Praise the Lord for the Holy Spirit of God to guide, comfort, and help us thru all ways of life. I am thankful to God and Jesus for all your prayers and assistance during my hospital experience.

The Lord gave such help, assurance, calmness, quiet, and undergirding to me as they took me into surgery. Some of my family and Dick & Mary Moore went into the chapel of the hospital to pray and wait on God while I was in surgery. Bro. Dick went up to the Bible and opened it. The first verse he saw was, "My times are in thy hand..." (Psa. 31:15). This is a promise God gave us when we were beginning this walk of faith, years ago. Praise the Lord for victory and deliverance that was so precious.

I tried to pour love and appreciation into the lives of everyone who came into my room while I was there. I think I might have missed one or two. All who ministered to me were so nice and kind.

One of my sisters in Christ was crying and praying, "Why, dear Lord, does thy servant have to have this surgery?" The Lord spoke to her and said, "This is just another missionary journey that he is to make for Me." Praise the Lord.

My Doctor instructed me that I could not drive a car for 6 weeks after surgery. So my dear wife has been my driver. However he allowed me to drive on the 40th day, which was Jan. 6th. I am very thankful to God for helping me in my body as well as every other way. Praise the Lord.

I have many experiences to share, that God has given me thru these days and weeks. These are precious answers to prayer and guidances of the Holy Spirit.

While I was at the hospital, I was privileged to pray four times with my Doctor, twice with a nurse, and twice with one of the maids. I also prayed once with a Brother down the hall, who was ready to go home.

It may be that I can share a few other things and revelations during the hospital experience at the Waiting Upon God in Feb.

I called my brother, Terrance, on Dec. 24th at 6:40 A.M. and oh what a wonderful time the Lord gave us. God revealed 11 different places down his back in the vertebrae that needed help. Also He revealed a place in his chest and one in the stomach area that was in need. He also revealed an infection in the bladder that would come in 5 years. There also was a deposit in his feet and ankles and in fibers and tissues that began to be made in 1936. We both were thankful to Jesus for all these revelations and for the privilege to pray about them.

After this call, I felt I should call my brother Edward, near Washington D.C. about their coming for Christmas. He had told us that his office was supposed to work Dec. 24th so they would not be able to come until the 25th unless something was changed. When I placed the call there was no answer, so I felt there had been a change and they were on their way here to surprise us.

I called Terrance back and began to share what I felt with him; he felt this was true. I began to pray for their (Edward and his family) travel to be protected

and the Lord revealed that a person full of liquor and wine would come across the highway and hit them. He also revealed a little later that all 4 of them would have been killed. So we prayed deliver, help, and a few petitions and when we prayed "delay" the Holy Spirit witnessed that God would delay the person and they would miss. Praise the Lord for all revelations and answers to prayer of God thru Jesus our wonderful Lord by the Holy Spirit.

I was led to call a sister in Christ and when she returned the call she said "I don't know what I'm going to do. I'm hurting thru the chest and I can hardly get my breath, yesterday and today." So I began to pray and the Lord revealed her trouble was in the walls of her heart. After a few requests the Lord answered and she said, "I got that prayer Brother." Praise the Lord.

As I hung up the phone, I got the burden of death. She would have left us on the next Wed. God answered for His glory and honor. She and her dear husband were so appreciative of what Jesus had done for them and us. To God be Praise always.

I called a dear couple in the Lord at 5:30 A.M. some time ago and the precious wife had not rested hardly at all during the night. The dear husband told me this. We began to pray and it was revealed that she had 30 to 40 burdens over the world. They both could tell in their hearts each leading and revelation the Lord gave me concerning where and what her burdens were for. When we were thru she said to her husband and me, "Oh this is like a night's rest." Praise the Lord.

There are other revelations we would like to share, for God's glory, some time if He were to lead. We owe all to the Lord for all guidance, help, provision, healing, instruction in righteousness and revelation thru the precious Holy Spirit, the Word of God.

We are looking forward to being in the Waiting Upon God in Christ Jesus, Feb. 19, 20, 21. We know we are completely dependent upon the leading of the precious Holy Spirit for this sacred time together with all who are of like mind in Jesus our only Savior and Redeemer. We all need to be in unity of faith concerning doctrine and the leading of the Holy Spirit, believing that the real evidence of Christianity is that we love one another as Christ so loved us. Also we need to be in perfect unity in every way and with one another, in order that God may have and do as He wills. One person present who is skeptical or has unbelief or doubt can hinder God's plan.

Also we need to be attentive during the sessions and not whisper, for this will distract others. We want each one to witness whenever God leads or testify as He directs.

I trust all the dear young people that we will be privileged to have with us will sit with their parents. In that way they will not be tempted

Praise the Lord for all His many benefits and blessings; also for His guidance of the Holy Spirit and the revelation of the Word and Spirit of God.

Although, I am not able to preach according to the doctor's orders for some months yet, God is leading and helping me in areas of prayer and revelation of needs of persons. Praise the Lord.

A dear brother that I have known for about 19 years brought a precious young convert and his wife to see me and have fellowship in Jesus. After an hour of sharing, I asked them if there was anything on their hearts. Just the instant the brother started to speak to his wife, the precious Holy Spirit revealed to me where her difficulty was. As I told her this revelation, she confirmed that was the place she had hurt for 1½ years. The Lord further revealed this was an inherited weakness.

We prayed as the Lord lead and helped us. After prayer she said, "I feel as if there is a fire burning inside my body." Jesus had touched and healed her. Praise the Lord.

I said to the husband, "The Lord reveals to me a trouble in your body on the right side of your chest." He said that that was where he was hurting when he came here to-night. Jesus touched him also. He said, "God has really shown me something here to-night." The wife said that she felt as though she had stepped over a line near heaven. This is to Jesus' glory and honor altogether.

The Lord revealed to me to go to Rev. Hill's church the other Sunday evening. Oh, what a service; a number came to the altar at the invitation. The Lord revealed to me that He was calling 19 more. A second invitation was given. Dr. Lang and his wife from Huntington were in the congregation; and she told me after the service that she thought about 19 more did come.

As I was leaving the church I was led to a young man who has been saved a few months. He is a basketball star. We got into a meeting in fellowship with Jesus in a short time. He said to me at first, "I don't know you from Adam." But we soon found out that we knew the same Jesus. He said to me, "I enjoyed your spirit in the service to-night."

We talked together about what sanctification means. The Lord helped and led me to explain. His girl friend who was standing beside him all the while, said, "This is the first time I ever understood what sanctification really is all about." The young man said that this is what he needed. I asked him if he felt God was calling him to this experience now; and he said that he had no working in his heart about it. As I prayed about it, I felt the Lord would sanctify him so I placed my hand on his head and began to pray. After a while he began to say, "Thank you Jesus." Praise the Lord for sanctifying him.

A dear brother and sister in Jesus told me two nights ago that last Sunday this young man praised the Lord before he took his part in the service for saving and sanctifying him. This is the victory!

Concerning the Waiting on God, Feb. 19-21, may I speak to you out of my heart.

This time of Waiting on God has been directed by the Holy Spirit. We have not tried to arrange this by ourselves. I doubt if any of us realize the importance of these services. We cannot place a monetary value on these days together with Jesus, the work of the Holy Spirit. A number of dear ones, who have really been blessed with us in the previous Waitings, began to have the preciousness of God's working taken from them in a little while by the powers of the air. They have forgotten to a great measure how wonderful it really was and how blessed they had been in the Waiting. It has slipped away.

The devil will try to prevent your coming to this Waiting. He will get you so involved with your work that you will give up trying to come. Many things may occur to get you discouraged. The Lord has revealed to me that the devil is telling many people that this is too expensive. In fact, about 80% of our fellowship have had this to combat.

Let us think for a moment about the devil's crowd or worldly group. Twenty to thirty million will spend from \$40.00 to \$300.00 this week-end at worldly places and they will not complain or murmur about it at all. Some church people will spend \$50.00 to \$100.00 or more to go to the lake or the mountains on a 3 day trip, but will say that this Waiting is too expensive. They forget they spent much more for some earthly things.

Some of our dear ones have spent from \$3000. to 6000. on a summer home or trailer. But the devil is trying to tell many that \$15.00 per person, per day for a 3-day Waiting is too much.

The devil will fight some of you more severely than he has concerning any other meeting you have ever considered attending. The more the devil tries to keep you away, the more God may bless and help you if you will persevere to be there in every service.

You have been so co-operative in past Waitings. You are some of the finest people in the world. You have not disturbed other motel guests except for once or twice in the 4 years of Waitings. For this I thank you for your being so thoughtful and quiet in the rooms, in the hallways, and lobby.

We are trusting the Lord Jesus thru the sacred Holy Spirit of God to lead us to precious victory as God knows best, for Jesus' glory, honor, and praise. Please pray and obey God, now and Feb. 19-21.

I need your prayer support very much for I am only a very small servant of Jesus. Thank you for your help and prayers these days, especially while I am not able to be in revival services.

Dear Ones in Jesus Our Wonderful
Savior and Lord,

We are trusting and rejoicing in the Lord Jesus, the work of the precious Holy Spirit. We are so very thankful to God for guidance in Dec. 1969, when He revealed that the next Waiting would be in Feb. 1971. Praise the Lord for directing, for if we would have tried to have it the week before, the roads were so bad with ice and snow that persons could not get out of Muncie, Ind. except on one lane east.

The three days of Waiting were very dear and precious as to God's presence, guidance, fellowship, and answers to prayer. There were 632 diseases, infections, growths, sicknesses, afflictions healed thru Jesus Christ of God the Holy Ghost, for by His stripes are ye healed. Praise the Lord.

I am so very, very in debt to God in every way for all He has done, lead, provided and revealed; also for how He has kept, guided, blessed, saved, sanctified, reclaimed, helped and delivered. All things are in Jesus the Christ, the Son of God. I am so thankful for His love and holiness, His "all-everythingness". I am only a very little servant, just nothing, God is everything. Praise God for the strength, healing and victory.

The hours flew by so quickly in the Waiting Before God Feb. 19-21. Each session was over so soon even tho it lasted 3 to 3½ hours. The brother who sold me my car said that an hour at church would be so tiring to him. He sat for 8 to 9 hours during the last day, as he arrived about 10:00 A.M. that day. He said that he was not tired of church at the end of that day. This was all because of Jesus' presence.

My mother was with us for the full 3 days. Her presence was a miracle of Jesus for she has had some ailment in her body for over 72 years; she will be 80 this Sept. There are times that she is so afflicted or ill that she cannot go anywhere or even get out of bed. Much of the time she has to rest in bed or a comfortable chair in her room. Yet because of Jesus' touch to her she was able to sit for 33 to 34 hours in meeting these three days. At the end of the session Sunday evening she was energetic and invigorated and moving about with enthusiasm and praise, not showing tiredness or exhaustion, which some people in good health revealed after 10 hours of meeting in one day. This is all because of Jesus' leading and presence.

If I may share a little background with you, I left her in 1932 to go to get the doctor and I thought she would be dead when I returned. In 1942 she was so sick for 19 weeks; and was on what she thought was her death bed. She would say to me, "Son, I was more out of the body than in, I will soon be going home." I said, "Mother, I'm expecting something wonderful from heaven and I believe God will spare you." She has lived almost 29 more years, all because of God's abundant mercy, love, and help. I praise God, the Lord Jesus for all this, indeed. When my mother was 14 years old, she had rheumatic fever, as her loved ones ministered to her she would tell them, "I cannot see you." She lost her sight for days and some of her hair came out. Many years later, when I was a year or two old, she became so ill the doctor and his wife would take me home with them to take care of me. The doctor would not reveal her temperature, it was so alarmingly high. This time all of her hair came out.

When I was quite small, she was ill and had severe pain starting in her feet, when the pain reached her head she would scream so loudly she could be heard about ¼ mile away. It could be said of a truth that mother has been in ill health most of her life, and hardly able to go at times. Yet she could sit 10 to 11½ hours each day for 3 days at this Waiting. Some strong men I know cannot sit 3 hours at a session for 3 sessions, much less 9 sessions. This has to be thru God only.

She was so delighted and happy thru the 3 days, all because of Jesus. She told me that these had been

three of the greatest days of her life. Before the Waiting she would say to me, "Son, I have no money for the expenses." I said, "Mother, the Lord will provide; He will help me get the money some how." One of her granddaughters, Rebecca Sue, who lives in Vienna, Va. said to her mother and dad, "Here is all I have saved from my baby sitting jobs and my allowance (\$17.50) take it to help with Grandmother's expenses." This touched me deeply for Rebecca wanted to come to these services more than most of the people who were privileged to come. When the Lord revealed that she was not supposed to come, she was willing to stay home.

We were asked to pray about Edna Cowie's coming to this Waiting. She lives in Scotland. The Lord witnessed she was to come. The day before she left she had one dollar in her purse. Her dear close friend, Pat Radecki, lives in Michigan. Her father said, "God wants Edna to come." So he went to the bank, got the money and wired it to her. She was with us and enjoyed it. All because of Jesus. When I learned that Mr. Radecki had done this it witnessed to me with sweetness. I pray the Lord to give the money back to Mr. Radecki with a lot of interest.

The only way one can know about the Waiting is to have been there. It cannot be told or explained, it must be experienced. The tall man, George, who was in charge of all the meals said to me, "I hope God leads you back to us." On Mon. after the Waiting was over he said, "You all have taught us many things in these days that you have been with us." When I went out in the hall on Sat., Mae, who was the head waitress, said, "We can feel the Holy Spirit's presence coming to us thru these walls from the service inside." Praise the Lord.

Then on Mon. after the lunch with 29 of our brothers and sisters in Jesus, Bro. Roger and I came out in the hall and Mae said, "We are glad you came, we needed you, you look like the apostles, I see Jesus shining thru your face." We were humbled to the floor in our hearts. We took her by the hand and prayed for the appetite for tobacco to leave her and in its place the Love of God to come. Also we prayed for her soul. We went to the front desk of the Inn to tell the ones there how we appreciated their labors. Two young women were there and I prayed for them and thanked them for allowing me to pray. They thanked me for praying. We went into the Innkeepers office and Bro. Roger, Bro. Emory and I loved him and had prayer with him. He wanted us to return for another meeting when the Lord would lead.

Rev. and Mrs. Alexander prayed with the lady who cleaned their room and she was converted to Jesus. Praise the Lord.

I am thankful to Bro. Moore who looked after my needs from 6:00 A.M. until after mid-night. Thanks to Rev. Reece and those who assisted him, to John and Jane Langdon, to Roger Yoder and Jon Cullum for their part. Also thanks to my wife, Florence, for the hours at the piano each day. Also thanks to everyone at the Inn who made our stay pleasant and comfortable.

There is so much to say I cannot tell all that should be told in this letter.

On the trip south I had the privilege to witness to 22 persons and one man in his 40's followed me to the Cross in the prayer of repentance. So we are at work for Jesus a little while we are trying to rest.

We need your prayers and help very much. Our first revival meeting is April 7 with Rev. Wm. Campbell in Ala. Then we are to be with Rev. and Mrs. Reece at Bethel, north of Dunkirk, Ind. on S.R. 167, April 15-22. Next we go to the Phoenix Church near Petroleum, Ind. April 24. May 12-18 we are to be with Rev. and Mrs. Oliver Hogue at Scott Depot, W. Va. June 4-? we will be with Rev. and Mrs. Edwin Helm at Emmanuel Methodist, Anderson, Ind.

Revival For Our Day, Inc.

Dear Believers in Jesus Christ, Son of God,

Greetings in the Holy Spirit of the Holy Kingdom of God. We are saved through the precious Blood of Jesus, the Mercy and Grace of our Heavenly Father. Praise the Lord.

The meeting in Alabama was so precious. We are very thankful for God's gracious, holy guidance, the wonder of His Grace and love. P. T. L. The pastor told us that the weather had been rough for some time before we came. But the day we arrived the sun shone brilliantly, the day grew beautiful, and it was like summer all the time we were there, to Jesus' glory.

When we arrived at the motel my wife and I were led to have prayer with the maid, and as I prayed with her the tears flowed down and found their way into the crevices of her cheeks. She was happy. The next day we saw this maid and she met us enthusiastically saying, "Oh, it's so good to see you! I thought about you all last night!" After a few days I was privileged to have prayer with the workers in the laundry room. They were so appreciative and were helped. A day later I had prayer there again. A few minutes after the housekeeper met me and said, "I hear you were by and had prayer again. We appreciate it so much."

While eating in the dining room of the motel the hostess called our song evangelist, Roger Yoder, to her and wanted to know who we were. She was inquiring for the two men who sat at the next table to our right. We were soon introduced to them and began to share with them answers to prayer and guidances of the Holy Spirit through Christ Jesus. As we stood talking their faces were receptive and appreciative, and I noticed that the eyes of the one gentleman would fill with tears from time to time. He looked up at me and said, "We need you in this world." The meeting that God gave us with these precious men affiliated with railroads was worth our coming for the services of revival.

While talking to the hostess at the cash register one day she shared that her twelve or thirteen-year-old son standing with her had had to come home from school because he was feeling badly. I could see by his face that he didn't feel at all well. So I lay my hand on him and prayed for his healing. On the afternoon of the twelfth of April she told me that he was healed at that very moment and went right out to play baseball with the boys. Praise the Lord!

The services with Rev. Campbell were a result of Jesus speaking to me on my bed at the Waiting on God in Indianapolis Feb. 19-21. I told Rev. Campbell in the next meeting, "Rev. Campbell, I've never told a man I'd be with him in revival unless he first asked me to pray about coming, but God tells me I'm to be with you in Birmingham, Alabama, April 7 to 11." He said later that it liked to scared him to death when I told him. He replied, "Why I don't have so much as a barn to meet in." He had no church at that time. I assured him, "Well, God has

told me to bring my wife and and my two song evangelists and fellowship with you even if we just sit in your living room or in a store somewhere. We'll trust God to work it out." Rev. Campbell was then later accepted by a 100% vote in the Fultondale Parkview Church of God just north of Birmingham, where the services were held.

The opening service, while Brother Jon was singing the first stanza of "A Mighty Fortress is Our God," the Holy Spirit revealed to me that someone was hurting at the base of the neck. I interrupted Jon after this first stanza and told the congregation what God had revealed. So I asked Jesus to send healing to this area in the body, and then Jon completed the other three stanzas of the hymn. After the song a beautiful lady spoke out and said, "I have been suffering there in the neck for some time, and when you prayed a fire came into me from my waist to my neck and took all that out of there." She continued by saying, "Bro. Campbell had told us how God worked through you, but it shocked me when the Lord revealed it by the Holy Spirit." P. T. L.

The Holy Spirit then revealed that someone needed to pray. One of the main women in the church began to pray, "Lord, you know I've been living a hypocritical life . . . I've criticized people and I know my prayers haven't been going higher than my head . . ." The Lord forgave her and she really got victory. To each of the remaining services she then brought a young beautician who worked with her. This young woman told me on Sunday morning, "I came here with many equations. The Lord has given me the answer to each one." She was really happy.

The pastor's wife slowly came to her feet this first service and testified that as I had prayed for healing in the limb earlier in the evening, pains she had had in her leg for several months simply vanished! She was so surprised that she tried moving her leg in a variety of ways to be certain the pain was really gone. She hadn't thought the prayer was for her, but it really was!

Every once in a while Bro. Campbell would shout out, "Well, glory!" He would raise his hand and testify that these services were for his encouragement.

A few nights later the Lord revealed that someone was hurting two different places in the side of the body, and he revealed to me the difficulty. I prayed to Jesus to remove the trouble there and we soon found out that it was the pastor's wife who was healed. She had mentioned this need in her body to her husband and they had considered mentioning it for prayer. But Jesus revealed it to me before they could make the request and simply took care of all that difficulty in her side. She testified that she was really helped in the meeting.

One precious woman, who sat near the back during this first service, testified that she had scarcely been out of the house for some time because of severe rheumatoid arthritis in her hips. But she said that she had sat through three hours of service without pain. She told us that at home she is in pain and suffering even when she has pillows all around her. This was a miracle of Jesus.

During this service her brother stood up and told the entire congregation that he had resentment towards this woman, his sister, because she didn't go to church where he thought she should. He was sorry that he criticized her and asked her to forgive him. We could tell that he received real precious victory in this service.

When we were closing the first night's service, I was led to call on Bro. Comer Tankersley to give the benediction. He immediately prayed, "Our Father, we thank Thee for the joy." Oh, you could tell that the Lord helped him. We later learned that he had never before prayed in public.

During the revival he and his wife never missed an evening service, driving each night 128 miles round trip to be with us. After the revival we were privileged to be in their home. Their precious maid told us with such enthusiasm, "Oh, Bro. Helm . . . Mr. Tankersley's not the same man he was before going with you to the Holy Land. I've lived with them nearly 14 years, and he's been entirely different since that trip!"

During my last sermon in Birmingham, Bro. Tankersley stood up three different times to help me. The first time he witnessed, ". . . while we were in the Holy Land at the tomb, Bro. Helm was praying, so I started praying myself and got to God." He had said to me earlier that same day in Jerusalem, "Let's go back to the motel." It was raining and we were all getting so wet. But I said, "Oh, let's go on." I prayed that no one would get a sniffle or a cough. And, to Jesus' glory, not a one of the 72 people had a sneeze or a cough or a sore throat.

Brother Comer stood up later in this service and said, "One thing more. I've been in the hospital with pneumonia a few times, and when I woke up in Athens, Greece, the day we were to start home, I

had penumonia. I was so sick. I managed to get a little juice down for breakfast, but that was all. I wanted to have Bro. Helm pray for me, but he was in the other bus. I didn't know how I'd ever get with him. But just as we started through customs, I looked over and there he was right beside me. He said, 'Why Bro. Tankersley, what's the matter?' I said, 'Bro. Helm, I'm a sick man.' So Bro. Helm prayed for me, and that pneumonia was gone at a snap of a finger!" Glory be to Jesus!

He said that before he went to the Holy Land he had prayed, "Jesus, if this man is really of you, show me a miracle on this trip." He told us later, "I didn't know it was going to be me the miracle would be performed on." One would really need to know this dear brother to see all the wonderful change that God has wrought through Jesus in him. He told me with such energy, "This revival at Birmingham has been for wife and me!"

We appreciated our dear ones coming from West Virginia, Ohio, parts of Tennessee (Memphis, Knoxville, Maryville), several families from various parts of Indiana, and my good friend, Homer Pumphrey, who flew from Copperas Cove, Texas, to be with us. Bro. Fox said it was the most wonderful revival he had even been in; and he is one of the dear saints of God who has been walking with Jesus for 31 years. From Rev. Everett Hogue's congregation in Hartsell, Alabama, (128 miles round trip) there were 26 one night, 32 another, and 34 another. Sixteen came from Rev. Alexander's church in Huntsville one evening, which is a 200 mile trip. It was a blessing and a help to have these dear ones with us.

A lady told me the last night of the service that on the first evening she had come depressed and down. But Jesus came during the service and lifted her up in the delight of the Lord.

Thank you, each one, who has prayed and helped us in this endeavor to trust and obey God.

Dear Beloved in Jesus, the Son of God,

I am thankful and rejoicing in God. Jesus is Lord! He never fails.

The Lord revealed on June 13th as we were eating lunch, that the next Waiting Before God is to be Aug. 28-30. It will be at the Holiday Inn # 8 in Indianapolis.

Please send your room reservations to the Inn as soon as possible. Be sure to tell them you are with R.F.O.D. Fellowship. Further instructions are in Bro. Reece's letter and on the registration card.

When I called Mr. Peacock at home, he was delighted to hear of our revelation that God directed us to be with him. He left his home and went to his office to check his schedule to see if it was clear. He called me back with joy in his voice to tell me that the dates were clear. This is a miracle, for normally there is some meeting there the year round. When Bro. Reece and I met him on Tues. (22nd), he was happy to see us and make the arrangements for the Waiting Before God.

A precious young man came to the services at Anderson at my Bro. Edwin's church, from Portland, Ind. The Lord worked deeply in his heart. He came to the altar and received a precious experience in his heart. The Lord worked in a precious way in these services.

We are including with the letter this time a letter from Hartselle, Ala., which shares some precious things which the Lord did last weekend, June 19-22.

Before we share this letter, I want to tell you a few revelations which are not included in it.

When Mr. & Mrs. Tankersley and I knelt in their home on Sat evening for family prayer, the Holy Spirit came on me. He turned me to the right and had me put my hands on Bro. Tankersley's back. Bea and Comer Tankersley, as well as others in the Church of God here in Hartselle, Ala. had prayed for some time that Bro. Helm would be sent to be with us. Their prayers were answered in an unusual way.

The Lord laid it upon Comer's heart that Bro. Helm should be called to see if he could come to Nashville, Tenn. to the hospital to pray for his neice's husband, Leonard Lawson. He had been in a coma since Feb. as the result of an accident.

They called Terry Hogue and he relayed the message to Bro. Helm. Bro. Helm had been asked to pray for Leonard before, but it was only after Comer called that the Lord laid it upon Bro. Helm's heart that he should come to Nashville to pray for Leonard.

The joy was great that Comer and Bea felt when they learned that Bro. Helm would be coming and staying in their home. When Bro. Helm walked from the plane the presense of the Holy Spirit went thru Bea's body as she never had experienced before. There was instant fellowship in Jesus with Bro. Helm.

Praise the Lord for victory. We were with Brad and his girl friend and Kim and his wife, Thurs. evening, 9/2. These young men had been saved recently by Jesus the Christ. Kim was saved 4 weeks ago and Brad was saved last Mon. evening, 8/30. P.T.L.

Our time together at the Holiday Inn in Marion, Ind. was precious and sacred. The Lord revealed to me that we should keep the group small. I was privileged thru the Holy Spirit to lead, Page, Kim's wife, to Jesus. This was worth more than the entire world.

Marlene, Brad's girl friend, was burdened. I took her hand and began to pray to God in the Name of Jesus. He revealed 19 burdens over the world He had given her. At a number of the revelations, the power of the Holy Spirit would run thru my hand and into Marlene, this hand maid of Jesus. She would say, "I can tell this also." Praise the Lord. We are in debt to Jesus, the Holy Ghost for all help, victory, revelations, guidance, provisions, protection and fellowship in God.

Cleo, our waitress, was happy. She would say to our group, "You are the real thing. I get to have someone like you about once or twice a year." I was burdened for her 4th, 6th, and 8th children. God helped us to pray for her body also.

She left the room where we were eating for about an hour. She then returned with the cashier and a waitress from the main dining room. When Cleo introduced them, they said that Cleo was telling everyone in the Inn about our little group.

As a result of the Waiting in Indianapolis, Aug. 28-30 at the Holiday Inn I-70, the Innkeeper and his staff want us to return as soon as God leads. We prayed for the Innkeeper's body and the lady in charge

of food service. I said to her, "You have some trouble in the back of your neck." She said, "Why yes, how did you know?" The Lord helped me to pray for her and I said, "I believe you will see a difference in 5 days."

During the Waiting there were 120-165 who ate with us. In some of the services there were over 225 with us. When many were seeking to be sanctified on Mon. (30th), God revealed to me that 88 persons in the U.S.A. did not persevere to be with us in that service. As a result we were

It is very difficult to rest under this responsibility and pressure. The responsibility of this is so great and we must be absolutely right as to God's leading and revelation in Jesus. We are nothing- Christ is everything.

We want to thank Rev. & Mrs. Reece, Rev. Hill, and the John Langdons for all their help to us in R.F.O.D. Thanks also to all of you who are helping them in the work of this Corp. I am grateful to you who have been faithful to pray and assist us in this ministry. Praise the Lord for all soul victories. Pray on for us, please.

We trust this Christmas time will be a delight, a joy, and a peace to you as the Holy Spirit gift operates within your heart. Be encouraged in Jesus, our wonderful Savior, who will never fail us at any time. Remember, the obedient heart is where the Gift operates.
