The people may be able to pay a part of my travel expenses; they don't know for sure, since this is a faith project.

Dear Friends in Christ Jesus,

Greetings in the Kingdom of God. We never did get to share with you before what God did at Wilshire, Ohio last August. I beleive the Lord will have me share this with you now.

This was a very precious and rewarding revival with Rev. & Mrs. Everett Hogue. Rev. Hogue said to Mrs. Helm and me as we walked to the church the first evening, "I'm more excited about this revival than any I have had." It was all because of Jesus, the work of the Holy Spirit. After the service that evening he said that it was equivalent to a two weeks revival. There had been a few victories for Jesus' glory and honor.

On Wed. evening Jesus gave a very precious time, souls were saved and sanctified. Praise the Lord. Then on Fri. evening God gave a service almost like 3 weeks' revival in soul victories and healings. One was healed in the back of an ailment of 10 years. God revealed a cancer to me and showed me the direction it was from us. This dear sister lived a few miles away. Her mother said to me later that she had had her arms around her daughter when God led me to pray. She said that she could feel the power of the Holy Spirit going into her body. She came to the altar in that same service for the Lord was dealing with her considerably.

We prayed one night with a dear brother and the next night he told me that he had had a heart skip for about three years. Since prayer together that evening he had not had any of the trouble. It was gone. Praise the Lord. He told me later in the presence of Bro. Dick Moore, that he got more out of this revival than the previous 10 years of church attendance. This was all because of the work of the precious Holy Spirit.

At Rev. & Mrs. Hogues' home the Lord revealed to me that one of his sons had been called to preach for almost 6 years. As I shared this with him that evening I asked him if he could get the witness of it and he replied yes. When I told the older brother, Oliver, of this brother's call, he said, "Bro. Helm that goes all thru me." This was very encouraging to me. Rev. Oliver Hogue drove every night from Anderson, Ind. to Wilshire, Ohio to lead the music for this revival. His wife came every night but one. She was healed on Wed. the 24th of Aug. as Mrs. Helm and I prayed for her after church at the parsonage. This was very important what God did for Barbara that night. It was worth the world.

The Lord told me to have Bro. Oliver lead the singing in a revival the preceding month at Parr Memorial Methodist Church in Kokomo, Ind. Barbara came to that meeting and as a result of the work of the Holy Spirit she was converted. This was an answer to many of her family's prayers for some time. Barbara did not want to be a pastor's wife but before the meeting was 2/3 over at Wilshire she could hardly wait to enter the pastorate. This was an up-to-date miracle. The Lord witnessed that they were to go right into the pastorate as soon as possible. They are now having a wonderful time at St. Paris, Ohio. Praise the Lord. This meeting at Wilshire was so important.

One night at the parsonage the Lord came upon us in the dining room and God healed a few things in bodies. Also He answered prayer for one's father who was many miles away. This man's daughter, who was in the prayer group, said that she felt the power of the Lord within her as I prayed. It was precious when she got the report later from her father who was in a western state when we had prayed. Praise the Lord for this revelation and victory.

Also one night God revealed to me that death was coming at the edge of Wilshire and it would be terrible. I told Rev. Hogue he would really know when this happened. Sixteen days later two cars with young men crashed and some of them were killed. They were reported to have been playing "chicken" which is driving in the middle of the road. When they met neither driver would pull over so they met head-on. Bro. Hogue remembered it was the very direction and position that the Holy Spirit had told me it would be. Oh that men would obey and fear the Lord. Please pray much for us.

Dearly Beloved in the Lord Jesus Christ,

Twenty-five years ago today the Lord sent me to the hills and mts. of Tenn. I thought I would die many times, but mile after mile the Lord gave me strength, help, encouragement and assurance. It was most precious how He did it. After going about 400 miles, He turned me to the right and told me this is the place. I saw there a little Methodist Church. We had a real experience on that circuit with Rev. J.W. Dew and his people. We met there Mr. & Mrs. Clifford Nickols who invited us to stay with them. We were perfect strangers to them and all the people, but they knew us by the help of the Holy Spirit. Praise the Lord! We have never forgotten their fine hospitality. The Lord would pour down His Holy Spirit on us four night after night in family worship. Our friendship has been precious in Jesus. Mrs. Helm and I are indebted to Jesus and all His people. We were really needed at Rev. Dew's church for those two weeks of meetings. We missed only one or two nights, the Lord helping.

We are greeting you today from the home of Mrs. T.W. Wood here in Fla. It is so enjoyable to be here and we are deeply grateful for the privilege of these nice accommodations. The weather has been so beautiful. They said on the radio an hour and a half ago that it was 24 degrees in Ft. Wayne, Ind. This morning while I write this letter in my car I'm perspiring. From where I am now I can lift my eyes and see God's hand made ocean in all directions. It is gorgeous indeed; oh how great is our God. His faithfulness is endless and reaches to the end of eternity. Praise the Lord.

On our way south I was able to witness to a number of persons, one day to eleven and a few each day. After we arrived I wanted to go deep sea fishing. The man at one place asked me to go with him the next day. I told him I would not go because that is the Lord's day and I would be in God's house. As I left the Lord told me I could not go on that boat nor in that area. So I went a few miles south to another place. There I met Capt. Bob and told him I would be there Mon. morning. On Tues. after we were out a while I prayed to the Lord, "Father you did not will for us to be here in Jan., Feb. or March, when Mrs. Helm and I thought maybe thee might lead us. But thee had us in one revival after another. We are here now and not on the other boat a few miles north, but on this one. Would thee let me catch a nice fish?" I don't remember whether I said a large sail or a big one but in just two minutes a fish hit my line. I had a tussel for 20 minutes getting him in. After getting him near the boat 3 times and each time he would dive again, I prayed Lord help me and give me strength. I had not had so great a physical strain for years. When we landed it it was a bull dolphin, 50 inches long and 32 lbs. Bull dolphins are rarely caught; it is usually females. One man on the boat said they had not had a fish caught on their boat that large for months. All the men on the boat got a real thrill out of that and I was privileged to witness to them about Jesus. I was also able to witness to a graduate of Emory Univ. and to a wealthy man from Seattle, Wash. I shared with the latter man how we need to know Jesus in our heart. When we reached the dock a fine looking man 45 to 50 said that if he could catch one like that he would be happy. I was able to witness to some there; and tell them it was all because of Jesus.

We need your prayers so much. I had quite a meeting here in a fruit market. I told the manager that I could have taken my orange juice and gone, but I would have missed the opportunity. He said that if I had he would not have been enriched. It was an enjoyable time. Praise the Lord. So you see we are able to deal with souls while being on a vacation.

We are to be at Prairie Grove Church 2 miles north and 2 miles west of Gaston, Ind. beginning May 9th. Then we go to Roan MT. Tenn. on May 24th. Thank you for your prayers and help. The Lord reveals that only a few persons have the burden for the finances of Revival For Our Day, Inc. For all that has been done we are in debt to God for it. Oh! for a revival, an outpouring of the blessed Holy Spirit in the Church for Jesus and souls' sake. It is the only solution to all our ills and troubles of our very lost world and sick church. The trouble is all because men will not obey and yield to God. Thanks to God for watch between us while we are absent one from the other. Please pray for us. Thanks to the directors and treasurer's assistant.

(Three days later) I went fishing again today with 20 otherrd on the same boat. They wanted me to put money in a pool and the one who caught the biggest fish would win. I told them no, I am a minister of the Gospel and witnessed to them about Jesus. After fishing for hours and catching nothing, I suggested to the Capt. to go south. In a little while I had a fikh on my line. It was a kingfish. When we finally landed it and later quit for the day it was the largest fish on the boat. So I was able to witness again for Jesus. If I had joined the pool I would have won. This gave me another opportunity to talk to them about God.

Dear Ones in Christ Jesus,

We are in a wonderful meeting in Ansonia, Ohio. The Lord witnessed in my heart He would be with me there on June 29 to July 8. When I called the pastor a few weeks ago to relate this revelation, he was pleased. His people wondered at this time over the 4th of July, how it would work out. The Lord gave 7 to 9 victories the first service, the next evening 2 or 3. Last Mon., 3rd, we prayed with 31 all together for various needs. Tuesday evening, the 4th, was a very precious service. One of the finest of the older men of the church came to the pulpit to speak to me. He said, "This service was like when Jesus was on earth; God was leading and helping the people in a wonderful way." Praise the Lord.

One woman had had trouble with varicose veins for years. When Jesus touched her by the Holy Spirit it felt as though to her that wights fell off her limbs. A young man had had a 900 pound block of cement fall on his leg, just above the knee, last Thursday. It had never stopped hurting. He said that he had to drag it as he walked to the front of the church. Prayer was made and all pain was gone. In a happy voice he said, "The pain is gone." He went to his seat and walked well. Praise the Lord for His healing power.

A number of young men and women have come to Christ in these services, because of the Holy Spirit's drawing and power. We cannot praise the Lord enough for God's working in these days.

We were at Roan Mt, Tenn. in services May 24 - June 11. God gave victories for Jesus' glory and honor. One man was sanctified and the Lord delivered him from tobacco. He had used it for over 30 years. Another dear brother was prayed for that he might be delivered from smoking. He took Mrs. Helm and me for a drive thru the mts. (120 miles) the next day. I saw him reach for cigarettes and I said, "God is able to remove this from your sub-conscious mind." He has not reached for any since. Praise the Lord for deliverance.

The Lord, by the Holy Spirit, revealed in the third or fourth service at Roan Mt. that some one had a blood infection. We prayed to God in Jesus' Name. One dear sister said that the power of God hit her like a bolt of lightning. She said, "Lord if that were for me touch me again." She jumped to her feet in tears, oh how happy she was. A number of boils on her right hand and arm were dried up by the next morning. She had had a blood infection for about 27 years. Praise the Lord for guidance and healing. Without Him we will never know anything else.

Another lady had pain and trouble in her stomach. Prayer was made for her at the door. She was healed and had no more pain, she told me later. One lady came who had ulcers and God healed her. He revealed to me that He would heal stomach trouble and she was the one. She said, "I haven't needed my medicine since." At first she did not realize she was the one who was healed (for I did not know who God was having me pray for). When she noticed that the trouble and pain had left she knew she was the one. She was thankful to Jesus and was really happy about this deliverance.

I want to relate that while we were in Fla. last April, we desired to go to Key West. Day after day when I asked the Lord about it, He would not give us the leading to go. After ten days He let us go. On the way I stopped for gas south of Miami. A young man was converted. He was happy and I was too. I said to Mrs. Helm, "This was worth more than the trip; it is valued more than the World itself." Praise the Lord. Days later as we were coming thru Ga., I stopped for a map. As I went thru the door I said to all 10 or 12 men, "Jesus is Lord," and preached a while to them. They looked surprised and amazed. It seemed that my heart shook because of their attitudes. When I got in the car the Lord revealed that 8 of those men had been called to preach, from 5 to 35 years ago. I had to tell them of Jesus. When I stopped I had no idea that was going to happen, but God had me there on time. I had a meeting in a barber shop in Virginia. I spoke in Knoxville, Tenn. at Rev. Field's church. The people were so hospitable and kind to us. We went on to near Washington D.C. and preached at the church where my brother Edward attends and directs the choir. Rev. Oliver is the pastor.

I might also say thanks to Rev. Reece and Rev. Moore for coming to get my car when we started to Roan Mt. It got so hot it would not run very good. Rev. Reece loaned me his car so we could go on to Roan Mt. Our car has been re-conditioned for the third time. The Lord has been so wonderful. Thanks to the 12 who have the real burden for the finances of Revival For Our Day.

He revealed this to me Aug. 28th. Praise the Lord.

Oh how I appreciate Mrs. Helm and what she has meant to me. We go next to Camp Emmanuel, 3 miles east of Bunker Hill, Ind. on s.r. 218. The dates are Sept. 1-11. Then we go to St. Paris, Ohio, Sept. 14 - 22 ? Then to Vienna, Va. Oct. 3-10. Then to Ponca City, Okla. Oct. 18-28. This will all be by God's grace, protection, help, and guidance.

We were in services with Brother & Sister Floyd Lacy at the Emmanuel Church near Bunker Hill, Ind. from Sept. 1 - 11. The Lord revealed to me at the beginning of the meeting that some one present had just a short time to live and be saved and ready to meet Jesus. One of our friends called me from Ohio a few days after the meeting closed to tell me that one of the men who took up the offering one night at Bunker Hill had died suddenly. Dear Beloved in the Lord Jesus,
