

- What happened this Sunday that stood out for you?


Pastor highlighted a few points on vision, let us discuss them:

Read: [Genesis 30:25-43](#)

- What does “You will produce what you see” mean in Jacob’s story (Genesis 30:25–43), and how does it apply to our lives today?
- How can speaking to God increase our vision, even when our current situation feels unfair or limiting?
- Jacob didn’t complain but positioned himself with vision. What are practical ways we can shift our focus from what we lack to what God has given us?
- What vision for your future “pulls” you forward despite present challenges, and how can you keep that vision alive?

## 2. The sheep conceived at the place of watering

Get two people to read: Ephesians 5:26 & John 7:38

- What does it mean that “the sheep conceived at the place of watering,” and how does God’s Word and Spirit water our lives?
- How does the place where you are planted influence what you produce in your life?
- What kind of “watering place” helps you grow in vision, faith, and action?
- Why is it important to move from just hearing “God loves you” to believing “God can do big things through you”?
- How does vision help you stay hopeful during delays and challenges?
- What bold step of faith can you take to move toward the vision God has placed in your heart?

## 3. What you see at the moment of conception matters

Get two people to read: Proverbs 23:7 & Habakkuk 2:2

- How does what we focus on in our minds shape what we produce in our lives?
- Why is it important to write down and make your vision visible?
- What are some ways small thinking can limit growth, and how can we stretch our thinking toward bigger vision?
- How do faith, obedience, and sacrifice play a role in moving toward God’s vision for your life?
- What is one practical action you can take to move closer to the vision God has given you?


## 4. No vision is fulfilled without someone bleeding for it
