WELCOME & CONNECT – ICE BREAKER

Welcome all members who are joining the Homecell.

PRAISE & WORSHIP

ENGAGE – THE WORD

What an incredible Sunday we had, Two Altars, from finished work to faithful response.

Ask the members the following questions to get them to interact:

- What stood out for you from the sermon Pastor preached on Sunday?
- What is one practical thing you have started doing different ever since you heard the sermon?

Before we start discussing the sermon, let me ask you these questions:

- What are the two altars that Pastor spoke about?
- How can you define the difference between the two altars?


1. ALTAR ONE: THE ALTAR JESUS ALONE ENTERED

Get a few people to read: Hebrews 10:10-12, John 19:30 & Ephesians 2:8-9

Now let us have a discussion, ask the members these questions and give people the opportunity to engage:

1. If Jesus finished the work, why do we still try to earn salvation?
2. What does it really mean to receive what Jesus did instead of trying to add to it?
3. How does believing salvation is earned change how we relate to God?
4. Why is grace harder to accept than effort?

5. What does "It is finished" mean for you personally?
6. If salvation is a gift, how should that change the way we live?

Closing remarks on altar one: While salvation is finished, God's purpose on the Earth is not.

2. ALTAR TWO: THE ALTAR JESUS WILL NOT ENTER

Get a few people to read: Romans 12:1, Luke 9:23 & John 20:21

Let us continue our discussion, ask the members these questions and give people the opportunity to engage: (note that question 4 & 6 can be questions that people would prefer to think about rather than answer out loud!)

1. If this altar is about surrender, what does surrender look like in everyday life?
2. What's the difference between being saved and being surrendered?
3. Why do you think God makes this altar voluntary?
4. **What might God be asking you to lay down, not to lose, but to realign?**
5. How can sacrifice be about purpose without becoming burnout?
6. **What areas of life are hardest for you to place on the altar?**
7. How does knowing God's love doesn't change free us to obey?
8. If surrender expands the Kingdom, what step could that start with this week?

Closing remarks on altar two: The second altar is deeply personal. How much you place on it is up to you.
