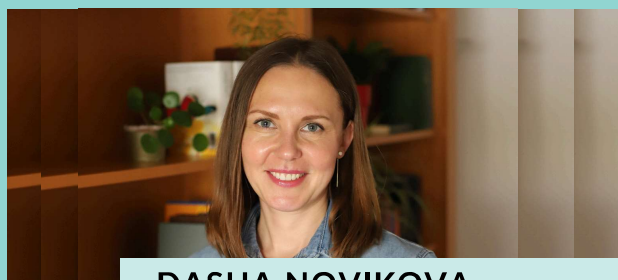
Yet, in the heart of this conflict, a quiet but powerful movement is underway. Against all odds, the distribution of Bibles across Ukraine has not ceased. It continues as a beacon of hope, a testimony to the enduring human spirit, and a reminder that even in the darkest valleys, God's light can never be extinguished and Jesus is on the throne.

For many, the Bible has become more than just a book; it is a lifeline, a source of comfort, and a symbol of resilience. Each Bible distributed is a tangible expression of God's love and sovereignty amidst the chaos. As missiles strike and sirens wail, the Word of God brings peace to those who are weary. It is a reminder that there is a power greater than any war, a power that stands above, a God who sees the suffering and offers solace through his son Jesus.

Despite the challenges, people are finding their way back to faith. Churches are not empty; they are growing. Requests for Bibles are up by more than 75%. Men, women, and children are turning to God, seeking solace in His promises. For some, the Bible is a guide through the turmoil, a refuge when the world around them seems to be falling apart. It is a reminder that they are not alone, that there is hope even when everything else has been stripped away.

The values that the Bible imparts—love, peace and perseverance—are taking root in the hearts of Ukrainians. These values inspire communities to hold on a little longer, to care for one another, and to believe that there is a brighter future beyond the horizon of war. The Bible reminds them that while the world may be uncertain, God's Word is steadfast. As Ukrainians face the relentless trials of war, the Bible serves as a reminder that God is near, that His promises are true, and that His love endures even in the most desperate of circumstances.

In these trying times, the spread of God's Word is a powerful testament to the enduring strength of faith. And as long as there are Bibles to distribute, there will be hope. Hope for peace through Jesus, hope for healing in Christ—and hope that one day, the sound of air alarms will be replaced by the sound of songs of praise.

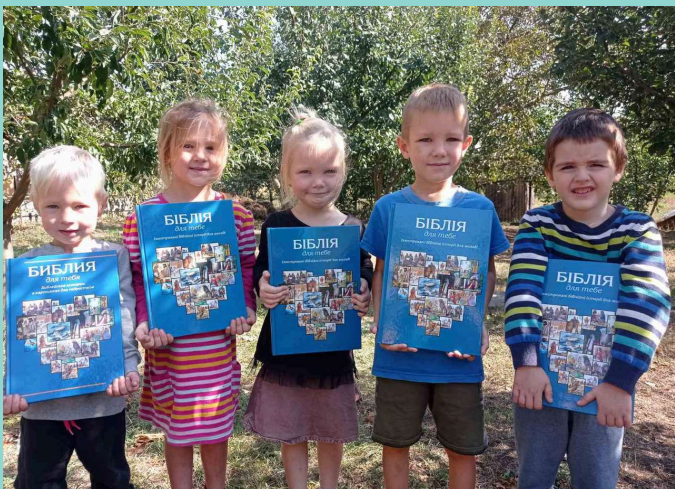

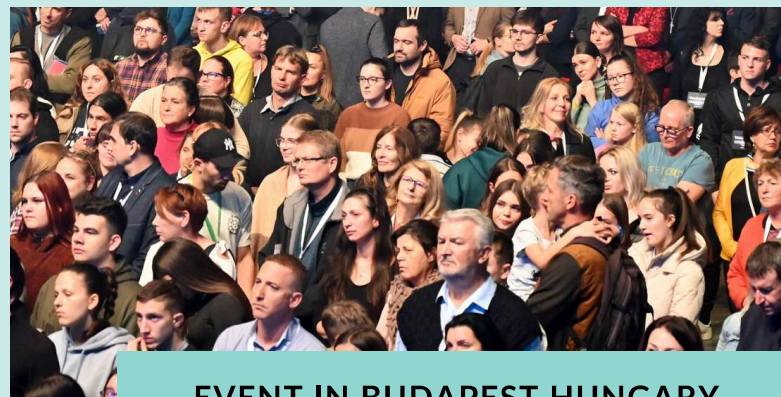
BIBLES IN HUNGARY

»» REPORT FROM CHURCH PARTNER

Thousands of people gathered in a large arena hall in Budapest, Hungary for the celebration of the 500th anniversary of Christianity spreading in Hungary. For followers of Jesus Christ in central Europe, year 1523 has significant meaning.

Throughout Europe, Christians gave their lives for their theological convictions during that time. Some—including Dr. Balthasar Hubmayer, a well-known Hungarian leader who was a contemporary of Martin Luther and John Calvin—who was burned at the stake.

Will Graham was the main speaker at the celebration and delivered a powerful Word of the Gospel. Believers brought many friends and families who did not know Christ and there were about 8,000 people who ended up at this event. Many heard the Gospel of Jesus for the first time. Event organizers share their gratitude to EEM because they were able to give Bibles to all the teenagers and children in attendance who wanted one. Praise God for the opportunity to reach the nation of Hungary on this special occasion.

RESILIENCE ON THE FRONTLINES >>> REPORT FROM PARTNER CHMD LIKY

In the war-torn city of Siversk, Ukraine, where daily life is defined by the constant threat of shelling and scarcity, the arrival of volunteers brings not just aid but a profound sense of hope. Through our efforts, the power of literature—specifically, the Word of God—serves as a lifeline for residents striving to maintain their faith amidst chaos.

Our team visited the embattled city of Siversk, just six kilometers from the combat zone. Once home to 11,000, only around 900 residents remain. The plight of Siversk underscores the urgent need for both material and spiritual support. As we shared a message from the Gospel of Matthew, reminding them that true wealth lies not in possessions but in community and faith, we witnessed its impact. The enduring spirit of Siversk residents highlights their deep connection to their home, one they refuse to abandon amidst the ruins. Due to constant shelling and lack of security, people do not have

confidence in the next minute of life. Faith in God and reading the Word help them to hold on and survive.

In such conditions, people gladly took books with stories and psalms. Faith becomes an unshakable foundation for locals in the most difficult conditions, helping them find peace and strength.

Thanks to EEM, the volunteers were able to leave behind Christian literature, enabling residents to grow in their faith even during the absence of visiting Christians. This provision is particularly crucial given the recent restrictions on volunteer access due to ongoing shelling, ensuring that spiritual support remains accessible during these challenging times.
