



GENERAL INFORMATION

CHECK-IN Note: *Campers without a completed and signed medical form will not be permitted to enter their cabins until one is on file in the camp office.*

Check-in is from 2:00 to 3:00 PM on Monday in Ashbrook Hall. Each camper should have with them a completed and signed **Medical Form** (if not previously mailed to the camp), all **prescription medication**, the **remaining balance of the camp fee**, and any **spending money for the Snack Shop and Camp Store**. Please leave all other belongings and luggage in your vehicle during the check-in process. After check-in, campers will be directed to the cabin area where counselors will help them settle into their assigned cabins.

MEDICAL NEEDS

During check-in, each camper will have the opportunity to discuss any specific physical needs with the Camp Nurse. A completed and signed Medical Form is required of each camper. Although a medical examination is not required for camp, we remind you of the advisability of having a physical examination if there is any reason to suspect that the camper is having medical problems. It is also recommended that each camper have a current tetanus booster before coming to camp. All medications will be turned over to the camp nurse as they are not allowed in the cabins. Medications should be in the original container and labeled with the camper's name. Campers do not need to bring common over-the-counter medications unless they are taken on a daily basis.

CAMP STORE AND SPENDING MONEY

All money will be turned in and recorded on a Camp Store spending card for each camper. No money is allowed in the cabins.

The camper will have access to their card when the Snack Shop or Camp Store is open during the week. Purchases made, as well as the camp offering (which is taken during the week for a specific camp project), will be deducted from the card. Money not spent will be returned on Saturday morning. The Snack Shop sells a variety of drinks and snacks while the Camp Store offers Bibles, books, gift items, some toiletry items, and Peniel Bible Camp clothing. The Camp Store will be open Monday afternoon during check-in.

WHAT TO BRING *Reminder: Please label all belongings with the camper's name.*

- Bible Pen Sleeping bag or sheets/blankets Fitted twin sheet Pillow
- Evening Chapel attire* Clothing for 5 full days of outdoor activity Swimsuit Dark T-shirt for water games/activities
- Tennis Shoes with closed toe and heel Extra socks and shoes Flip-flops/crocs
- Soap and shampoo Toothbrush/Toothpaste Comb/Brush Sunscreen Bug spray Jacket/Hoodie Rain gear
- Laundry bag Towels/washcloth Plastic bag to take wet clothing home

Other items you may find helpful:

* For chapel services girls should bring dresses/skirts/long pants and nicer shirts and boys should bring collared shirts and nicer pants/jeans.

Do not bring cell phones or any other electronic devices, pets, valuables, magazines, air soft guns, knives, tobacco, alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs, clothing with inappropriate messaging, short or tight clothing, or tank tops.
