- ✕^o✕ If a student plays a worship-band instrument, we encourage the campers to bring them. This does not indicate that they will be asked to play for services, but we want the campers prepared.
- ✕^o✕ There will be many opportunities to be involved in structured athletic events, but there is also free time built into the schedule. Campers should feel free to bring their own athletic equipment, within reason.
- ✕^o✕ There will also be opportunities for students to engage in craft/art activities. Some supplies will be provided, but campers are encouraged to bring their own items as well.

FYC Guidelines

General

- ✕⁰✕ Campers are expected to attend the entire week of camp.
- ✕⁰✕ Campers may **not** bring phones. If a camper brings a phone, he/she will be required to turn it in to his/her counselor for the duration of the week. The best option is for the camper to leave the device at home.
- ✕⁰✕ Campers are expected to treat the campgrounds with respect. This includes the bathing/restroom facilities, cabins, dining hall, etc.
- ✕⁰✕ Staff members and campers must always be in groups of at least three or more when not in a public space.
- ✕⁰✕ Campers are expected to sleep in their assigned cabins and remain in their cabins after “lights out” each night.
- ✕⁰✕ Visitors must have approval from the camp director prior to arrival at camp.
- ✕⁰✕ Absolutely **no** males in females’ cabins or vice-versa.
- ✕⁰✕ Campers are expected to participate in the scheduled camp activities unless there is a medical reason preventing it.
- ✕⁰✕ Guns, fireworks, knives, tobacco products, alcohol, or illegal drugs including but not limited to marijuana and vaping are strictly prohibited.
- ✕⁰✕ PDAs (public displays of affection) between campers is not permitted.
- ✕⁰✕ All medications must be turned in to the camp nurse for dissemination at the appropriate time.
- ✕⁰✕ If a camper drives to camp, he/she must turn in car keys to the camp director/cabin counselor to be kept in a safe, locked location until camp ends.

Dress Code

- ✕⁰✕ Campers are encouraged to use discretion in their attire. Inappropriate clothing will be addressed in a direct, discreet manner.
- ✕⁰✕ Female swim suits must be a modest one-piece.
- ✕⁰✕ Male swim suits must be appropriate length and not too tight.
- ✕⁰✕ All campers must be fully clothed going to and from the swimming area.

Sports Rules

- ✕⁰✕ Sportsman-like conduct is expected in all athletic activities. This includes appropriate language (verbal and body).
- ✕⁰✕ Only game-appropriate physical contact is permitted during athletic activities.

Consequences

- ✕⁰✕ Misconduct will be dealt with appropriately by counselors first. If necessary, any issues will be brought to the attention of the camp director. Serious infractions may result in a camper being dismissed from camp immediately at the cost of the parents/guardians coming to retrieve the camper.
