Dear Christian Friends,

Greetings to you in Jesus' Name of the Kingdom of God. The pastor of the Wesleyan Methodist Church at Logansport, Ind. asked me to pray about coming to his church about a year ago. When I prayed I sent him word that the church was not ready for revival yet. This stirred the church, Mr. Bishop related to me later. Then some months later I wrote and declared that the Lord has witnessed to me He would be with us on Dec. 4, 1964 at their church in revival. Praise the Lord. He was.

The weather was bad the first night, but Jesus was precious. The second night at the close of the service a dear brother asked me to pray for his condition when we had time. So I suggested that we sit down and learn his location in the soul. The Lord immediately revealed where he was and sent the power of the Holy Spirit and brought him to quick, sweet victory in the Kingdom of God. The Lord also then revealed to me he had nerve trouble and infestation in the right side of his body. The Lord was so dear and precious and privileged prayer for these needs and they were met just at that instant.

I called for the Pastor and Mr. & Mrs. Bishop to come into the main part of the church where we were. They were surprised for they knew the case to be a very difficult one as Mr. Bishop later said. Jesus had given our brother real victory and healing. It showed on his face as people said it was all over his countenance.

We then related some answers to prayer and said, "It is late, I guess I should start for home." The Lord immediately said stop. As I shared what had just so suddenly happened, one person said, "I told the Lord to show me something right now also if these things be true." He said, "I told Him to do it, I told Him to do it." He repeated this 3 or 4 times. So I stood still for a while. Then again I began to talk of the Kingdom of God and answers to prayer, also revelations to Jesus' glory.

We didn't leave the church until about 11:30 P.M. In about 2 hours the Lord revealed to me that I was to be at the church for Sun. School the next morning. I usually do not go to S.S. when I am to preach also. When I arrived at 9:30 A.M. I asked the Pastor where the young people's class met, as this is where the Lord wanted me. When I walked into the class you don't know how surprised I was to see the dear brother in the Lord, that had a few hours before asked God to show him something. I learned later that he had asked God to send the evangelist to the class to speak to the young people who were not used to staying

for Sunday morning worship. So he said, "I am not surprised to see you." Praise the Lord.

As Mr. Bishop gave the lesson the Lord had laid on his heart, I sat there and rejoiced, it was so wonderful to hear. I thought he made a magnificent presentation. Then he asked me to share what ever was on my heart. The Lord revealed that he was calling two of the class members to Christ right then. One of the youth, a fine young man, found Christ the next Wed. evening. It was wonderful. Praise the Lord.

In that same Sunday morning worship service the Holy Spirit drew and two precious young women were saved. Then God began to work on a senior high school boy. We nor any one there had ever seen any thing to equal this in all our lives. Words could never describe what took place. This precious young man who was under such great conviction, cried out in a loud voice in such a way as you probably never heard. It takes God to work like this, for the devil was opposing furiously. A 350 pound man, a brother in the Lord was standing just behind this boy. This Brother was really responsible for getting the young people to the service. Our Brother told me later, "I confess I'm not afraid of any thing on earth except snakes, but what happened here scared me until I saw that the Lord had given you calmness and assurance in your eyes. Then I was no longer frightened." Praise the Lord for undertaking and the senior boy was converted after some 20-30 minutes.

There were 20 or more victories during those enjoyable days with Rev. & Mrs. Robert Daughenbaugh and their dear people. A number were healed in the realm of the wonderful. The Lord revealed in the 8th to 10th minute of the sermon one evening to pray for persons with back trouble. Two women were healed in that minute. One had the trouble for 20 years and the other a few days less than 30 years. They and a few of us praised God for this answer to prayer.

I wish I could relate many other things the Lord did. One night a pastor and his wife from a neighboring city were in the service. She had been bed fast for 11 weeks. Many of the church people where they were serving told the pastor to let her go, his prayers were holding her from going to be with the Lord. The Lord sent Rev. Daughenbaugh and me to see them one day. God led us to pray. It was an ordeal but God answered. She was able to go Christmas shopping the next day, by God's grace. She also went that same evening to prayer meeting and it stirred the church there at Wabash. Praise the Lord for what He did for Jesus' sake.

As you see I have just written about one meeting and I have many more things I could tell you about this meeting, to Jesus' glory. We have been in meetings since the one related above. At the writing of this letter we are in a meeting at Bradford Park Church west of Muncie.

Don't think every thing has been roses, because we have had trials and afflictions. Satan has fought hard against us. Last Sun., Feb. 7th as we were on the way to service, two women ran a stop sign and I skidded 50 feet on wet pavement before we met. I could have killed them and the baby with them if I had not seen them in time to bring my car almost to a stop before we hit. Our car was damaged some \$426.00. We are now without a car for I don't know how long. Please pray for help and deliverance. May the Lord bless this report to your heart.

Greetings in the Kingdom of God. The Lord has been so very precious and wonderful, in many ways since we last wrote to you.

The meeting at Peaceful Valley Friends Church, near Winchester, Ind. was a time when the church experienced a revival. The Pastor told me, again the other evening he felt the church has been revived. Praise the Lord, for it came from God and we owe all to Him, indeed.

The first one saved in this meeting was a precious boy. Oh how happy he was. He said, "I'll never forget it, how it was when Jesus came to me." The last Sunday I was there, this boy came down the aisle, as I remember with his father helping him. He wasn't bearing any weight on one foot. I noticed it was swollen considerably. His mother informed me that he had not slept the night before because of pain and distress. I had not observed him during the service to see this until he was near me at the door and ready to leave for home with his father and mother. My heart went out to him immediately. I placed my hands on his head and began to call to God in Jesus' name asking for healing for His glory and honor. Praise the Lord, He sent it. I wish you could have been present. I am sure you would have remembered it, because it was wonderful to see him put his weight on the foot and walk down the aisle and back and go on home. He rested and slept that afternoon. Also his parents told us the infection ran out of his foot later that day.

My wife felt that since my other hat had worn out and had a hole in the top of it, I should get a new one; for a man of God needs to look his best in serving Him. While I was at Ball Store in Muncie, I prayed about where I should get the hat. I thought I would get it there, but the Lord said, "No." in my heart. I thought of Sears and Stillmans, and it was No. So I said to my wife, "I'll go to Pennys." While trying on a few hats, I heard the main man on the floor say to the saleslady, "Are you in pain?" She said that she was. I looked at her and saw her eyes were filled with tears. I asked her what had taken place. She told me of her fall and showed me her swollen wrist. I said let us pray. So we asked God to heal for Jesus glory, and He did. I wish you could have seen her face. "It doesn't hurt now, look, I can use it," she exclaimed. Praise the Lord I say.

Dear Friends,

Greetings in the Name of Jesus our wonderful Lord and Saviour. He who hath saved us with His own precious blood and hath given me the Holy Spirit, whereof I am glad and thankful to God.

Jesus never fails. For He is faithful, who hath promised, who also will do it. Praise the Lord.

The meetings at Pleasant Ridge were encouraging. Four young women came to Jesus on Sunday morning. I especially preached to the young people that morning. I felt it was so important that they find Christ while they are in their tender years; and then allow Him to guide all their lives. I said if they would do this, and pray faithfully and read God's Word and be willing to witness at each opportunity and always obey the Holy Spirit they would avert so much trouble and many pitfalls.

That was a precious morning. While we were rejoicing an older man going on 92 years of age came down the aisle and exhorted near the altar where the girls were kneeling. It was wonderful and he stated that night in the service that he thought he was the happiest he had ever been in his life that morning when the girls gave their hearts to Jesus. Praise the Lord.

I overheard one of the girls tell her mother that she was in pain. I learned that two years before she had caught her toe in a railroad tie and tore it up. It had hurt her since that time. Paul Hill on Fri. night at 7:20 to pray with us for God to protect and take care. He said to me on Monday morning following the tornado, "What if the Holy Spirit had not been able to give us the message and the burden so prayer could be made?" We prayed and God revealed a precious thing to us, that a number of people were spared from death and injuries because of the power of God intervening in answer to the prayers of His children. It would take a number of pages to tell you what has taken place here, for Jesus' sake. I shall not at this time tell you of them for there are many others to tell you about from prior meetings. Praise the Lord.

When Mrs. Helm and I were privileged to be at the E.U.B. Church at Pendleton, Ind., the pastor related the fact that he had a bleeding ulcer. He had had this for 6 to 7 months. He had lost 47 pounds. When we went to the table for lunch, I was asked to pray. The Holy Spirit brought his condition to my attention part way through the grace. So I asked Jesus to heal him. Next evening at Mr. Aults' the pastor said, "Praise be to God; and Bro. Helm will be glad to know that this food tastes so good." He had to force himself to eat for all those months, because he did not want to eat. Rev. Jackson told us a few times in the two weeks how good the food was. Also he was healed on Monday of the second week of a serious infection that God revealed to me he had had since he was six years old.
