Dear Christian Friends,

Not lifting his head, because of his distress, he replied that he had never stopped burning since last Friday. He had been this way for five days. I said, "My brother, I am going to call to God and ask Him to send Jesus the Holy Spirit and stop this for His glory." I instantly had the witness as I told him. I called to God in Jesus' Name and it was precious. Oh how much we have to praise the Lord for. I wish you could have seen the difference in the expression on his face. I left the room rejoicing in the Lord.

I returned to see him a few days later. He said, "Oh what a relief I have had." I said, "We owe all this to Jesus." He said, "Praise the Lord." I asked him if he ever knew the Lord. He answered that he had. I asked him if he had been true and faithful to Him. He replied, No. I asked him if he would follow me to Calvary and he answered Yes. We came to Jesus. I was so blessed there aren't words to describe what wonder was in my soul and being. I'm sure the angels were rejoicing also. Praise the Lord.

My body seems to be tired with very little times for rest between meetings. I cannot get home like I once did. Please, all of you say the Lord willing we will do this or that. It is only by God's grace and strength we can do anything. I want to thank all of our brothers and sisters in Christ who have helped with and for Revival For Our Day, Inc. There are a few who help us regularly and do not forget. We are in debt to the Lord for all of you.

The Lord worked in Burr Oak, Mich. I plead about as hard as I have in a number of years for the church to confess one to another. A few did. Praise the Lord. Souls were saved and cleansed and bodies were healed for the glory of God by Christ Jesus. I think of one fine young husband that got victory, He was not in a hurry to go home. He waited until he was sure we were going home. God gave some meetings after services were dismissed at night.

A mother spoke to me at the door one night, and asked if I felt God could heal her baby who was 15 - 20 months old. The baby had to be on a special diet and could not drink regular milk. I answered in the affirmative and we had prayer. They went home and poured out the solution she was taking and gave her milk. She was fine because of Jesus' healing her.

We went in to pray for a certain mother's baby one day. Just as soon as I finished prayer for the baby, I lifted my hand to the mother's head and stated that the Holy Spirit was leading me to pray for the mother also. She told her sister that while prayer was made a burden or weight fell off of her being. Praise the Lord. I learned later that her husband had deserted her almost a year before. So you can see why the Lord wanted prayer for her; she needed extra help from God to care for her three children.

I should have special prayer for my body. May the Lord anoint four persons to pray through for me. This is something I have never had in my body before. Greetings in the Kingdom of God. While I was in Michigan some weeks ago, I was impressed to go 100 miles for prayer. As I left the parsonage, I went into Surgis, Mich. and stopped for gas. I witnessed of Jesus' power and saving grace to the man operating the gas station. I asked if there was a shoe shining parlor and he said no, that is a thing of the past. As I left him I felt the same drawing to a shoe shining place. I found one in a few minutes. This delayed me long enough that zero morning to see a young man wanting a ride south at the junction of 66 & 12. When he got in my car I told him who I was and my mission. He had never been called of God before in his life. God sent the Holy Spirit and he was converted; he knew in his heart when Jesus' peace came in. Praise the Lord. Latter that day, God revealed a precious missinnary call which a person had with whom I prayed that afternoon. Isn't the Lord wonderful?

I was asked to go see a close friend of my brother Terrance. I had prayed with this precious brother about 4 or 5 times in 12 days. However, I was not able to get the leading or the unction in prayer that I longed for. When this brother had surgery the doctor came out to his wife and said it is only a matter of time and he will be gone. As I went into the hospital on the 13th day, I said, "Lord, wilt thou help and lead me to pray for Bro. Melvin, today?" God witnessed by the Holy Spirit going through my body and heart that He would anoint me to pray the prayer that would kill the cancer, for the glory of Jesus Christ our Savior and healer. Praise the Lord.

It was a precious experience, when I opened my eyes in the middle of the prayer. He had a light on his face and tears of thanks and praise to God were running down his cheeks. He said, "Oh! I felt Jesus come thru my head, neck, and body and a part of my pain is gone." We surely have been praising the Lord for every answer to prayer. This Brother went home in a week or two as I recall. He then went to Fla. for a few days and was a witness to some of his people the Jews. He attends a large Methodist Church 10 miles from my home. While in a church school class a few Sundays after his healing he told and witnessed to what God for Christ sake had done for him. The class seemed to be somewhat mystified. While I was there that day, the owner followed me in the prayer of repentance and gave her heart to Jesus. She said, "This is probably the first time you ever led anyone to Christ in a beauty salon." I replied, "You are correct." She was happy.

I hope I can remember the many experiences in various places, which I have had in the last 5 or 6 revivals. I want to share these with you in our next letter. Meanwhile, please continue to pray and remember us to the Lord as He leads and guides you. Jesus is truly wonderful. Oh, for more of His spirit and love.

Last Wednesday night I prayed with him at our home and it was wonderful how God answered all his questions and lifted all his anxieties. He was so happy.

They are very respected and highly esteemed people. They are wonderful people, but they just needed Jesus as their Savior and Lord. This was a very precious and worthwhile experience.

This morning has been no exception. God gave a Camp meeting in the Sunday School class at my home church on July 3rd. I had been asked the day before to lead the group. Jesus, the Holy Spirit led it, praise the Lord.

Some time ago I was busy with several things that had to have attention, when the phone rang. Some dear friends in the Lord had need of help. I asked them to meet me at the Middletown Rd. & S. R. 67. We had a real time together. I learned as we rode along that this dear brother had had a hard experience. The Holy Spirit revealed the situation to me. While we rode along the Lord led me to pray and bind those powers of the devil that had opposed and tried him, and cast them out thru Jesus' power. He was covered by the blood of Christ. The Holy Spirit had lifted him up out of the pew. I saw his wife try to pull him back down at first. He would come back up crying, "I can't get thru here!"
