Praise the Lord for the Holy Spirit of God to guide, comfort, and help us thru all ways of life. I am thankful to God and Jesus for all your prayers and assistance during my hospital experience.

The Lord gave such help, assurance, calmness, quiet, and undergirding to me as they took me into surgery. Some of my family and Dick and Mary Moore went into the chapel of the hospital to pray and wait on God while I was in surgery. Bro. Dick went up to the Bible and opened it. The first verse he saw was, "My times are in thy hand..." (Psa. 31:15. This is a promise God gave us when we were beginning this walk of faith, years ago. Praise the Lord for victory and deliverance that was so precious.

I tried to pour love and appreciation into the lives of everyone who came into my room while I was there. I think I might have missed one or two. All who ministered to me were so nice and kind.

One of my sisters in Christ was crying and praying, "Why, dear Lord, does thy servant have to have this surgery?" The Lord spoke to her and said, "This is just another missionary journey that he is to make for Me." Praise the Lord!

My doctor instructed me that I could not drive a car for 6 weeks after surgery. So my dear wife has been my driver. However he allowed me to drive on the 40th day, which was Jan. 6th. I am very thankful to God for helping me in my body as well as every other way. Praise the Lord.

I have many experiences to share, that God has given me thru these days and weeks. These are precious answers to prayer and guidances of the Holy Spirit.

While I was at the Hospital, I was privileged to pray four times with my doctor, twice with a nurse, and twice with one of the maids. I also prayed once with a Brother down the hall, who was ready to go home.

It may be that I can share a few other things and revelations during the hospital experience at the Waiting Upon God in Feb.

I called my brother, Terrance on Dec. 24th at 6:40 A.M. and Oh, what a wonderful time the Lord gave us. God revealed 11 different places down his back in the vertebrae that needed help. Also He revealed an infection in the bladder that would come in 5 years. There also was a deposit in his feet and ankles and in fibers and tissues that began to be made in 1936. We both were thankful to Jesus for all these revelations and for the privilege to pray about them.

After this call, I felt I should call my brother, Edward, near Washington, D.C. about their coming for Christmas. He had told us that his office was supposed to work Dec. 24th so they would not be able to come until the 25th unless something was changed. When I placed the call there was no answer, so I felt there had been a change and they were on their way here to surprise us.

I called Terrance back and began to share what I felt with him; he felt this was true. I began to pray for their (Edward and family) travel to be protected

and the Lord revealed that a person full of liquor and wine would come across the highway and hit them. He also revealed a little later that all four of them would have been killed. So we prayed deliver, help, and a few petitions and when we prayed "delay" the Holy Spirit witnessed that God would delay the person and they would miss. Praise the Lord for all revelations and answers to prayer of God through Jesus our wonderful Lord by the Holy Spirit.

I was led to call a sister in Christ and when she returned the call she said, "I Don't know what I'm going to do. I'm hurting thru the chest and I can hardly get my breath, yesterday and today." So I began to pray and the Lord revealed her trouble was in the walls of her heart. After a few requests the Lord answered and she said, "I got that prayer, Brother." Praise the Lord!

As I hung up the phone, I got the burden of death. She would have left us on the next Wed. God answered for His glory and honor. She and her dear husband were so appreciative of what Jesus had done for them and us. To God be praise always.

I called a dear couple in the Lord at 5:30 A.M. some time ago and the precious wife had not rested hardly at all during the night. The dear husband told me this. We began to pray and it was revealed that she had 30 to 40 burdens over the world. They both could tell in their hearts each leading and revelation the Lord gave me concerning where and what her burdens were for. When we were thru she said to her husband and me "Oh, this is like a night's rest." Praise the Lord!

There are other revelations we would like to share, for God's glory, some time if He were to lead. We owe all to the Lord for all guidance, help, provision, healing, instruction in righteousness and revelation thru the precious Holy Spirit, the Word of God. Amen.

We are looking forward to being in the Waiting Upon God in Christ Jesus, Feb. 19, 20, 21. We know we are completely dependent upon the leading of the precious Holy Spirit for this sacred time together with all who are of like mind in Jesus our only Savior and Redeemer. We all need to be in unity of faith concerning doctrine and the leading of the Holy Spirit, believing that the real evidence of Christianity is that we love one another as Christ so loved us. Also we need to be in perfect unity in every way and with one another, in order that God may have and do as He wills. One person present who is skeptical or has unbelief or doubt can hinder God's plan.

Also we need to be attentive during the sessions and not whisper, for this will distract others. We want each one to witness whenever God leads or testify as He directs.

I trust all the dear young people that we will be privileged to have with us will sit with their parents. In that way they will not be tempted (over)

to talk or visit during the sessions of the Waiting. This will be so helpful I am sure, as we wait and trust before God.

Only a few have sent there reservations for meals to Rev. Reece as yet. It is thru eating our meals at the Inn that really makes possible the use of the rooms for the 3 days. Please pray for our strength and help from God at this time. Thank you.

Be sure to obey each leading of the Holy Spirit; otherwise we do not hear the message or get very much of the Word of God, neither are our prayers effective. We must obey God.

I am grateful for the Cullums and the Harmons for printing our letters recently. Thanks to Rev. & Mrs. Reece for getting the letters out thru these 8 years and over, and for all the other work they do for Revival For Our Day. Also we appreciate the work done by Rev. Hill and his assistant, Mrs. John Langdon in keeping the financial records of R.F.O.D. This involves many hours every month.

Dear Ones in Christ Jesus,

We have had a great and exceedingly wonderful time in the Land of our Lord; the land where Jesus walked and lived among men for 33 years. God gave all of us a safe trip from our homes in ten states to New York on Dec. 29th. On Sat. the 27th snow & ice were forecasted. We were trusting the Lord to hold it back until we all got on the plane in Indianapolis to go to New York. They announced on the radio that in Cincinnati there was ice on the roads at 5:00 A.M. on the 29th. Also we were told there was ice on the roads 50 miles north of Evansville, Ind. We prayed that the ice and snow would be held in the south for all 32 of our group going from Indianapolis were coming from the northern and central parts of the state. This prayer and desire was answered. My brother, Edwin, who took Mr. & Mrs. Johnson and my family to the airport, said it was quite different going home after noon for the rain was freezing on the roads. All of the 32 had good roads going to Indianapolis for our flight to New Y.

I was anxious for all of the 71 going with me for they were scattered in ten states. We were trusting that each one would be able to press through to get to N.Y. in time to go on the flight that evening. The ones who came from Okla. had a difficult time making connections, but they made it. Glenn Shaver told his wife on Sat. or Sun. that they would not wait until Mon. but would go on Sun. and stay over night in N.Y. They did this; and they learned on Mon. that no plane was able to land nor take off from St. Louis on Mon. the 29th. because of extremely bad weather. So you see if they had not done this they would not have been with us.

We had many trials in making the arrangements for this Tour. When we arrived in N.Y. we had a trial over the plane ticket for one of our number. A proper transfer had not been made from one who had to cancel his trip to the one taking his place. So my song evangelist and I had to purchase a ticket for this one to be able to go with us for \$840.00, as this is the round-trip fare of anyone going tourist rate from New York to the Holy Land. The personnel of the airline did all they could to help us work out this problem. So you see that when you compare the cost of an individual ticket with the total price we paid on the group plan, we saved a few hundred dollars; for the \$570.00 we paid for the Tour included the flight, all lodging, all meals and the buses and guides for all sightseeing. We are trusting the Lord to supply the \$840.00. Some of those who support our ministry have helped and some have promised to help as they are able. The dear one for whom we bought the ticket, had already paid the \$570. to the person whose place she was taking, so you see it was our responsibility to see that she could go. The problem resulted from human error.

We had a good flight from N.Y. to Paris, then on to Athens, and then to Tel Aviv. At Tel Aviv we were met by a wholesale Tours representative who guided us thru to the two buses waiting to take us to Jerusalem. We had learned in N.Y. that a change had been made of our hotel. We were to go to the Palace Hotel instead of the Holy Land Hotel. We wondered about this, but when we arrived we could see the Hand of God in it for the Holy Land Hotel is surrounded by other buildings with only a very limited view; but the Palace Hotel is located on the slopes of Mt. of Olives and we had a wonderful view of the west side of the walled city of Jerusalem. One cannot imagine what it was like; you would have to see it to know how really beautiful it was.

Our food was so good. Most of our people were surprised at the quality of food which was served to us. The owner-manager of the Palace Hotel is a graduate of Wayne State University in Detroit, Mich. He understood how to buy and prepare food that we would enjoy as well as how to make us comfortable and feel at home. The men who served us our meals were so precious to us. I loved them nearly every time I went to the dining room. They looked forward to this after a few times. I also loved the door keeper and the bell boys almost daily. Several other brothers loved these men also. The manager told me, "We have learned through you this week." One of the handsome men at the desk told me, "You have taught us things since you came to us." He also told my brother, Terrance, "When I get converted, I would like to have it like Rev. Helm." (This dear man wrote the message that appears at the end of my letter.) Of course we are unworthy of this high compliment. We owe all to Jesus in every way.

On the first day of our sightseeing it rained nearly all day. All 72 of us tramped through the wet streets of Old Jerusalem. I was as wet as I had been in 30 years. Some were more soaked than I. Rev. Hill and others without hats had water running down their necks. Some had feet so wet the dye in their socks came off on their feet. A number of us began to plead the blood of Jesus over us when we started out and as we continued, also the stripes and promises of Jesus. As far as I know no one had a serious sore throat or cough from the rain for the next two or three days. All of this was because of Jesus' helping us. This was so precious, for we were out in the rain for nearly six hours altogether.

On Thursday the weather was so beautiful. We went to the Garden of Gethsemane. The Holy Spirit witnessed at one time that I was within 19 feet of the spot where Jesus agonized in prayer, "not my will, but thine be done." We sang, "In The Garden", and it was beautiful for the Lord blessed us so. Here and in other places also,

our guide read Scriptures that were appropriate to the place where we were.

We went to Bethany, the home of Mary, Martha, and Lazarus. We went to the tomb where Jesus raised Lazarus from the dead. We then went on through the Wilderness of Judah and we were all surprised at what it was like. As we went to Jericho, we found that it is an oasis in the desert. Oranges and bananas grow there. We saw the spring which Elisha made sweet at the commandment of God as recorded in the Old Testament. We were not far from the spot where Jesus had the precious experience with Zaccheus, which is recorded in Luke 19. We went on to the Dead Sea and the place where the Dead Sea Scrolls were found. Most of us tasted of the water in the Dead Sea. It was the most different taste that I have ever known.

We saw several flocks of sheep as we passed thru the country sides. Each flock had a shepherd. In most of them there were goats grazing with the sheep. On Fri. we went by the road which leads to Emmaus. We could not get there by bus because the road was destroyed in the six-day war. We went to Jacob's well. There we had an experience never to be forgotten, I trust. We went thru the place of Dothan where Joseph was met by his brothers and sold into slavery. We were a few miles from Jacob's home that morning. We saw the village of Nain where Jesus raised the widow's son from death. We saw the Mt. of Transfiguration. It was a unique place; it stands out from all the other mountains and is surrounded by planes on all sides. We dipped our hands in the Jordan River; and after lunch at Tiberias we crossed the rough Sea of Galilee on a motor launch. When I first saw the Sea of Galilee as we approached it from a high elevation, the Holy Spirit witnessed in my heart with some power. I asked the Lord where he fed the 5000 and He revealed it to my heart. Two or three hours later as we were crossing the Sea the guide told us of the place where Jesus fed the 5000; and it was the same place where the Holy Spirit had revealed to me. Praise the Lord. As I pointed my pen around the Sea, He witnessed where He first found James and John, also where Peter walked on the water and then began to sink. Also He revealed where Peter was when Jesus said, "Thrust out a little from the land." Luke 5. It was wonderful. We praise Jesus and Our Heavenly Father for all these blessings and help.

There are many other things to share as the Lord may allow. Remember our next R.F.O.D. Fellowship meeting on Feb. 28th at 8:00 A.M. at Parker United Methodist Church. Please pray for us that we may be strengthened and be able to proceed to obey every leading of our blessed Lord Jesus Christ.

Dear Ones in Jesus the Christ of God,

We are trusting the Lord and believing God for the Holy Ghost Revival at God's time and place. This must be for Jesus in every way, not for any organization or person, but for God's glory only. I do not know if very many or any will really understand this statement or not. The Revival will be according to complete yieldedness and obedience and true Holy vision in Jesus our Lord.

The meeting of Revival For Our Day Fellowship on Feb. 28th was very precious. The Lord was very near. God was glorified in His Son Jesus. We began with prayer and then the Lord led to have a special song. As I prayed through the list of singers, the Holy Spirit witnessed that John Langdon was to sing. Now he would rather that any one else sing than him, but the one who wants to sing is seldom ever led by the Holy Spirit to sing. He sang, "Fill My Cup, Lord", and souls were blessed.

Then the Lord witnessed in my heart that I was to pray for the healing of the body. We cried out for the healing of persons who had trouble in the head. Four were healed for Jesus' glory. One of these had suffered for six weeks with pain in the head. Next we prayed for healing in the neck. We learned this result the next day (Sunday). This will be a 15 day tour because there are no 10 day tours available at this season of the year. However we will see so much more on this tour than on the 10 day tour last winter. We go first to Athens and Corinth and see the historic places of ancient Greece and places where Paul was. From here we go to Cairo and visit famous places in Egypt- The Pyramids, The Sphinx, King Tutankhamen's Citadel, Mohammad Ali Mosque etc. Then we go to Beirut where we see the Dog River, Tripoli Rd., The Holy City of Phoenicians. Then to Baalbek to see the City of Pagan Gods, The Street Called Straight, House of Annanias, and other historic Christian sites. Then to the Holy Land. Brochures will be coming soon to give complete details of the itinerary.

Since this is a 15 day tour and in the peak travel season, the cost is more than the 10 day economy tour we took last Dec.-Jan. The cost will be \$849.00 plus foreign airport taxes and gratuities (about \$20-25) which the tour host gives to the guides, bus drivers and hotel and restaurant workers for the whole group. It is possible to go on a credit plan with \$85.00 down and about \$35.00 per month for 24 months.

We do not have much time to get arrangements made. So, if you are interested in going and would like further information and an enrollment form, let us hear from you by return mail. This does not commit you to go. If you are ready to enroll NOW, please send \$25.00 enrollment fee and your name, address and phone number. Make the check for the enrollment fee payable to: Holy Land Tour, by Rev. Loran Helm.

We hope some of you who went with us before will be able to go on this tour. Will you each one pray and obey God's leading about going? If you want us to pray with you about knowing God's will for your going or not, please be willing to accept the answer He gives and then press thru all the obstacles of the enemy to do His will. From here we go to Cairo and visit famous places in Egypt- The Pyramids, The Sphinx, King Tutankhamen's Citadel, Mohammed Ali Mosque etc. Then we go to Beirut where we see the Dog River, Tripoli Rd., The Holy City of Phoenicians. Then to Baalbek to see the City of Pagan Gods, The Street Called Straight, House of Annanias, and other historic Christian sites. Then to the Holy Land. Brochures will be coming soon to give complete details of the itinerary.

Since this is a 15 day tour and in the peak travel season, the cost is more than the 10 day economy tour we took last Dec.-Jan. The cost will be \$849.00 plus foreign airport taxes and gratuities (about \$20-25) which the tour host gives to the guides, bus drivers and hotel and restaurant workers for the whole group. It is possible to go on a credit plan with \$85.00 down and about \$35.00 per month for 24 months.

We do not have much time to get arrangements made. So, if you are interested in going and would like further information and an enrollment form, let us hear from you by return mail. This does not commit you to go. If you are ready to enroll NOW, please send \$25.00 enrollment fee and your name, address and phone number. Dear Believers in Jesus the Christ,

Greetings in the Kingdom of God, the work of the precious Holy Spirit. If one misses this way he has lost his soul. If we know and experience Christ in our heart by faith, we have the beginning of real life and true happiness.

While I was in Fla. last March, I talked to Rev. Reece on the 7th. He asked me if I felt it would be God's will for us to go to the Holy Land again soon. If only you could know how I felt in the flesh. I dreaded and drew back very much before I prayed concerning this question. Both of us found out a few months later why I felt this way. We had many trials and difficulties in making the arrangements and plans for the trip. The tour agency staff would tell us one thing and then it would be changed. This happened more than once concerning the same matter. Satan fought us both times (last Dec. and this time) we planned these tours. When we prayed about the question of going again soon, the Holy Spirit witnessed that we were to go. I asked what month- April, May, June- and God revealed that June was the month. When I prayed about the day, it was the 15th. We also prayed at that time about how we were to go to New York; and it was by car. This was not what I wanted to do, but this we did.

The Lord blessed us so wonderfully all the way to N.Y. The fellowship God gave us was rich. Rev. Hill said as we were in Penn. when we arrived in N.Y. and met the travel agent, we had a surprise waiting for us- we were to fly on a new Boeing 747 to Paris. I had never seen one until then. It was gigantic. The jet intake was over 6 feet in diameter. It was so roomy inside; it seemed we were in a large meeting place. We had very little turbulence on the flight; we had prayed for a good flight some months before we left. Everyone with me enjoyed it, as far as I know.

We did not wait very long in Paris before continuing to Athens. We really had an enjoyable time there- much more than last Jan., by God's grace and gift. We had a delightful time dining on the roof of the hotel where we were staying. There was a full moon each night; and it was like eating in a garden. The sight was also beautiful from St. George's Church, where we looked over the city of Athens at night. I have seen the great cities from Mt. Wilson, at 4000 ft. altitude and Chicago from a plane as I came into it. This sight in Athens was a little special somehow.

Our trip to Egypt was really wonderful indeed. As we began our descent in the plane we looked to our right and we were looking down at the full moon for a few minutes. Then we could see the great Nile River soon and we flew then up the Nile to Cairo. This was a beautiful and unexplainable experience. Our lodging in Cairo was on a large river boat docked on the east bank of the Nile River. Very few persons in the U.S. can say they spent 3 nights on the Nile River. We were told the population of Cairo is 5,000,000 and is the largest city in Africa. Oh the sights and sounds we experienced. I was privileged to greet with Christian love, 11 of the men who worked on the boat. Some of them said, "Do come back." They appreciated our Christian love for them. About 10 minutes before we were to leave for Beirut, a dear fine looking man met me on the stairway between the decks and I put my arm around him and loved him. As I put my arm around him, the Holy Spirit touched both of us in our hearts; he felt it too. He came immediately out to the bus and waited almost at attention until we drove away. He would lift his hand as I lifted mine. I had not met him in the 3 days we had been there. I feel he will never forget our experience; and if he were in this country, I feel he would be one of our closest brothers in the Lord Jesus. P.T.L.

To see the Pyramids was a great earthly experience for all of our group, as far as I know. I do not know if we could really comprehend what we were seeing or not. To be close to the place where Moses was found on the Nile River was a precious time. We thank the Lord for all the blessings He gave us. We also were privileged to see the place where Joseph, Mary and the baby Jesus spent some time in Egypt.

When we arrived in Lebanon we saw some beautiful sights. We saw a number of historical places dating back to earliest civilization. We went on to Syria to Damascus to the Street called Straight where Paul was led. We saw also the house of Ananias whom God told to go to pray for Paul. Also we saw the place where Paul was lowered over the wall in a basket. This was a precious time and the fulfillment of many years for me for I have wanted to see Damascus for many years.

Another surprise for some of us was that we stayed over-night in Cyprus in the Conrad Hilton hotel. This was because of air travel complications, which proved a blessing.

I do not want to fail to tell you that there was a breeze blowing everywhere we went. Our guide in Egypt told us it could be easily 115 to 120 that day, but it was 83 degrees. We had a breeze in Lebanon and in Cyprus also. They said it had been hot in Cyprus, but it was cool when we arrived. I had prayed for cool weather for months before we departed (from March 7th on in fact). Praise the Lord, He sent it.

Our hotel in Beirut was just a little way from the Mediterranean Coast. It was such a beautiful view from our balcony. This could hardly be excelled any where in the world. Our guides were very good everywhere we went.

The Lord revealed to me that 3 of our group would be healed as we went on our journey. Rev. Morgan had not been well for some weeks before we left. From the time we left our homes for N.Y., he began feeling better and improved each day. In 9 days he had fully recovered. Praise the Lord.

God comforted and helped all of us who had to leave our companions at home. He also watched over each of them and worked things out for them while we were abroad. We never heard a shot while we were there, except for some planes which flew over

our bus shooting at targets to our left. The guide told us these were reserve pilots who kept in practise each week. We did not hear any guns from the war fronts, as we did in Jan.

The weather was cool in Jerusalem at night. Some of our people shivered as they walked outside at night. There was a breeze during the day also. Our guide told us it had been 150 degrees at the Dead Sea 4 weeks before. I don't see how it could have been that hot, but several of us heard him say that. It was in the 90's when we were there. It was hotter back here when we returned.

The lady who represented the travel agency in Israel, came to me as I was standing on the elevator with Rev. Reece, Rev. Elrod and Mr. Ellis (Tour Hosts) and said, "Rev. Helm, you will come back? Come back by next Nov." She turned to the other three men and said, "This man is a spiritual man." Then she turned to me and said, "I would like to come to the states and be in your church." As the elevator door closed, Rev. Elrod said, "Oh look, we are leaving her in tears." This was all because of Jesus, the work, keeping, and guiding of the sacred Holy Spirit. Praise the Lord.

I have met very few persons in my lifetime that have recognized my calling. Last Jan. I met a dear brother on the streets of old Jerusalem, just a short distance from where Jesus rose from the dead, who knew me. The young man who was our guide then called this brother while we were in Jerusalem this last time and told him there was a person at St. George Hotel... He said right away, "That person is Rev. Helm." I've seen him for some days in an inner image." When they came to the hotel to meet us we had a little meeting with some of our group. He told our dear ones, "We would like to keep this man of God in Jerusalem, but I will know when he will be returning."

When we left Tel Aviv, the hostess on the plane told my brother Edwin that the head pilot over all Air France was our captain on this flight. We flew over Corsica and the Isle of Crete into Nice, France. Then we flew on to Lisbon, Port. where we refueled and took off for New York. We had to fly over N.Y. for 40-60 minutes before we could land and then we had to taxi around the terminal for about an hour before we could get a "gate" to enter. The Lord helped us so I praised Him even though some of our group missed their flights home. He had brought us home safely.

When I went to get my car in the parking lot, of all the cars our folk drove to N.Y., ours was the only one that had been damaged. The left rear door and back panel looked sick. The front door had also been hit. I began to praise the Lord that my car was there, that God had brought us back this far safely, and that the car would start after sitting idle for 15 days. May I say, to Jesus' glory and honor, because it would take Him to help us do this, when I saw our new car banged up there was no hurt in my heart or bad feeling. He gave me peace, rest, and contentment, all because of God's power, the Holy Ghost. The Lord has all praise, for without Him I could not stand anything; I mean this.

The Holy Spirit witnesses to a few of His children that I need 8 weeks of solid rest. Thanks to each of you who are helping us in our ministry of the Lord Jesus, the Holy Spirit of God. Without your faithful prayers and offerings we cannot continue.

The early Tuesday and Thursday morning services were serious and precious also. The Saturday morning service was sacred, holy and important. The first Sunday night the Lord revealed to us to pray for the body. He revealed to us concerning back trouble. One dear brother from Columbia, Mo., was healed in his back in the location where the Lord had revealed it to me. Afterwards, his brother said to me, "I knew you were praying for Harold as soon as you prayed."

The Lord also revealed for us to pray for the elbow. One of the precious sisters had broken her elbow three years ago, and since then a bone spur was growing out of it. The doctors had said that surgery would be required to cut this out, which would probably leave the elbow stiff. They felt that surgery would be the only solution to this bone spur. A few minutes after prayer, Sister Foley looked down at her elbow and the bone spur had disappeared! Jesus had taken it in just two minutes. Praise the Lord for what God did for our sister in Christ. She and her family rejoiced and we rejoiced also. We can't praise the Lord enough for the leading of the Holy Spirit to tell us this in advance, and for every answer to prayer.

He revealed to us that there was trouble in the finger. In a way He'd never done before, God revealed to me that it was the little finger that needed help. One of the ladies of the church, a pianist, had injured her little finger some six weeks before. It hadn't functioned for six weeks: it would not bend and she was unable to play the piano all of this time. When prayer was made, the Holy Spirit went through her finger and she was healed. She arose and said, "That was me you were praying for." She went to the piano and played, "If God is Dead, Who is This Living in My Soul?" Most of the church was blessed as she played and sang this wonderful song.

We were privileged to have eighteen of our family with us at one time. There were three of my brothers and their families and we were privileged as well to have our grandchildren with us for almost a week. Their parents came the last weekend to be with us also. It's interesting to note that when the grandchildren started home they asked their parents, "Will we get to take next year's vacation with Grandma and Grandpa?" When Rev. Ryan from Oklahoma arrived he said, "Brother Helm, when I learned that three of your brothers and their families had come to spend their vacation with you in

this meeting, that really said something to me." I was so thankful to have my own brothers, and all my brothers and sisters in Christ, with me.

We had dear ones with us from Knoxville and Memphis, Tennessee; 3 families from Oilton, Oklahoma; persons of 2 families from Springfield and one from Cleveland, Ohio; two from Sears, Michigan; a couple from Scott Depot, W. Virginia; families from Anderson, Mentone, Parker, Yorktown and Noblesville, Indiana; one family from Vienna, Virginia; and my dear friend, Rev. Puhphrey, from Copperas Cove, Texas. The eleven-year-old son of my brother Edwin told him after two days there, "Daddy, these two days in St. Louis revival have been worth more than a whole week at the lake." Three or four weeks before the revival I was in phone conversation with my brother, Edward, in Virginia. His daughter, Rebecca, was so excited about coming to the revival services she didn't know whether she could wait. Two weeks following the services in another phone conversation with him, she came on the line and said, "Uncle Loran, I enjoyed the services even more than I thought I would."

During the Saturday morning prayer service, one dear brother shared that he had been pressed down and in hard battle all week. The Lord revealed to me that he had had a burden for souls in Africa. This immediately witnessed in his heart and a light came upon his face, and he knew within him that this was true. The Lord revealed also he had been burdened for a storm brewing in the earth. He had learned a wonderful spiritual lesson concerning the operation of the Holy Spirit in the interior life. In the same service I received a long distance call from the pastor's brother-in-law, 200 miles from St. Louis. He wanted me to pray about a certain burden on his heart. The Lord gave guidance and direction, for which we're thankful to Jesus. He had been sanctified the previous Saturday night in our service. I wish you could have been with me on the call. He laughed and he cried for joy, he was so thankful to Jesus for everything. This is such a dear blessing to my soul. Hallelujah.

After the prayer service had ended and almost all were gone except a dear one who cleaned the church, the Lord had me leave the study to go out and love him. When I did so he told me that he had had a pain in his heart for about a week. His wife works in the hospital and has contact with about 200 doctors. One of the doctors had given him a prescription to have an electro-cardiogram, which he showed me. But he said that as soon as I stepped out of the study from talking to the pastor's brother-in-law, that severe suffering immediately left him. He realized that all that week he had been privileged to carry the burden for this dear brother some 200 miles away that he didn't even know. It was

his first experience in knowing what a burden was. He testified that night that previously he thought a burden was an anxiety in the mind for some person or situation known to him personally. So the Lord had taught another lesson in spiritual operation in the interior life.

In the middle of my sermon one night, "To Whom Is The Arm Of The Lord Revealed?", the Holy Spirit revealed to me that someone was hurting or had been hurt in his head and gave me the location of the hurt. A dear woman stood after a few minutes and said, "I was the one you just prayed for." She informed us that 18 years ago in a downtown store an overhead light fixture fell down on her head. Since then she had suffered severe headaches periodically. She knew when I put my hand on my head and prayed that she was the one.

One day the pastor requested that I go pray with a man. The Holy Spirit revealed to go the next Friday. When we arrived, I saw three serious infections in his body. Also, the Lord gave me a very marvelous revelation concerning his life. For a few days he had been hurting so severely in his back that his doctor was unable to administer any adjustments to him. We had prayer and then I went over to love him. When I put my arms around him, I felt the power of God flow from my arms and into his body. He whispered in praise, "Glory to Jesus.

Glory to Jesus." I said to him, "Lean over now." We all rejoiced, because he could lean over and touch the floor without hurt. It was gone from him. Jesus had taken it away! When we left he went to the doctor, and the doctor beheld him well. Our brother came to church that night and demonstrated how he could now move without pain because Jesus had healed him. Even more precious, this brother's companion and wife was converted and gave her heart to Jesus that night. The angels of Heaven had right to rejoice. Praise the Lord.

We cannot tell you near all about this meeting, so we'll have to close. I refer to spiritual victories and spiritual help. In our next letter I'll try to share a little about God's wonderful working in Sears, Michigan, when we were with Sister Ione Lloyd.

I would like to be able to share with you the precious revelations and guidances of the Holy Spirit in the last few days, but it would make quite a little pamphlet in itself. This is all because of God and Jesus, the leading of the Holy Ghost. Hallelujah.

Please be praying about our October 10th meeting for protection, for guidance, and the instructions of the Holy Spirit. Also, remember our physical needs, that we may have deliverance and know what to do.

Dear Ones in Jesus Our Lord,

It was precious how the Holy Spirit led us in Indianapolis from the 8th to the 15th of October. Rev. Richey informed me, to Jesus glory, that he observed more spiritual growth in his people during these days than during any other comparable time.

There were a number of victories. On Sunday evening there were eight or nine at the altar, most desiring to be sanctified. The wife of one of our dear brothers, who was raised in the Wesleyan Church, was sanctified that night and testified for the first time in her life. Her face was aglow and her soul was full of joy. She appreciated the work of the Holy Spirit so very much. Her husband was so thrilled with Jesus and grew immensely during those days. Their little daughter, about ten years old, also found Jesus that night and was very happy. She took three pages of notes on our message of "The Glorious Church" which blessed the hearts of those who read them.

One young man witnessed before the people that this series of meetings was worth more to him than a four-year college course. Another young man who prayed through to victory with us said, "This service was something else. You fellows are like the disciples." He marveled that he had previously heard about the leadership of the Holy Spirit, and had read about it, but this was the first time he had ever been privileged to actually experience it.

One precious young couple came to me in the pulpit following the Friday night service and requested that we pray whether it would be in Divine Order that they be married. I sought to share the seriousness of inquiring about this, and that the answer might break their hearts. I told them that most couples were married out of Divine Order, and because of this both individuals were soon crushed in the gears of their own choosing. But they both insisted that we pray concerning them. The Holy Spirit revealed to me that they were not to be married. This fine young man began to weep deeply, and the young woman soon left the sanctuary, apparently somewhat agitated. Neither the young man nor the young woman spoke a word of gratitude for praying. They just both left.

I mention this experience so that all our people across the country will know that whenever you ask a man of God to pray concerning a situation or a decision, the answer will more often than not be exactly the opposite of that which you thought or desired. We need to review this often so that we won't be disappointed at what God wills for us to do.

One precious young woman was burdened. One of the servants of God brought her to me for spiritual counsel. The Holy Spirit revealed that her burden was for two different situations. When we prayed with her she was so happy—her face was shining and tears were streaming down her cheeks. She went to her father to share her experience with him, and my how they rejoiced! How thankful we are that the Holy Spirit can reveal to us what our burdens are. It required many, many years of obedience and waiting on God before we knew how to locate our burdens. It is by God's grace and gift that we would ever know again. To God be glory and honor; to the Holy Spirit be thanks.

One night, in the midst of the sermon, the Holy Spirit revealed that someone there was in much suffering. He told me right where they were hurting. I stopped preaching and asked Jesus to send His healing into this body for His glory and honor. A woman stood immediately and said, "That was me you just prayed for!" We were all so thankful to Jesus.

One dear pastor, who has been on the Way for over fifty years and preached the Gospel of redemption and inner cleansing for years, told Bro. Richey, "I've been in many meetings, but I was never in a more Spirit-led meeting than last night." To Jesus be all glory and honor.

As I face today, I'm looking into situations I've not heretofore met. The pain in my body from the hernia became so great Sunday morning that I could not go to service. I missed also Sunday night, Monday night and Tuesday night. God marvelously blessed my wife, Roger and Jon in the services at Portland in our absence. When I attempted to get up Monday, three times I was forced to return to bed. In all probability, it was approaching strangulation of the bowel. But God was merciful and allowed me to be relieved of that situation.

My need of prayer through the years has been much, but today is more. Please, if possible, pray through for us in these experiences to come. We cannot express enough our deep appreciation to those of you who have accepted our burdens as your own, seeking the Lord in fasting and prayer on our behalf. We are humbled deeply by your compassionate intercession for us.

These prices will hold even if there is an increase between now and Feb. 19. These prices are plus 5% city and state tax.

If you learn that you are unable to come after making reservations, you must *cancel by Feb. 11*. The manager has been most gracious and receptive to our plans for this Waiting Upon God. He said to Rev. Helm and me last week, "I am really looking forward to your coming. I believe we will have a wonderful time together." The next matter we have to share with you is so urgent I trust the Lord to help me share this with you in proper spiritual perspective. Will you stop and whisper a prayer before continuing to read?

The Holy Spirit has revealed to some of us brethren that "it is urgent" that Bro. Helm have surgery immediately. The Holy Spirit has also revealed that this experience will be 8 times more difficult for our Brother than all of the fear and dread of making the first plane trip. I doubt that very many persons realize the many ways the devil opposes and buffets Bro. Helm, nor do they realize the extreme sensitivity of his body. I do not know this very well and I have been fairly closely acquainted with Bro. Helm for over 20 years.

By having this surgery, Bro. Helm will not be in any revival meetings for the next few months. The Dr. has indicated that Bro. Helm should have absolute rest with no preaching for 3 to 4 months after surgery. Therefore, with no offerings coming in from churches you can see that we are entirely dependent on the Lord to supply the needs through personal contributions, to Revival For Our Day, Inc.

Bro. Helm has a hospitalization policy that pays only \$100. per week. This is the only financial help he has for this expense. This amount of insurance coverage will mean almost nothing in comparison to the expenses facing him. Some of us brothers have prayed and feel that he should have a private room. This will cost \$40 - \$60 per day plus all other costs of a hospital experience. We surely appreciate your praying with us about this. Thank you for considering this matter with us.

With the Lord's help and your prayers and gifts, we know that every financial need will be met. Through Bro. Helm's obedience, and prayers for

many of you for physical needs, you have been delivered by the power of God from much, much suffering; and many thousands of dollars expense has been averted. Therefore, I feel this is your opportunity to present your "Thank Offering" to God for His servant's needs.

When I read this last paragraph to Rev. Helm on the phone just now, he felt most humbled and cried out to the Lord for mercy and thanksgiving. Also as I have read this entire letter to him before sending it on to you, he is suffering with pain and has been off and on for the last few days. He has had this trouble for about six years. Some of us feel fearful that unless he has surgery within a few days a strangulation will occur in the lower abdominal diaphragm.

Your prayers, faith, trust, and obedience are needed now as much, if not more (I have the witness on more) than at any time in the history of R.F.O.D. We are grateful to those who have prayed and assisted us in this work. We are thankful for each one of you. We trust for the Holy Spirit to bless and help each participant in this Fellowship. Only a few of our Fellowship, in comparison to the hundreds (Over 900) who receive our letters have really helped us. As in all Christian work, only a few carry the burden of the responsibility of this ministry which the Holy Spirit has given us the privilege to embrace.
